**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

Requires Department of Human Services to report to the Legislative Assembly on state laws related to children by January 1, 2021.

**EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:**

The Department of Human Services (DHS) supports individuals and families at times when they have experienced abuse, when they are hungry, and when they are homeless. The mission of DHS is to help Oregonians achieve safety, well-being, and independence through services that protect, empower, respect choice, and preserve dignity. DHS supports children, families, people with intellectual and developmental disabilities, and seniors through five program areas: Child Welfare, Self-Sufficiency, Vocational Rehabilitation, Aging and People with Disabilities, and Intellectual/ Developmental Disabilities.

Senate Bill 171 requires DHS to report, no later than January 1, 2021, to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to human services on state laws related to children.
