Measure Description:

Requires Oregon Health Policy Board to study changes in health care coverage in Oregon since implementation of Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act and report results of study to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to health.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Health Care to the House Committee on Rules.

The measure requires the Oregon Health Policy Board to collect data regarding changes in health care coverage in Oregon since the passage and implementation of the Affordable Care Act. The board must study the data collected and report to the Legislature by January 1, 2021.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on the Oregon Health Authority.
