My name is Gerold Floyd and I am a citizen of Dallas, Oregon in Polk county. Committee members I am writing today to express my opposition to SB978.

While I understand that news and social media would lead the public to believe that firearms are to blame for recent incidents of horrible criminal acts, I submit that it is the people who are responsible for those acts. As such, the issue at hand is what is causing people to commit such acts? The real crisis in America and in Oregon is one of mental health and those who cannot associate such actions and their outcomes with consequences. We live in an age where video games glorify killing without consequence and a reset button, while in real life there is no reset button.

The Constitution is clear in the 2nd amendment, the right to bear arms shall not be infringed. Americans have the right to have access to arm themselves to defend themselves and their families. The provisions on SB 978 would seek to destroy the very foundation of providing a defense against those that choose to ignore the law, thereby making more people a victim.
