


Department of State Lands Expenditure History + 2019-21 Governor's Budget

Investments

> Elliott State Forest

- Seasonal forester position, continues contract with Titan Kelly, funds ODF fire patrol.
- Contract for Habitat Conservation plan, agreement with US Fish and Wildlife, public affairs contract with Oregon Consensus at PSU.

Ongoing work

- Portland Harbor Superfund Site defense costs.
- Filled lands inventory and online mapping (Senate Bill 912, 2015).

> Infrastructure

- Replace 20 year old Land Administration System database.
- Project manager position for Portland Harbor, Elliott State Forest and other high profile projects.
- Unclaimed property claims examiner position (limited duration) to meet processing performance measures.

- GIS/data management position
- Seasonal education position
