To: National Resources Committee and Speaker of the House Tina Kotek:

Please vote no on HB 2795 and HB 3118. These bills seek to turn back what we Oregonians have voted for TWICE in the future: bear bating and bear and cougar hound hunting. Measure 18 banned both of these unsporting practices. We do not want the measure weakened.
