Children are curious and simply "putting a gun out of reach or hidden from sight" is NOT working. Every single day we read another story about a dead child.

Every day, <u>19 children are shot in America</u>, according to a recent study. Nearly <u>1,300 kids under</u> the age of <u>18 die every year</u> from gunshot wounds, and almost <u>6,000 go to the hospital for non-fatal firearm injuries</u>.

Please join nurses and take action to promote and protect the safety of all children.
