I am a born and raised Oregonian. I have lived in this state for 71 years. I have grown up around guns all my life. Senate bill 978 is egregious to Oregonians. You will NOT make Oregon safer by putting these onerous restrictions on legal gun owners. Criminals already do not obey laws. Why would you try and penalize those who DO obey laws? Because in reality that is what the 44 page amendment does.

Banning CHL holders from certain buildings? People who have obtained CHL's have gone through extensive background checks with the local Sheriff. To penalize CHL holders who have passed a background check demonstrates that there is little faith in background checks. It is a fact that .0002% of CHL holders have ever committed a crime.

Before you sign off on any new confiscatory or overreaching legislation regarding "large capacity" magazines, or firearms in general you may want to read the federal court decision handed down in the last few days which declares unconstitutional California's ban on "high capacity" magazines and negates it in its entirety. The very scholarly and detailed analysis of citizens' rights under the Second Amendment is likely to set the precedent for any new legislation you might pass.
