I am submitting my testimony on SB 978.

The entirety of this bill should be thrown out as it is a violation of individuals rights.

No law made in disagreement with the constitution is legally binding.

A law that mandates you to lock up firearms in your own home is absurd. A firearm owners responsibility is to keep firearms out of reach of those that cannot use firearms safely or are a danger to themselves or others with a firearm. But to make it criminal for the owner because of how they store it is not right. This bill also fails to address criminal elements that steal firearms. That indicates a strong legislative push to vilify and criminalize firearms and their owners. There may be as many as 4.1 million firearms in Oregon, and if firearms or their legal owners where the problem then it would be obvious.
