WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Provides that a person retains a privacy and possessory interest in the contents of a residential garbage receptacle outside a person's residence until collection for disposal by sanitation company. Prohibits search or seizure by a law enforcement agency without consent or a search warrant. Declares an emergency, effective on passage.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

-1 Replaces the measure. Expands the hearings required to be privately held by district school boards to hearings pertaining to any confidential school records unless the student or the student's parent or guardian requests a public hearing.

BACKGROUND:

Any hearing held by a district school board on matters pertaining to or examination of confidential medical records of a student including that student's educational program, shall be held in private under current statutes. House Bill 2514, under the -1 amendments, would expand this requirement to include hearings that pertain to or examine any confidential records of a student, not only medical records.
