Dear Representatives of the Oregon House Rules Committee

My wife and I live in Tangent, in the southern part of Linn County. We are strongly opposed HB2974, the formation of a Salem bridge district, generally, and, specifically to the inclusion of Linn County within that district.

Oregon does not need added reliance on infrastructure just to alleviate automotive rush hour traffic in Salem. The existing two bridges are quite sufficient. Adding a bridge will NOT solve the traffic problem, it will only bring more cars. Is not that exactly the problem that is being addressed by the Carbon bill?
