I guess I am not aware of the downsides to this bill as it would allow agencies to hire back PERS retires for far less then they pay fully benefited employees. It does not require them to hire them, thus allowing agencies to pick and choose the people that would most benefit their respective agencies.

I get the sense that some Legislators just do not want to support anything that might remotely benefit anyone who is part of the PERS system. I find this somewhat distressing. I have worked for the Douglas County Sheriff's Office, as their Emergency Manager, for over 40 years now. I am definitely not rich, the County has paid OK but they are not in the top of the comparables for pay. Don't get me wrong I feel very blessed that I have job and have been able to provide for my family. I am nearing the end of my career and am very worried, due to all the PERS reform bills, that the PERS system is not going to be able to provide me the retirement I once hoped.
