I am writing to you in support of SB 283 in the Oregon legislature, which would direct the Department of Education to make available a statement that discloses potential health risks of wireless network technology and requires both public and private schools to distribute statements to employees; students; and parents (or guardians) statements outlining the potential risks to health of these technologies.

I believe this bill, could; if heard in the senate and passed into law, provide some level of the curtesy to customers, regarding the entire nature of these technologies and their possible connection to problematic elements in the environment, (both; currently and in the foreseeable future) and ,thereby; allow some possibility that these consumers might apply their discretion (if not also their caution) to their specific uses and applications of these very powerful and influential technologies.
