

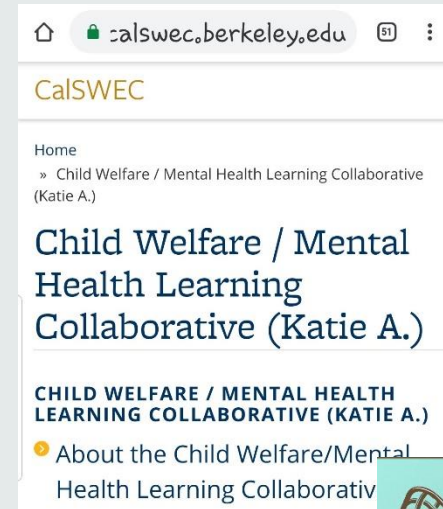

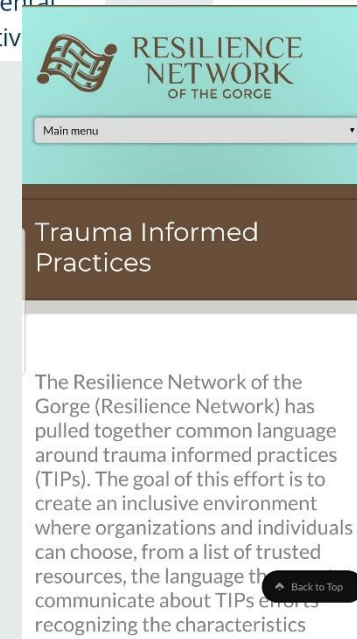

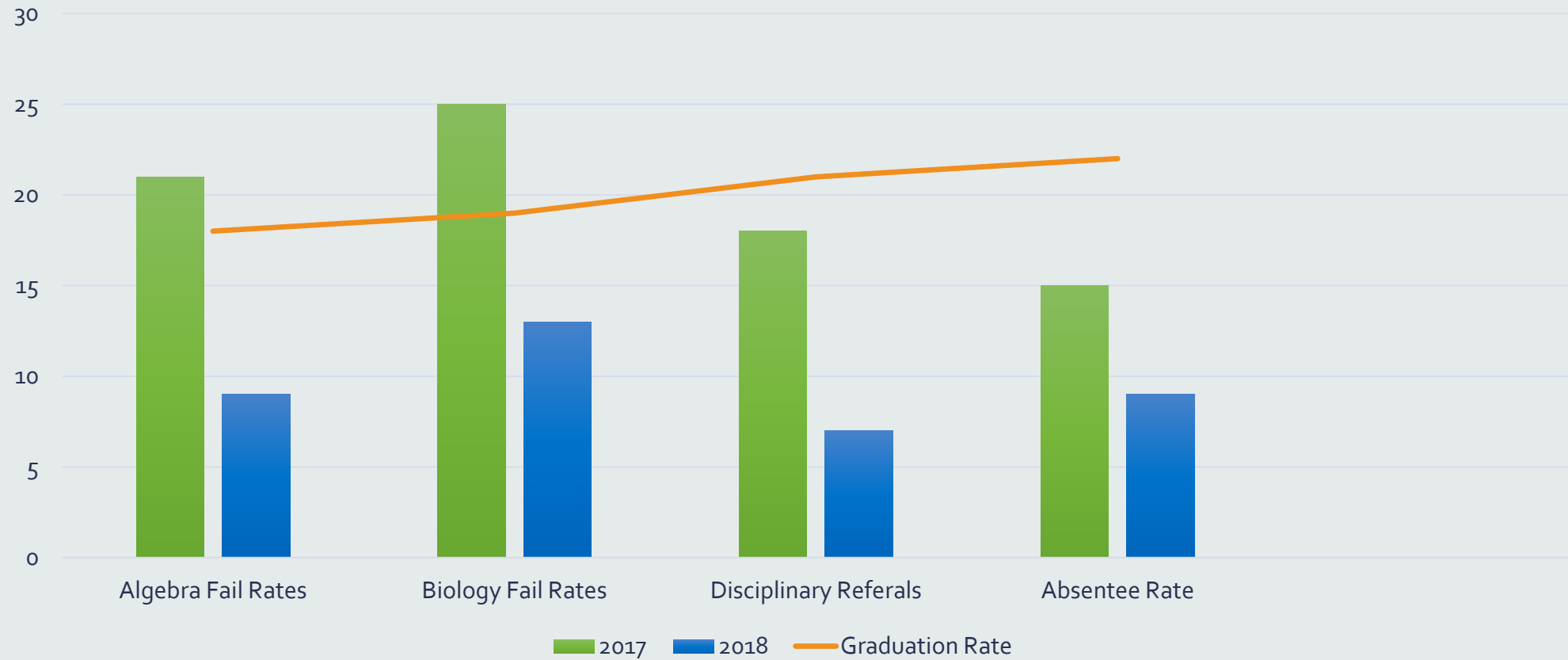
A completely different way of handling disruptive learning, behavioral issues, responding to youth who have ACEs/Trauma, etc.
