I am writing in regards to amendment -2 on HB 3063. I noticed that the school amendment removed private but maintained public charter, most of which in Oregon, homeschool families are part of as an online school to remain in compliance with ODE requirements. These charters may have a ground campus but primarily and completely for us, takes place in our home. I ask that a designation be made for online charter.

In Section 2 (3) I would like clarification on whether this applies only to students being unenrolled in their current school or if this applies to registration within the school district as they now register as homeschool students. I do appreciate the recognition of religious exemption.

What will happen to students with IEP's?

Would there be an amended CDC catch up schedule for students who are merely missing a single vaccine?
