The Eastmoreland neighborhood has been locked in the federal historic district process for almost three years. A handful of people started this process.

Attached is my testimony before the **US House of Representatives, Committee on Natural Resources Subcommittee on Oversight and Investigations on July 18, 2017 on "Examining Impacts of Federal Natural Resources Laws Gone Astray, Part II.**

Our Oregon law resulted from the National Historic Preservation Act of **1966** which was meant to be entirely honorific.

It is time for this change with local and public process.
