As a concerned, responsible Oregonian, I am writing to respectfully express my <u>opposition</u> to SB 978 -1.

This is a violation of the Second Amendment, and Oregon's own Constitution ("Article 1, Section 27. Right to bear arms; military subordinate to civil power. The people shall have the right to bear arms for the defence [sic] of themselves, and the State, but the Military shall be kept in strict subordination to the civil power[.]."
