WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Allows Chief Justice of Supreme Court to charge reasonable fees of public bodies for cost of providing electronic filing services. Deposits collected fees into State Court Technology Fund. Takes effect 91 days after adjournment.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

The Chief Justice may establish reasonable fees for access to electronic documents on the Oregon Judicial Case Information Network (OJCIN). Currently, the fee schedule charges a flat \$150 non-refundable set up fee and a monthly user fee, which can range from \$25 per month to \$200 per month, depending on the size of the law firm. Each account also has a \$15 user profile fee. Data resellers are treated separately from law firms or general access accounts and pay a \$1,500 - \$2075 base rate per month and a \$250 user profile fee.
