I am against this bill:

"Prohibits police officers commissioned by public university from carrying firearms as police officers outside of police headquarters if public university is located in city with population exceeding 150,000.

I feel the response time for a police officer may be too long to help anyone being attacked for whatever reason

The local police may not know as quickly as a university officer where each building/room is located making response time that much longer.

As we seen in an alleged "school shooting" when "officers" just hid behind a building waiting for back up; more children were hurt. Time is vital in responding to potential violent situations.

You would also have the concern of a university officer in more danger, due to student riots, drunk/stoned, in a domestic dispute...

Everyone should be able to protect themselves. The 2nd amendment doesnt discriminate: only proven felons should not be able to legally own guns.
