As a victim of home invasion, please do not limit my ability to protect myself and my family. It was the scariest thing I have ever experienced and I would not wish it on ANYONE.

I'm writing this instead of sharing it live because I was not allowed to sign up to testify in person. 1st Amendment issue?

Section 26.1. Clear over reach. Cities and Metropolitan service districts do not need the legal right to disarm CHL holders in public parks. That is what 26.1 and sub-section b (grounds adjacent) does. If there is a bathroom onsite, Tualatin Hills Park and Recreation as well as Metro, I will have to disarm at home. This makes these locations less safe.

Section 26d. Passenger terminal. Again, over reach. I should be allowed to protect myself while taking my wife to and from the airport drop off terminal and baggage claim.

Section 17. There is a preexisting federal system of registration for home manufactured firearms. They are not firearms until they are completed. Any piece of aluminum or steel in a home shop is a potential firearm.
