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**Measure Description:**

Authorizes translator district board to establish property tax permanent rate limit and impose operating taxes, following elector approval.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Counties, Special Districts, Cities

**Analysis:**

This fiscal impact statement is submitted to transmit the measure from the Senate Committee on Business and General Government to the Senate Committee on Finance and Revenue.

The measure would authorize a translator district’s board to establish a property tax permanent rate limit and impose operating taxes, upon approval by electors. It would authorize the board to impose a local option tax, upon approval by electors. The board would only have authority to call for an election on whether to establish a permanent rate limit during a November general election in a presidential election year. The measure would also authorize a translator district to enter into enforcement agreements with cities to permit code enforcement officers to determine if a property occupant is intentionally receiving and using a district signal.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on Counties, Special Districts, and Cities.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Senate Committee on Finance and Revenue.
