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Measure Description:

Allows eligible employee who declines coverage in health benefit plan offered by Oregon Educators Benefit Board or Public Employees' Benefit Board and who is enrolled as spouse or family member in another health benefit plan offered by Oregon Educators Benefit Board or Public Employees' Benefit Board to be paid employer contribution for plan that was declined.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Administrative Services (DAS), Oregon Health Authority (OHA), statewide

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Health Care to the House Committee on Rules.

The measure allows eligible employees who decline coverage in the health benefit plan offered by Oregon Educators Benefit Board or the Public Employees' Benefit Board and who is enrolled as spouse or family member in another health benefit plan offered by the Oregon Educators Benefit Board or the Public Employees' Benefit Board to be paid the employer contribution for the plan that was declined.

The measure is anticipated to have a statewide fiscal impact.
