Environmental Factors


- Proposed 2019-21 budget at current service level
- Tax credit review process and establishment of Joint Committee on Tax Expenditures, plus the Student Success subcommittee on Revenue
- Increased prevalence of revenue related voter initiatives
- Continued interest in tax reform options and their implications
- Federal tax reform impact on Oregon's tax system
- Our LRO/LFO IT Analyst (1 FTE) position was moved to LAC's budget

Impact of 10% Budget Reduction

• Since 89% of LRO's budget is personnel costs, a 10% reduction would likely result in the loss of one of the agency's five economist positions.
