I manage 160 acres of forestland in the Oregon Coast Range. We have never used toxic chemicals in managing our forestland but we have experienced aerial spray drift from neighboring industrial forest on several occasions over the last 30 years and we have experience state agency unwillingness to show any concern for the chemical trespass and our health.

SN 926 attempt to provide basic protection for rural landowners and communities with forested drinking water sources has been blocked by industrial timber interests before.

At what point will legislators realize that human health is more important than the toxic use of chemicals to manage forests and in particular, the aerial application in what are steep sloped Coast Range mountains where chemicals are the most likely to drift for miles.

We can only hope that legislators will consider that they will be on the record for blocking this extremely important bill and may be held accountable for be unwilling to protect human health.
