# HB 3262: The Oregon Taxpayer Reimbursement Act

- 1** Sets definitions, including public assistance and subject employers.
- 2** Establishes Taxpayer Reimbursement Fund to receive and distribute assessments.
- 3** Imposes assessment on subject employers. Describes process.
- 4** Authorizes agencies to share data. Provides certain necessary disclosures, etc.
- 5** Protects employees from employer retaliation.
- 6** Allows DHS to provide certain information in order to determine assessment.
- 7** Allows OHA to provide certain information in order to determine assessment.
- 8-10** Ensures that state reclamation process does not “double dip” when reimbursed.
- 11** Allows assessed employers to audit their assessment, with existing restrictions.
- 12** Authorizes Employment Dept to provide certain data to other agencies for Act.
- 13** Allows BOLI actions to be brought for violations of Section 5.
- 14** Delays assessment to 2022. (No e-clause; Preparation can begin January 2020.)

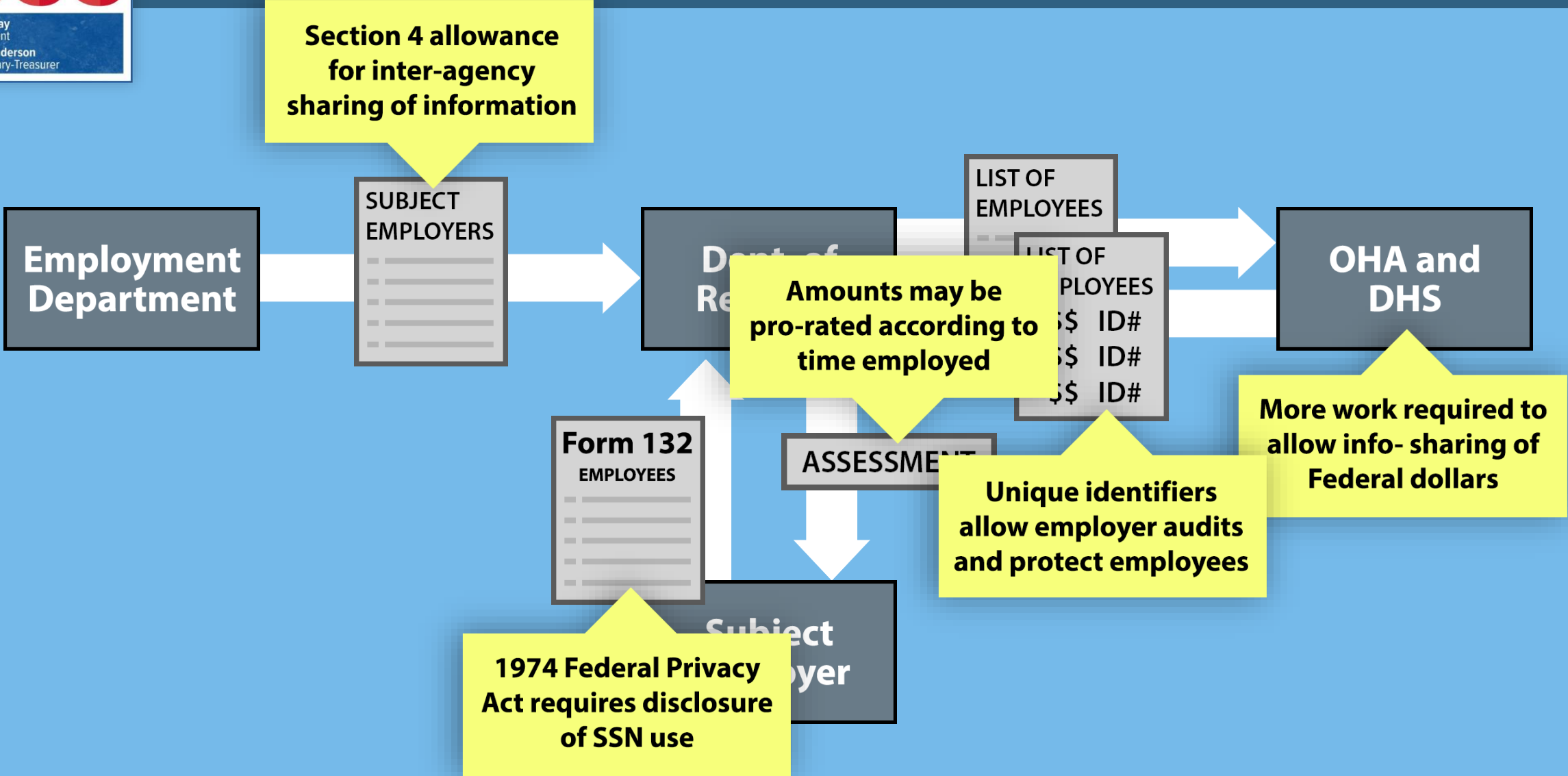
