

Dear Representatives,

This is to express my opinions on HB 3063 and one more attempt to convince you to vote **NO** on HB 3063...

It is a plea to you as politicians, parents, compassionate human beings; your consideration of implementation of HB 3063 has huge implications, both legal, economic and moral.

Please vote NO:

- By voting NO you would keep the same status quo; it has worked fine for Oregon; There was no pandemic – contrary to what media portrays. There are more children suffering from malnutrition than those exposed to contagious diseases. The exemption rates do not adequately report unvaccinated rates; There is no reason to change the current law.
- Our children – all children – deserve education. It is a right, not a privilege and you can not stop children by putting any medical requirements from attending schools. All medical procedures require consent – there is no reason to have vaccines not follow the same rule.
- United Nations lists “Right to education” as one of human rights. You can not stop children from attending schools by making medical procedures forced and mandatory.
- You are infringing on United Nations law – the “Right to life”, the one that states that “Everyone has the right to life, liberty and security of person”. Vaccines are not always safe. It is clearly described in every single pamphlet, listing death as a potential side effect. You can not force anybody to inject anything that may potentially cause death or injury.
- It would be economically more feasible to create safe environments for immune compromised children than force all exempt children to leave schools.
- Your targeting children for mandatory vaccination is illogical. Children do not “carry” diseases. Outbreaks of contagious diseases are not innate. In the latest case, measles were brought from Philippines – and not by a child. If you claim that you truly want to prevent diseases you are selecting wrong targets. Do not mandate vaccinations to the most vulnerable.
- If you claim that you are introducing HB 3063 with “herd immunity” - please look at your own vaccination record. With true honesty please say when did you have your booster shot of any vaccine? If you haven’t had your measles shot within the last 10 years you are being clearly hypocritical. You are more prone to spread disease than a kindergartener in a closed, rural community.
- You are not to decide in a broad stroke what is good for each family. How can you claim that HepB - the one that is spread by sexual intercourse, sharing syringes or during birth from an infected mother – could be mandatory to all elementary children?
- Vote NO for all those mothers who just testified in the name of their injured children under hashtag #SaidNoMother
- Vote NO for all people with religious objections. There are people who may be morally, religiously not comfortable injecting their own children with vaccines containing “WI-38 human diploid lung fibroblasts” (cell strain derived from lung tissue of a 3-months gestation aborted female fetus). If sanctity of life is important – can you see how contentious this may be?
- Say NO on HB 3063.
