HB 3063 Amendment Proposal

1. Grandfather clause on all Personal Belief Exemptions until Dec 31, 2019.

2. Bill is effective Jan 1, 2020

3.Vaccine checkpoints occur for every child at Preschool, Kinder and 7th entry.

4. Medical exemptions shall be made at the full discretion of the child's attending physician and not restricted to the CDC contradictions. Exempt a child from vaccination when the child's physician concludes that there are circumstances, including but not limited to, family medical history, for which the physician does not recommend vaccination.

5. Religious exemptions be retained; the morality of being forced to use products that contain aborted fetal cells should never be mandated. Supreme Court has upheld "sincerely held religious beliefs" to the same scrutiny as any organized religion.

6. Students with Individual Education Programs(IEP) are federally protected; therefore they are EXCLUDED from this bill.

7. Conditional enrollment for children needing to catch up on vaccines. A doctor can write a letter stating the child will be receiving the "needed" vaccines but on a spread out schedule safer for the child.

8. No additional vaccines added, no HPV, no Flu, no future CDC added vaccines 72 is already way too many

9. Remove Hep B for infants, they don't need it until later in life

10. Remove DTaP due to pertussis failures

11. Allow a doctors note stating the child is getting required vaccinations on a delayed schedule for safety purposes. The current schedule is overkill and children on a delayed schedule are already on track with vaccines against communicable illnesses, posing no health threat to others.
