**Measure Description:**

Directs Early Learning Division to develop pilot program in rural area of state that reimburses child care providers for cost of providing high-quality child care rather than percentage of market rate.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Department of Education (ODE), Department of Human Services (DHS)

**Analysis:**

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Human Services and Housing to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure directs the Early Learning Division of the Oregon Department of Education to develop pilot program in rural area of state that reimburses child care providers for cost of providing high-quality child care rather than percentage of market rate. The bill also contains a blank General Fund appropriation.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on the Oregon Department of Education and the Department of Human Services.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
