Measure Description:

Directs the Oregon Department of Education to provide moneys to pay for education of students in a specified residential alternative education program. First applies to the 2019-20 distribution of the State School Fund.

Revenue Impact: Indeterminate

The bill proposes an additional funding source to the State School Fund and stipulates a carve-out from the State School Fund (SSF), to pay for a specified residential alternative education program. It is not clear how much money will be added and how much money will be paid out of the SSF.

This bill has a subsequent referral to the Joint Committee on Student Success. Further analysis will be done when the bill reaches the committee.
