Ladies/Gentlemen of congress:

I understand the fear of firearms that has been generated through heinous crimes in our past, but I have carefully researched the matter through historical analysis, and my research has born out the following facts:

- 1. 56.8% were either on or withdrawing from SSRIs (Serotonin Re-uptake Inhibitors), (prescribed) or from mind altering drugs (Methamphetamine, Cocaine, Heroin, PCP, Marijuana, etc.)
- Persons abusing controlled substances (drugs) are already not allowed to possess firearms.
- Persons on or coming off of SSRIs are not denied access to firearms unless they have been declared a danger to themselves or others (mental health order).
- 2. 34.6% involved persons in a domestic disturbance) usually in a relationship, and not a marriage). In these situations, stalking orders have been issued and ignored, or have been in-process and not in effect yet...
- 3. 46.8% involved persons with a history of mental health issues (having been committed or under psychiatric care. (and who cannot possess firearms at all)
- 4. **36.4%** involved convicted felons, who are legally banned from possession (having contact) with firearms (or weapons).
- 5. **31.1%** involved persons who cannot legally possess (have contact with), or purchase/own firearms because they are under the legal age to purchase/own/possess firearms.
- under 18 years of age to possess/own a long gun (rifle or shotgun).
- Under 21 years of age to possess/own a handgun.
- 6. 24.3% of these incidents occur in a "gun-free" zone (i.e.: school, government building, church or place of worship, on public transportation (bus, train plane), where persns are generally not allowed to be in possession of firearms.
- 7. **9.6%** involved persons with allegiance to some form of religious jihad. (However, these attackers usually kill and injure much greater numbers of persons in a single attack, resulting in a much higher incidence of death/injury over-all.)
- 8. 6.0% of these incident are racially motivated.

I have attached the chart I have compiled to acquire these statistics, but it sometimes does not send in it original fashion.

Obviously the sum of these percentages are greeter than the sample total, because some of these assailants cross over more than one category.

As is plain to see, nearly 100% of these crimes would be prevented if the laws currently in effect were enforced.

However, people enraged/effected by drugs or hate or greed, etc., do not obey the laws anyway, so until the laws we have can be enforced, new laws will only have the effect of preventing or hindering law abiding citizens from being able to defend themselves.

- 1. We need to assure that convicted felons do not acquire/possess firearms.
- Perhaps if persons prescribed SSRIs need to be assessed and certified by the doctors that they are NOT a danger to themselves or others (with the doctors being liable for their actions).
- 3. Persons involved in Domestic disturbances perhaps need to be more closely monitored by doctors and police...
- 4. Our mental health histories (when involving dangers to self and others), need to be incorporated into the LEDS system.
- 5. Persons from foreign countries, according to gun dealers I have known, are able to purchase/possess firearms by simply showing two letters addressed to them at the same address --- even though they are not currently citizens of the United States --- even if they are currently in the USA unlawfully... (Often these persons are not allowed to legally possess firearms in their native country.)
- 6. Persons under the legal age for possession of firearms, should be required to be in the presence of a responsible adult outside their residence, and only allowed possession/use of a firearm within their residence, when certified by a responsible adult, and having been trained by a recognized firearms training authority (e.g.: NRA).
- 7. We need to establish a means of protecting our citizens in 'gun-free' zones (I have developed a realistic plan...)

I believe in a Constitution and its 2nd Amendment Rights guaranteed to law abiding citizens, and I fully understand the history and purpose of that right. History in **EVERY** country that has ever revoked it citizens' right to keep and bear arms, has eventually become a dictatorship, with no rights for it's citizens.

The 2nd Amendment Right is the Amendment that protects all of the other rights enumerated in our constitution.

Prescription Drugs and their effects in causing/contributing to murders, suicides, and mass murders across the USA (and world)

These drugs (listed below) are not the only ones that can cause the opposite of their desired effect. Several anti-depressant medications are also restricted to adults, for the depression they inspire in kids rather than eliminate.

Ambien: depression, anxiety, aggression, agitation, confusion, unusual thoughts, hallucinations, memory problems, changes in personality, risk-taking behavior, decreased inhibitions, no fear of danger, or thoughts of suicide or hurting yourself; daytime drowsiness, dizziness, weakness, feeling "drugged" or light-headed.

Amitriptvine: You may have thoughts about suicide while taking an anti-depressant, especially if you are younger than 24 years old. Tell your doctor if you have worsening depression or suicidal thoughts during the first several weeks of treatment, or whenever your dose is changed.

Anafranil: mood or behavior changes, anxiety, panic attacks, trouble sleeping, or if you feel impulsive, irritable, agitated, hostile, aggressive, restless, hyperactive (mentally or physically), more depressed, or have thoughts about suicide or hurting yourself.

benzodiazapine. [ben"zo-di-az'ĕ-pēn]

...any of a group of drugs having a common molecular structure and similar pharmacological activities, including antianxiety, muscle relaxing, and s edative and hypnoticeffects. The group includes the sedative-

hypnotics<u>chlordiazepoxide</u> (<u>librium</u>), <u>clorazepate</u> (<u>tranxene</u>), <u>diazepam(valium</u>), <u>flurazepam</u> (<u>dalmane</u>), and <u>oxazepam</u> (<u>serax</u>), which areused as <u>antianxiety agents</u>; and <u>clonazepam</u> (<u>klonopin</u>), an<u>anticonvulsant</u>.

Effexor (anti-depressant): The Medical Accountability Network, a private nonprofit focused on medical ethics issues, publicly criticized Wyeth, saying Effexor's "homicidal ideation" risk wasn't well-publicized and that Wyeth failed to send letters to doctors or issue warning labels announcing the change. And what exactly does "rare" mean in the phrase "rare adverse events?" The FDA defines it as occurring in less than one in 1.000 people. But since that same year 19.2 million prescriptions for Effexor were filled in the U.S., statistically that means thousands of Americans might experience "homicidal ideation" - murderous thoughts -as a result of taking just this one brand of anti-depressant drug. Effexor is Wyeth's best-selling drug, by the way, which in one recent year brought in over \$3 billion in sales, accounting for almost a fifth of the company's annual revenues.

Fanapt: restlessness, aggression, and delusion have been reported frequently. Hostility, decreased libido, paranoia, anorgasmia, confusional state, mania, catatonia, mood swings. panic attack, obsessive compulsive disorder, bulimia nervosa, delirium, polydipsia psychogenic, impulse-control disorder, and major depression have been reported infrequently. Fanapt was dropped by its first producer, picked up by another, initially rejected by the FDA, then later picked up and mass produced. The adverse side-effect is said to be "infrequent," but still it exists, and can't be ignored. The reaction invoked by the drug in some people is reminiscent of the Jeffrey R. MacDonald case, where a Green Beret

slaughtered his entire family and then fabricated a story about a marauding troop of "hopped up hippies." MacDonald though, had Eskatrol in his system, a weight-loss amphetamine that's since been banned in part for its side effects of psychotic behavior and aggression.

Lexipro: mood or behavior changes, anxiety, panic attacks, trouble sleeping, or if you feel impulsive, irritable, agitated, hostile, aggressive, restless, hyperactive (mentally or physically), more depressed, or have thoughts about suicide or hurting yourself.

Lithium: hallucinations, seizure (blackout or convulsions.)

Luvox: mood or behavior changes, anxiety, panic attacks, trouble sleeping, or if you feel impulsive, irritable, agitated, hostile, aggressive, restless, hyperactive (mentally or physically), more depressed, or have thoughts about suicide or hurting yourself.

Mirtazapine: anxiety, panic attacks, trouble sleeping, or if you feel impulsive, irritable, agitated, hostile, aggressive, restless, hyperactive (mentally or physically), more depressed, or have thoughts about suicide or hurting yourself.

Paxil: mood or behavior changes, anxiety, panic attacks, trouble sleeping, or if you feel impulsive, irritable, agitated, hostile, aggressive, restless, hyperactive (mentally or physically), more depressed, or have thoughts about suicide or hurting yourself, agitation, hallucinations, fever, fast heart rate, overactive reflexes, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, feeling unsteady, loss of coordination, fainting, headache, trouble concentrating, memory problems, weakness, confusion, hallucinations, fainting, seizure, shallow breathing or breathing that stops.

Prozac: headache, trouble concentrating, memory problems, weakness, confusion, hallucinations, fainting, seizure, shallow breathing or breathing that stops.

Ritalin: aggression, restlessness, hallucinations, unusual behavior, or motor tics (muscle twitches); dangerously high blood pressure (severe headache, blurred vision, buzzing in your ears, anxiety, confusion, chest pain, shortness of breath, uneven heartbeats, seizure.)

Suboxone is a habit-forming drug that has been connected with sudden outbursts of aggression.

Thorazine: unusual thoughts or behavior; feeling restless, jittery, or agitated.

Trazodone: mood or behavior changes, anxiety, panic attacks, trouble sleeping, or if you feel impulsive, irritable, agitated, hostile, aggressive, restless, hyperactive (mentally or physically), more depressed, or have thoughts about suicide or hurting yourself; extreme mood swings, restlessness, or sleep problems; agitation, hallucinations, fast heart rate, overactive reflexes, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, loss of coordination.

Temazepam: confusion, slurred speech, unusual thoughts or behavior; hallucinations, agitation, aggression; thoughts of suicide or hurting yourself.

Valium: (diazepam): confusion, hallucinations, unusual thoughts or behavior; unusual risk-taking behavior, decreased inhibitions, no fear of danger; depressed mood, thoughts of suicide or hurting yourself; hyperactivity, agitation, aggression, hostility.

Venlafaxine: (the active ingredient contained in Effexor): agitation, hallucinations, fever, fast heart rate, overactive reflexes, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, loss of coordination.

Vicodin: confusion, fear, unusual thoughts or behavior; anxiety, dizziness, drowsiness; headache, mood changes.

Wellbutrin: mood or behavior changes, anxiety, panic attacks, trouble sleeping, or if you feel impulsive, irritable, agitated, hostile, aggressive, restless, hyperactive (mentally or physically), more depressed, or have thoughts about suicide or hurting yourself.

Xanax: depressed mood, thoughts of suicide or hurting yourself, unusual risk-taking behavior, decreased inhibitions, no fear of danger; confusion, hyperactivity, agitation, hostility, hallucinations.

Zoloft: mood or behavior changes, anxiety, panic attacks, trouble sleeping, or if you feel impulsive, irritable, agitated, hostile, aggressive, restless, hyperactive (mentally or physically), more depressed, or have thoughts about suicide or hurting yourself.

Below I have color-coded the 'contributing factors' in the murders brief biographies listed below.

Abdulazeez, Mohammod Youssuf, 24: a devout Muslim who kept in touch with his roots in the Middle East., Accused Chattanooga gunman reportedly texted a friend a link to an Islamic verse the night before embarking on a shooting spree. Kuwaiti-born a naturalized US citizen, opened fire at a Naval reserve center, and then drove to a military recruitment office where he shot and killed four Marines and a Navy service member, and wounded a police officer and another military service member. He was then fatally shot in an exchange of gunfire with law enforcement officers responding to the attack. He had been treated by a child psychiatrist for depression,... In May 2013, Abdulazeez lost his job at a nuclear power plant in Ohio due to a failed drug test,... He taking sleep-aide medicines...and had a prescription for muscle relaxants for his back problem.
- 2. Adamcik, Torey Michael, 15: (see Brian Lee Draper): former American high school students who are currently serving life sentences without the possibility for parole, for murdering their classmate Cassie Jo Stoddart on September 22, 2006. [2] in Pocatello, ID (Zoloft) in 1998 had a Zoloft-induced seizure that caused an armed stand off at his school.
- 3. Adams, Robert Lee jr, 27 (shooter) and 16-year-old Jordyn D. Wade: who is also been charged in the murder.: Columbus, OH, 6/13/15 The shooter killed a man, the man's daughter, and two other victims inside the man's home. He also shot and injured a 16-year-old girl. Handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: The shooter was prohibited from possessing firearms due to a 2008 felony robbery conviction.
- 4. Adair, Tyrone 38; Madison, WI, 12/3/09 The shooter killed two women with whom he was involved in paternity cases, along with their daughters, before shooting himself in his car.--- over the years there were are one disorderly conduct charge (which could mean anything), two battery misdemeanors (which also could mean anything) and three temporary domestic violence restraining orders... GUN DETAILS: Two handguns were found inside the vehicle where Adair died, one of which matched the caliber of the ammunition used in the murders. GUN ACQUIRED: Police report that Adair bought a 9mm gun that was advertised on Craigslist. This gun was likely transferred in a private sale. PROHIBITING CRITERIA: The shooter was prohibiting from possessing firearms due to an active restraining order involving a third woman. He had also been arrested in March 2009 after a domestic incident, but charges were not filed in that case.
- 5. Aldridge, Joseph Jesse, 50: Tyrone, MO, 2/26/15 The shooter went door to door in his neighborhood, shooting and killing four of his cousins and shooting four unrelated neighbors, killing three of them. Afterwards he fled the scene and ultimately shot and killed himself in his car. Neighbors described Aldridge as a recluse within an intimate community, and none knew him well. He mostly mooched off his mother and relished drugs and weapons, said a former friend GUN DETAILS: .45-caliber handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: The shooter was prohibited from possessing firearms due to a 2008 felony conviction for possession of a firearm and drugs by an unlawful user of a controlled substance. Aldridge's autopsy showed he had a 0.256 percent blood-alcohol content more than three times the legal limit to drive in Missouri as well as marijuana and over-the-counter painkillers and allergy medicine in his system.

- 6. Alexis, Aaron, 34, a military veteran and contractor from Texas, Alturas tribal shooting 2/20/2014 Alturas, CA, Alexis created a webpage with the name "Mohammed Salem", relative said he acted in retaliation for U.S. wars in Muslim opened fire in the Navy installation, killing 12 people and wounding 8 before being shot dead by police. Washington, D.C.
- 7. Avila-Alva, Jose 24: Bay City, TX, 11/30/11 The shooter and his wife argued in their mobile home, and when she exited he shot her three times in the front yard, injuring her, before killing his four children aged 2 to 5 and then killing himself. GUN DETAILS: .22-caliber revolver GUN ACQUIRED: The handgun was reported stolen in 2010. PROHIBITING CRITERIA: The shooter was not a legal resident of the U.S., and had been deported to Mexico in 2006 for unlawful entry, which would have prohibited him from purchasing a gun. One week earlier, on November 22, 2011, the shooter's wife filed an assault report against him and was taken to a crisis center by police, but she did not press charges.
- 8. Anderson, Cedric, 42: Villa Park, IL, 1/17/12 The shooter killed his girlfriend, her two sons, and her niece while they slept. After leaving the scene of the crime he shot himself and died of his injuries. • GUN DETAILS: .357 Magnum handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: Anderson has several drug-related offenses dating back to 1990, and in 2008 received probation for possessing a firearm without the required license. On December 29, 2011 was convicted of felony heroin possession, and was awaiting sentencing at the time of the massacre. He was therefore prohibited from possessing a gun.
- 9. Ashbrook, Larry Gene, 47: (1999) On Sept. 15, 1999, Larry Gene Ashbrook murdered seven people and injured a further seven at a concert by Christian Rock group Forty Days at Wedgwood Baptist Church in Fort Worth, Texas. Ashbrook then committed suicide. A doctor had prescribed the anti-depressant drug Prozac for Larry Gene Ashbrook, but investigators are unsure whether he was taking Prozac when he killed seven people and then himself in a Fort Worth church last week, police said on Monday. Fort Worth's Lt. Mark Krey, who is heading the investigation into the largest mass shooting in the city's history, said police have found a Prozac vial in Ashbrook's name.
- 10. **Atwater, Alan M.**, 31: who killed his wife and three children in Oak Harbor, infidelity and verbal abuse, Ohio in 2011, .22-caliber rifle, shotgun
- 11. Auvinen, , Pekka-Eric, 18: 7 November 2007 at <u>Jokela High School</u> in <u>Jokela</u>, a town in the municipality of <u>Tuusula</u>, <u>Finland</u>. Finnish gunman Pekka-Eric Auvinen, age 18, had been taking antidepressants before he killed eight people and wounded a dozen more at Jokela High School then he committed suicide.
- 12. **Baadsgaard, Cory age 16**, Apr 2, 2013: Wahluke (Washington state) High School, was on Paxil (which caused him to have hallucinations) when he took **a rifle** to his high school and held 23 classmates hostage. He has no memory of the event.
- 13. **Baker, William D. 66:** Feb. 5, 2001: Melrose Park 5 Dead (including perp), 4 Wounded. State records show that Baker received his FOID (Firearm Owners Identification card) card in February 1993, and renewed it on May 8, 1998. That was just two weeks before his **conviction for sexual assault**. "The fact that he was a **convicted felon** and had four weapons on him that weren't confiscated is amazing to us," said Kirsten Curley, a spokeswoman for the Illinois Council Against Handgun Violence.

- 14. **Bannister, James Edward**, 31: Marion County, FL, 8/5/11 The shooter killed the mother of his child in her mother's home, his own 6-year-old sister, and two other acquaintances before setting the building on fire. Court records indicated he had smoked synthetic marijuana laced with cocaine prior to the murders. The gun was not immediately recovered. GUN DETAILS: Believed to be a .38-caliber revolver GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: There is no evidence that he had a prohibiting criminal record (Do you, or have you ever used a controlled substance/mind altering substance...?)
- 15. <u>Barker, Diana, 71</u>, accidentally shot (not fatal) by .38 derringer from concealed carry permit holder, who dropped the gun out of his pocket, causing the discharge. January 13, 2011. KINGWOOD, Texas
- 16. Barton, Mark Orrin 44: July 29, 1999: Stockbridge, GA Police found Prozac in his van after the shootings. 13 Dead (including perp), 12 Wounded.
- 17. **Bean**, **Jeremiah** 25: Fernley, NV, 5/13/13 The shooter killed five people in a spree following a home invasion, in which he stole \$3,500 in cash and jewelry. GUN DETAILS: NEF Co. Model R92 .22-caliber handgun. The shooter also **stole** a **Smith & Wesson from one of his victims.** GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: The shooter had been **previously convicted for felony charges of burglary and grand larceny**, and finished his **parole** in December 2012. This criminal record prohibited him from possessing firearms.
- 18. **Belknap**, **James Roy** 27 •Leivasy, WV, 5/19/12 The shooter **killed a man** after a dispute over **a debt for drugs**, as well as **his girlfriend and their two children**. GUN DETAILS: Unknown GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: In 2007, Belknap **pled guilty on charges of conspiracy to deliver cocaine** and was sentenced to 5 years in prison. In exchange, prosecutors dismissed a grand jury indictment **charging him with murder**. He was therefore **prohibited from possessing a gun**.
- 19. Bellar, Troy, 34: May 3, 2009: Lakeland, FL, Tegretol a drug prescribed for "bi-polar disorder, shot and killed his wife and two of his three children in their home before killing himself. —. 4 Dead (including perp), 0 Wounded
- 20. **Bellard, Darrell, 43**, a drug relationship that went very bad, killed four people (including children aged 4 and 3) in Lanham, Maryland in 2010. **Tkeisha Gilmer**, 18, joined him Ballard in blocking the escape of the victims. **Gilmer was bipolar and schizophrenic and had other mental health issues.** (http://www.cnn.com/2010/US/08/07/maryland.arrests/index.html). !
- 21. Bennett, David Cornell, jr (<u>Black man</u>), 22: basically stalking her and wouldn't leave her alone, killed a <u>young white mother</u> and her 3 (1/2 black) children, after raping the mother, in Parsons, Kansas in 2013, psychological and sociological history, was sent to a state psychiatric hospital one month before the shooting. He had posted a threatening message on Facebook that had been flagged to local police. (http://www.nydailynews.com/news/crime/police-hunt-suspect-kansas-mom-article-Biker gang brawl:
- 22. **Bennett**, **Jacob Allen**, 26 and **Moser**, **Brittany Lina Yvonn**, 25: Crab Orchard, TN, 9/11/13 The shooters killed a woman and three teenagers, apparently during an attempted robbery during a **marijuana exchange**. The victims' bodies were

- discovered in a car parked along the side of the road in the Renegade Mountain resort community near Crossville. GUN DETAILS: Handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: **Bennett was prohibited from possessing firearms**. In 2010 he received a 6-year prison sentence for charges of **theft, forgery, and possession of a handgun during a felony**, but was paroled on March 4, 2013. The Cumberland County sheriff's office estimated they had previously **arrested Bennett five times**.
- 23. <u>Bishop, Amy, 44</u>: professor, February 12, 2010: <u>University of Alabama in Huntsville</u>, (UAH) in <u>Huntsville</u>, Alabama, shooting those closest to her with a <u>9-millimeter</u> handgun. Three people were killed and three others wounded in a shooting on. She had been denied tenure...
- 24. **Boren, Joshua 34: Spanish Fork, UT**, 1/16/14 The shooter, an **officer in the Lindon City Police Department**, shot and **killed his two children, his wife, and her mother** inside of their family home before killing himself. GUN DETAILS: Handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: Several months prior to the shooting the shooter and his wife had separated and one of her friends reported that she was going to file for divorce because she could no longer tolerate her husband's rage. But he did not have a history domestic abuse or felony convictions, and there is no evidence that he was prohibited from possessing a gun.
- 25. Bournes, Michael, 59: Missoula, MT, 6/07/15 The shooter killed his wife and their three children ages one, four, and five in their home. He then set the house on fire and committed suicide with the gun. GUN DETAILS: .45-caliber handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: Despite a previous criminal history, the shooter was likely prohibited from possessing firearms. In 1999, he was convicted in New Mexico of three misdemeanor crimes: fleeing from an officer, concealing his identity, and resisting, evading or obstructing an officer.
- 26. **Bowser, Erbie Lee,** 44: Dallas, TX, 8/7/13: shot and killed his **girlfriend and her daughter, and injured two others;** and then in a separate attack **shot and killed his estranged wife and her daughter, and injured another two people.** He also detonated an explosive but it did not harm anyone. GUN DETAILS: .380 pistol GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: The shooter's estranged wife had obtained **a protective order against Bowser** in February 2011, citing family violence, and he **was later arrested for violating the order**. The order seems to have expired in February 2012, but would likely have been prohibiting while it was in place. A **criminal conviction for domestic violence**, which would also likely have been prohibiting, was expunged from his Analysis of Recent MASS SHOOTINGS record after he completed a court program for veterans in the summer of 2012. Bowser was a veteran, but he had not served in combat making him ineligible to enter the program. He apparently lied about his military history in order to enter the program.
- 27. **Brantley, Derrick** 21 and **Deshanon Haywood**, 21: Akron, OH, 4/18/13 The shooters **killed four people** inside a townhouse; the initial motive for the crime was reportedly robbery. PROHIBITING CRITERIA: One shooter, **Brantley, was free on bond awaiting trial on felony charges** of heroin trafficking. The other, **Haywood, was paroled from prison** in February 2012 after serving part of a two-year sentence for cocaine trafficking and heroin possession. He **immediately violated his parole** and was sentenced to 45 days of house arrest.

- 28. **Brazzon, Robert** 55: Newton Falls, OH, 7/6/12 The shooter **killed his girlfriend, another couple, and their son in two separate shootings,** before being cornered by the police and killing himself. • GUN DETAILS: Unknown GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: Brazzon had previously **pled guilty to felony drug trafficking** after **police seized 47 guns from his home in 1999** (the guns were later returned to Brazzon's brother and son following a court petition). **Federal firearms laws prevent the possession of firearms by a convicted felon.**
- 29. Brownlow, Charles Everett, 36: killed 5 people in an 8 hour crime spree in Terrell, Texas in 2013, mother is dead. So is his aunt. The same goes for two of his acquaintances, plus a convenience store worker. Brownlow appeared to be on drugs when he was arrested, and mental health history. A criminal record that prohibited him from possessing firearms. He was convicted of burglarizing a vehicle in 1996, a Class A misdemeanor, and convicted of felony burglary in 1997. In 2008 he was served a three---year sentence for unlawful possession of a firearm and in 2011 he was convicted of misdemeanor assault against a family member. (http://www.huffingtonpost.com/2013/10/29/texas-killing-spree_n_4172729.html). !
- 30. Burks, Adrian, 37 Kansas City, KS, 6/22/09 The shooter killed a woman with whom he had been romantically linked and three others at the house where she was staying. He had argued with the woman and followed her to the house. GUN DETAILS: Unknown GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: The shooter was prohibited from possessing firearms. He had served 10 years in Kansas prisons for robbery, aggravated assault, and burglary. He also fatally shot a man in March 2009, but he was not charged in the incident, which his cousin later described as "self defense." In April 2009, he was charged with battery and a criminal threat against the sister of the man he killed and was ordered not to possess firearms.
- 31. **Bush**, **Elizabeth**; **age 13**, (Paxil/Prozac) was responsible for a school shooting in Pennsylvania
- 32. **Butwin, James** 47: Tempe, AZ, 6/2/12 The shooter **killed his wife and three children** inside of their home, then drove the bodies to a location in the Vekol Valley desert, where he lit the car on fire and shot himself. His wife had filed for a divorce earlier in the year but he had not vacated their shared residence. He was also reportedly **undergoing treatment for a brain tumor**. GUN DETAILS: Two guns were recovered in the vehicle, and the caliber of the shells for one matched those found in the house where the murders took place. GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: There is no evidence that Butwin was prohibited from owning a gun.
- 33. Carneal, Michael (1997) In Paducah, KY, in late 1997, 14-year-old Michael Carneal, son of a prominent attorney, Ruger MK II .22-caliber pistol in his backpack. travelled to Heath High School and started shooting students in a prayer meeting taking place in the school's lobby, killing three and leaving another paralyzed. Carneal reportedly was on Ritalin.
- 34. Carter, Calvin Lewis III, 22 Rockford, IL, 12/20/14 The shooter went to his ex-girlfriend's home and fatally shot her, her two children, and her boyfriend. GUN DETAILS: Handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: There is no evidence that the shooter was prohibited from possessing firearms.

- 35. Carter, Orlando, 20; Simms, Nathaniel D. 26; and unnamed 14-year-old juvenile.: Washington, DC, 3/30/10 Three gunmen killed four and wounded five in retaliation for another murder. GUN DETAILS: An AK-47 assault rifle and 9mm and .45-caliber handguns GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: The adults were reported to have lengthy criminal histories, which prohibited them from purchasing guns, and the 14-year-old was too young to purchase or own a gun.
- 36. **Castillo, Alvaro Rafael, 19:** Aug. 30, 2006: Hillsborough, NC On drugs for depression. 1 Dead, 2 Wounded.
- 37. Celaya, Hector, 31: Tule River Reservation, CA, 12/8/12 The shooter killed his mother and two uncles in the travel trailer where they lived and injured his young son; he then shot his two daughters, one fatally, while fleeing with them from the police. The gunman died after a shootout with police in which he also shot himself in the head. GUN DETAILS: .38-caliber revolver PROHIBITING CRITERIA: Celaya had been imprisoned in 2008 for an assault and battery charge and was prohibited from having weapons. He was subsequently arrested multiple times for driving while intoxicated, and was due in court in January 2013 to face a misdemeanor drug possession charge.
- 38. Cho, Seung-Hui (2007), 23: Seung-Hui Cho was a Korean spree killer who killed 32 people and wounded 17 others on April 16, 2007, at Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University in Blacksburg, Virginia. He was a senior-level undergraduate student at the university. The shooting rampage came to be known as the "Virginia Tech massacre." Cho later committed suicide after law enforcement officers breached the doors of the building where the majority of the shooting had taken place. His body is buried in Fairfax, Va., In middle school, he was diagnosed with a severe anxiety disorder known as Selective Mutism, as well as major depressive disorder. After this diagnosis he began receiving treatment and continued to receive therapy and special education support until his junior year of high school. During Cho's last two years at Virginia Tech, several instances of his abnormal behavior, as well as plays and other writings he submitted containing references to violence, caused concern among teachers and classmates. In the aftermath of the Virginia Tech massacre, Virginia Governor Tim Kaine convened a panel consisting of various officials and experts to investigate and examine the response and handling of issues related to the shootings. The panel released its final report in August 2007, devoting more than 30 pages to detailing Cho's troubled history. In the report, the panel criticized the failure of the educators and mental health professionals who came into contact with Cho during his college years to notice his deteriorating condition and help him. Like the perpetrators of both the Columbine and Jokela school massacres, Cho was prescribed the anti-depressant drug Paroxetine (Paxil) in 1999, officials said prescription medications related to the treatment of psychological problems had been found among Mr. Cho's effects." prior to his rampage, Paroxetine is a substance suspected by Peter Breggin and David Healy of leading to suicidal behaviors. ... Walther P-22 pistol he purchased online on February 2 from an out-of-state dealer at JND Pawn shop in Blacksburg, a 9mm Glock pistol and 50 rounds of ammunition from Roanoke Firearms for \$571.
- 39. **Christian, Gareth 18; Vancouver,** was on Paxil when he committed suicide in 2002, (Gareth's father could not accept his son's death and killed himself.)
- 40. Carrillo, Christopher, 25: Tucson, AZ, 5/13/15 The shooter fatally shot his parents, his brother, and his brother's daughter in the family's home, and then fatally shot himself. Family members said he had a history of mental illness GUN

- DETAILS: 9mm handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: There is no evidence that the shooter was prohibited from possessing firearms.
- 41. Clark, Dennis III, 27, Santa Monica rampage, Pinewood Village Apartment shooting, Federal Way, Washington; 4/21/2013; shot and killed his girlfriend in their shared apartment, and then shot two witnesses in the building's parking lot and a third victim in another apartment, before being killed by police....history of domestic violence, and yet issued a Concealed Carry License
- 42. Clemmons, Maurice, 37:: Nov. 29, 2009: Parkland, WA shot and killed 4 police officers at a restaurant, sentenced to 95 years in prison in Arkansas for robberies, burglaries, thefts, and taking a gun to school, among other crimes (child rape). In 2000, after Clemmons had served 11 years, then-Gov. Mike Huckabee commuted his sentence on the recommendation of the parole board, which had determined he had met all the conditions for early release, self-medicating with Marijuana. Noted "Mental Illness Does Cause Violence". 5 Dead (including perp), 0 Wounded.
- 43. **Conant, Everett 35**: Wheatland, Wyoming in 2011, http://www.wyomingnews.com/articles/2011/07/09/news/01top_07-09-11.txt). ! WY: Wheatland father Everett Conant III, shot-gun murders of three children, and brother. Two the children competed in the Special Olympics. Conant is also charged with shooting his wife. His wife later reported he had become upset because he wanted to keep the curtains of their home drawn to prevent the neighbors from looking inside. Conant and his wife had recently discussed divorce. He just shot them.
- 44. Conway, Samuel, (23); Stringer, Marvin Lamar (22); and Pickney, Jeremy (23), all Black: killed five people in Arkansas in 2009, These were later identified as 56-year-old Edward Gentry Jr., his 52-year-old wife Pam, their 24-year-old son Jeremy, and Jeremy's 19-year-old girlfriend Kristyn Warneke (all white). They had all been shot to death. ... the body of 80-year-old Edward Gentry Sr. was ... shot to death execution style ... burglarized: flat-screen televisions, guns, and two sets of rims and tires had been stolen. Police records state, the killers "stayed awhile" after they killed the victims which indicates in other similar robbery-murders that they tortured and raped their victims before killing them. [1] (http://www.arkansasonline.com/news/2009/nov/20/authorities-shoot-kill-suspect-5- pearcy-deaths/). !
- 45. Coon, Asa, 14: from Cleveland, age 14, SuccessTech Academy shot and wounded four before taking his own life. Court records show Coon was on Trazodone.
- 46. **Cooper, Shawn, 15:** April 16, 1999: Notus, ID: Antidepressant and Ritalin. **Shawn Cooper** of Notus, Idaho took a 12-gauge shot gun to school and started firing, injuring one student and holding the school hostage for about 20 minutes. 0 Dead, 1 Wounded.
- 47. **Dann, Laurie** (1988) In 1988, 31-year-old Laurie Dann went on a shooting rampage in a second-grade classroom in Winnetka, IL, killing one child and wounding six. She had been taking the **anti-depressant Anafranil as well as Lithium**, long used to treat mania.
- 48. Dantzler, Roderick, 34: July 7, 2011: Grand Rapids, MI (Black x-convict) Reported to have stopped medication for "Bipolar" before the shooting. 8 Dead (2 x-white girlfriends, their 3 children, and their mother and father (and self), 2 Wounded
- 49. Danysh, Kurt; age 18, and on Prozac, 1996, killed his father with a shotgun. Danvsh's description of own his mental-emotional state at the time of the murder is chilling: "I didn't realize I did it until after it was done." Danysh said. "This might sound weird,

- but it felt like I had no control of what I was doing, like I was left there just holding a gun.". ...He now writes letters, trying to warn the world that SSRI drugs can kill.
- 49. Davis, Fred B., **53**: Apr. 26, 2009: shot and killed a police officer and wounded a sheriff's deputy who had responded to a call that Davis had threatened a neighbor with a gun. Prescription drug bottles found at the scene showed that Davis was prescribed the anti-psychotic drug Geodon" (ziprasidone) used to treat schizophrenia and the manic symptoms of bipolar disorder . 1 Dead, 1 Wounded.
- 50. Dekraai, Scott Evans, 41; (2012) Eight people died in a shooting at Salon Meritage hair salon in Seal Beach,
 Calif. The gunman, 41-year-old Scott Evans Dekraai, killed six women and two men dead, while just one woman survived. It was Orange County's deadliest mass killing. At Dekraai's Oct. 14 arraignment hearing, which at the request of defense attorney Robert Curtis was continued to Nov. 29 so he would have more time to prepare, the lawyer asked Judge Erick L. Larsh to order jail officials to give his client a prescribed anti-psychotic medicine and access to a "spinal cord stimulator" he has needed since his 2007 boat accident. Larsh instead ordered a medical evaluation of Dekraai to see what medicine he might need, leaving it up to the Orange County Sheriff's Department jailers to decide what was appropriate.
- 51. Dell, Patrick 41: Riviera Beach, FL, 9/27/10 The shooter killed his estranged wife and four of his stepchildren in their home, injured one other, sparing his biological children, and then shot and killed himself. • GUN DETAILS: Handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: In May 2010, the shooter's wife obtained a restraining order, which was active at the time of the shooting and would have prohibited him from possessing a firearm. In December 2009, Dell has also been arrested on felony aggravated assault, and had been convicted of misdemeanor improper exhibition of a dangerous firearm. Police had responded to 34 calls from the household in the four years preceding the shooting. In April 2008, the shooter's wife had taken out another restraining order against Dell for abusive behavior.
- 52. Diaddinne, Driss: 50 Phoenix, AZ, 5/13/15 The shooter fatally shot his mother (76-year-old Kenza Benzakour), two brothers, (38-year-old Reda Diaeddinn and 56-year-old Dodi Fayed); and a sister-in-law (26-year-old Meriem Ben Yahia) in the home they all shared, and then fatally shot himself. The family had origins in Morocco. The suspect and two other brothers were reportedly in an on-going feud about a transportation and restaurant business the family owned; and police said it appears the suspect snapped... GUN DETAILS: Semiautomatic handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: There is no evidence that the shooter was prohibited from possessing firearms.
- 53. Diez, Brian, 26: Lake Havasu City, AZ, 8/29/10 The shooter killed his ex-girlfriend, her boyfriend, and three others while they were celebrating her boyfriend's birthday and took his own life later that night. GUN DETAILS: Unknown GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: The shooter was prohibited from possessing a firearm at the time of the shooting due to a prior conviction: In July 2010, one month before the killings, he was convicted of assaulting his infant son.
- 54. **Do, Tan,** 35: Grand Prairie, TX, 6/23/11 The shooter **killed his wife and four of her family members** at his daughter's birthday party before killing himself. GUN DETAILS: Reported to be a handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: Tan Do had a **history of domestic violence**. His wife **had obtained a protective order** against him but had withdrawn it earlier that year against the advice of a prosecutor.

- 55. Draper, Brian Lee; 15 years old (born in 1990) and Torey Michael Adamcik, 15 years old (born June 14, 1990)[1] are former American high school students who are currently serving life sentences without the possibility for parole, for murdering their classmate Cassie Jo Stoddart on September 22, 2006.[2] in Pocatello, ID (Zoloft) in 1998 had a Zoloft-induced seizure that caused an armed stand off at his school.
- 56. Dufrene, Kesler, 23: In 2012, Haitian immigrant, murdered as many people in Miami as Robert Dear did in Colorado Springs. One of Dufrene's victims was a 15-year-old girl. Dufrene had already been Twice convicted convicted of felonies in the United States, so he should have been deported, but our "Deporter in Chief" Obama had blocked his return to Haiti. As the murdered girl's mother said, "Because of immigration, my daughter is not alive." Have you ever heard of Dufrene? I don't think his murders got as much press as the "Planned Parenthood" shooting.
- 57. **Dyess, Carey H.,** 73: Yuma, AZ, 6/2/11 In a series of separate shootings over a five-hour period, a gunman shot and killed his ex-wife, three of her friends, and her attorney, before killing himself. • GUN DETAILS: Handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: Dyess's ex-wife alleged there had been domestic abuse and a judge had issued an order of protection against him in 2006, but there is no evidence that he was a prohibited from possessing firearms at the time of the shooting. He held a Concealed Handgun License (Domestic protection order should have prevented the License from being issued.)
- 58. Eagle, Kalcie Leroy (Four Bears Nux-Bizi Dobish), 21: New Town, ND, 11/18/12 The shooter murdered a woman and her three grandchildren in their home on Fort Berthold Indian Reservation. When confronted by police he stabbed himself in the neck and died of his injuries. • GUN DETAILS: .25-06 hunting rifle GUN ACQUIRED: The rifle was stolen from a family member. PROHIBITING CRITERIA: In March 2012, Eagle was arrested in a stolen pickup truck after a high-speed chase with police. He pled guilty to felony unauthorized use of a vehicle, and was sentenced to a year in jail, with more than three years of supervised probation and more than \$45,000 in fines and restitution. Because of this offense, he was prohibited from possessing a firearm.
- 59. Egland, Leonard, 37 Chesterfield, VA 8/27/11 The shooter, a veteran of the U.S. Army, killed his estranged wife, her boyfriend, his seven-year-old child, and another adult female at a home. He then went to another home and fatally shot his mother-in-law. When police pulled him over, he shot at them, injuring one officer. He fled and was found in a wooded area dead of a self-inflicted gunshot. GUN DETAILS: Handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: There is no evidence that the shooter was prohibited from possessing firearms.
- 60. England, Jacob Carl, 21; and Alvin Lee Watts, 34: Apr. 6, 2012: Tulsa, OK Hate crimes <u>targeting black victims</u>, and <u>Taking medication for depression</u>. 3 Dead, 2 Wounded
- 61. **Engeldinger, Andrew, 36: (2012)** Five were shot to death by 36-year-old Andrew Engeldinger at Accent Signage Systems in Minneapolis, Minn. Three others were wounded. Engeldinger went on a rampage after losing his job, ultimately killing himself. A police search of the home of Accent Signage Systems shooter Andrew Engeldinger found **medications commonly prescribed for depression and insomnia**, according to a Minneapolis Police Department report. Police found prescription bottles for two anti-depressant

- medications. **Mirtazapine and Trazodone, and for Temazepam**, a medication used to treat insomnia, in Engeldinger's home. They also found many empty prescription bottles, including 18 empty prescription bottles for a generic form of the anti-depressant drug **Wellbutrin**. According to the police report, all of the prescriptions bottles bore Engeldinger's name.
- 62. Farook, Syed Rizwan (28) and his wife, Tashfeen Malik (27): 12/3/2015; Muslim Jihadists, San Bernardino Mass Shooting San Bernardino, Ca left a Christmas party held at Inland Regional Center, later returning heavily armed and the two opened fire, killing 14 and wounding 21, ten critically. The two were later killed by police as they fled in an SUV.
- 63. **Fetters, Chris; age 13**, mis-diagnosed as bipolar disorder, killed his favorite aunt while taking Prozac.
- 64. Flack, Kyle 27: Ottawa, KS, 4/28/13 The shooter raped and killed a woman, as well as killing her 18-month-old daughter and two men who were with her at a farm in eastern Kansas. GUN DETAILS: Unknown GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: In 2005 the shooter was convicted of attempted murder in the 2nd degree, having shot a man five times with a pistol, but he only served two years of a five-year sentence and was paroled in July 2009. He was required to register as a violent offender until 2024 and was prohibited from possessing firearms. His mother also sought mental health treatment on his behalf; her concerns were dismissed, but Flack ultimately submitted to a mental health evaluation.
- 65. Flanagan, Vester, 41-year-old, Aug 26, 2015 ... Vester Lee Flanagan, AKA Bryce Williams, is the alleged shooter who killed reporter Alison Parker and cameraman Adam Ward of WDBJ-TV, x-employee, took a cocktail of anti-depressants before his shooting spree.
- 66. Floyd, Zane, 24: June 3, 1999: Las Vegas, NV born September 20, 1975, --- Treated for ADHD and Depression with antidepressants at age 13 (in 1989). 4 Dead, 1 Wounded.
- 67. Flores, Robert S., 41: Oct. 24, 2002: Tucson, AZ In a letter he wrote prior to the shooting and suicide, he said, "I realize that I am depressed but even with treatment it will not change my future.... It's not about anger because I don't feel anything right now." A professor at the university where the shooting occurred said that it was "common knowledge among the faculty that Flores was depressed." 4 Dead (including perp), 0 Wounded.
- 68. **Franklin**, **Jeffrey**, **17**; is serving three life sentences for killing his parents with an axe and a sledge hammer, and slashing one sibling and almost murdering another in 1998.in Huntsville, Alabama. Taking Prozac and massive amounts of Ritalin, he went psychotic...
- 69. **Fryberg, Jaylen: 15, Marysville-Pilchuck High School shooting,** Marysville, WA, 10/24/2014 using a .**40-caliber Berretta**, shot five students at Marysville High School, including two of his cousins and three friends, killing all but one. Fryberg arranged to meet them for lunch in the school cafeteria by text. Fryberg was reportedly well-liked at the school and there was not believed to be any ill-will between him and his victims. He committed suicide at the scene. **At the age of 15, the shooter was unlawfully in possession of a handgun.** The **gun belonged to the shooter's father**, who was himself under a **permanent restraining order that prohibited him from possessing firearms** under federal law. But the order had been issued in a Tribal Court and was not

- entered into the federal criminal background check database, so the man was able to pass a background check at a licensed gun dealer and acquire the gun.
- 70. Fuller-Otter, Kara Jaye Anne; age 12, was on Paxil when she hung herself from a hook in her closet. Kara's parents said ".... the damn doctor wouldn't take her off it and I asked him to when we went in on the second visit. I told him I thought she was having some sort of reaction to Paxil...")
- 71. **Furrow, Neal, 38:** August 10, 1999: (Prozac) in LA, <u>A White Supremist, and Jewish community center shooting, and killing Pilipino-born postal delivery person, had been treated for mental illness and reported to have been court-ordered to be on Prozac along with several other medications.</u>
- 72. Gale, Nathan, 25: Dec. 8, 2004: Columbus, OH Diagnosed with paranoid schizophrenia a year before the shooting. His mother said that "he came home with his medications" but didn't "know if he took them or not." 5 Dead (including perp), 2 Wounded.
- 73. Galstyan, Nerses Arthur 28: Los Angeles, CA, 4/3/10 The shooter killed four and injured two at a San Fernando Valley restaurant after a dispute with other patrons. He was indicted in a separate investigation for engaging in the business of dealing firearms without a license and possession of a firearm with an obliterated serial number, having sold firearms to an informant working for federal agents the previous year. GUN DETAILS: Handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: Selling firearms to a Federal Informant would prevent him from owning firearms...
- 74. Garner, Kevin, 45; Green Hill, AL, 4/7/09 The shooter killed his estranged wife, their teenage daughter, and two other relatives one day before his divorce proceedings were scheduled to take place. He then lit the house on fire and shot himself. GUN DETAILS: Handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: There is no evidence the shooter was prohibited from owning a gun. In divorce documents, however, his wife cited physical and emotional abuse.
- 75. **Gilmer, Tkeisha, 18; and Bellard, Darrell, 43;** ...a **drug relationship that went very bad (dealing and stealing drugs)**, killed four people (including children aged 4 and 3) in Lanham, Maryland in 2010. **Gilmer was bipolar and schizophrenic and had other mental health issues.** (http://www.cnn.com/2010/US/08/07/maryland.arrests/index.html). !
- 76. **Goh, One L, 43**: .. Apr. 2, 2012: **Oikos University shooting,** a <u>Korean Christian</u> college; expelled from college and denied refund; Oakland, CA 7 Dead, 3 Wounded.
- 77. **Golden, Andrew, aged 11,** March 24, 1998, , (Ritalin) and **Mitchell Johnson**, **aged 14,** (Ritalin) shot 15 people killing four students, one teacher, and wounding 10 others **Mitchell Scott Johnson** (born August 11, 1984) and **Andrew Douglas Golden** (born May 25, 1986) were middle school students, when they committed a massacre at <u>Westside Middle School</u> in<u>unincorporated Craighead County, Arkansas</u>, United States, near <u>Jonesboro</u>, nine weapons (<u>Remington 742</u> .30-06 rifle, <u>Universal .30 M1 carbine</u> replica, <u>Smith & Wesson .38 revolver</u>, <u>Double Deuce Buddie .22 two-shot derringer</u>, FIE .380 pistol, Star .380 pistol, <u>Ruger Security Six .357 revolver</u>, <u>Davis Industries</u> .38 two-shot <u>derringer</u>, and a <u>Charter Arms .38 revolver</u>)[4]—which had been stolen from Golden's grandfather's house—and 2,000 rounds of ammunition.

- 78. Gonzales, Esteban Quintero- 37, of Colombian origin: Gargatha, VA, 12/15/11 The shooter forced entry and killed two of his children, their mother, and the man she was living with before killing himself. The shooter was reportedly involved in a custody dispute with the woman at the time of her death. • GUN DETAILS: Unknown
- 79. Gonzalez, Marcos Chavez, 29: Mount Airy, NC, 11/1/09 The shooter killed four people outside a television store before eventually surrendering to the police. GUN DETAILS: Assault rifle GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: The shooter was a prohibited purchaser, having been convicted of kidnapping a minor in 2002.
- 80. Goodwin-Bey, Scott, 47: Springfield, MO, 11/15/14 The shooter killed four people in a motel room whom he thought were acting as informants to the police. GUN DETAILS: Ruger 9mm GUN ACQUIRED: The gun had previously reported stolen, though it not clear how the shooter acquired the gun. PROHIBITING CRITERIA: The shooter was prohibited from possessing firearms due to multiple felony convictions. In 1992, he was convicted of three felonies: possession of a controlled substance, unlawful possession of a firearm, unlawful use of a weapon, and resisting/interfering with arrest for a felony.
- 81. **Goodrich**, **Perley Jr.**, **45**: Oct. 26, 2009 Newport, ME: beat his mother and then shot his father dead shortly after being injected with Trazodone in a psychiatric hospital. Goodrich had complained that he didn't want to take the medication because it made him feel "violent."—. Trazodone. 1 Dead, 1 Wounded
- 82. **Green, Daniel,** 40, 8/14/13: Oklahoma City, OK, The shooter **killed four of his relatives including an infant inside of their family home.** • GUN DETAILS: .380 semiautomatic handgun GUN ACQUIRED: One of the victims owned a .380 semiautomatic handgun and kept it hidden in the attic. PROHIBITING CRITERIA: Green's father told police in an affidavit that his son was schizophrenic, but there is no evidence that Green had been adjudicated mentally ill or had a criminal history that would prohibit gun ownership.
- 83. **Griego, Nehemiah, 15:** Jan. 19, 2013: murdered his father, mother, brother, and 2 sisters; he had been having suicidal and homicidal thoughts; has a working diagnosis with psychosis and dissociative disorders and has started medication. We know that DNA and genetic codes are damaged by drugs and chemicals... Albuquerque, NM 5 Dead, 0 Wounded.
- 84. **Guadalupe, Ronquillo-Ovalle**, 33: killed four people in Rice, Texas in 2013, **Rice, TX**, 9/23/13 The shooter **killed her husband and three children** aged 4, 8, and 10 before committing suicide. In the previous month, the shooter's husband had pled no contest to a charge of assault against her, but was released after two days in custody. .22-caliber semi-automatic rifle PROHIBITING CRITERIA: There is no evidence that the shooter was prohibited from having a gun. (http://www.nydailynews.com/news/crime/mother-gunned-husband-sons-texasauthorities-article-1.1466168).
- 85. **Guzzo**, **Michael**, 56: who killed four people in Phoenix, Arizona, over barking dogs. 10/26/13 The shooter entered his neighbors' home and killed all four family members and their two dogs. The shooter then tried to enter another nearby residence, firing twice into the door, but ultimately failed and returned home to commit suicide. According to news reports, the shooter disliked the "constant barking" of his neighbor's dogs. GUN DETAILS: Pump-action shotgun PROHIBITING

- CRITERIA: There is no evidence that the shooter was prohibited from having a gun. (http://www.foxnews.com/us/2013/10/28/phoenix-family-killings-may-have-beenspurred-by-barking-dogs-cops-say/).
- 86. Hamilton, Michael Patrick-Murphy, **34:** Sept. 8, 2012: Jackson County, MI His dosage of Adderall was doubled just months before shooting. 1 Dead, 0 Wounded, Had a Concealed Handgun Permit. (Adderall is a psychotropic drug...)
- 87. **Hance, Michael E., 51**: Copley Township, OH, 8/7/11 The shooter **killed seven neighbors and relatives of his live-in girlfriend and wounded her** before he was shot and killed by police. GUN DETAILS: Hi-Point .45 ACP and .357 Magnum six-shot revolver GUN ACQUIRED: The shooter purchased the Hi-Point .45 ACP at a pawn shop five days before the shooting spree. He purchased the .357 Magnum at the same pawnshop in 2005. PROHIBITING CRITERIA: The shooter had no criminal record and there is no evidence to indicate that he was prohibited from owning a gun.
- 88. Harris, Eric David (18); and Dylan Bennet Klebold (17): 1999 Columbine massacre; The two boys got into trouble with the law for breaking into a locked van and stealing computers. In January 1998, they were charged with mischief, breaking and entering, trespassing, and theft. "Considerable media attention focused upon Cassie Bernall, who had been killed by Harris in the library and who Harris was reported to have asked, "Do you believe in God?" immediately prior to her murder. Bernall was reported to have responded "Yes" before being killed. Emily Wyant, the closest living witness to Bernall's death, denied that Bernall had this discussion. Eric Harris was taking the antidepressant Luvox, and Dylan Bennet Klebold (September 11, he was taking the drug fluvoxamine, an SSRI antidepressant,
- 89. **Harrison, James, age 35: killed his five children and wife**, and then himself in Graham, Washington in 2009, was born in 1974. He had a history of abuse, and when his wife threatened to leave him, he killed the children to prevent them from being raised by anybody else... The wife reported that she and the children had sustained years of abuse...(http://www.mahalo.com/pierce-county-murders/).
- 90. Hasan, Nidal Malik, 39: Nov. 5, 2009: Killeen, TX Military Psychiatrist, suffered harassment from fellow soldiers who questioned his loyalty to the US and commented on his Middle East ethnicity. Hasan was born in Arlington County, Virginia, to Palestinian parents who immigrated to the U.S. from al-Bireh in the West Bank. He was raised a Muslim, and was upset at the killing of Muslims in Iraq and Afghanistan by his fellow US soldiers, and was shouting Allah Akbar as he killed them. He was due to deploy to Afghanistan soon...He was depressed over the deployment, and was allowed to prescribe self-medication (anti-depressants (psychotropic SSRIs)). He fired over 220 rounds of ammunition, with 200 more rounds in his pockets when subdued. --- killing 13 soldiers and dependents Dead, 32 Wounded on military installation. The shooter had links with terrorist organizations (being placed on the 'Terror Watch List'), but was a Major in the US Army at the time of the murders !!!
- 91. Haskell, Ronald Lee 33: Spring, TX, 7/9/14 The shooter killed his the sister of his ex-wife, her husband, and four of their children, injuring a fifth, before he was captured by police. GUN DETAILS: Handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: The shooter was likely prohibited from owning firearm due to a mutual

- restraining order enacted as part of his divorce proceedings in October 2013. He had also been charged with simple assault and domestic violence in the presence of a child in June 2008 but the charges were dismissed.
- 92. Haughton, Radcliffe, 45: years of domestic abuse of his wife, bought a 40-caliber semiautomatic handgun (no background check between individuals in Wisconsin); under 4 year a restraining order; charges for domestic violence were dropped when the officer failed to show, and the DA refused to re-schedule the case resulting in 4 dead and 4 wounded; Oct. 21, 2012: Brookfield, WI 4 Dead (including perp), 4 Wounded.
- 93. **Hawkins, Robert, 19**; (2007) Robert Hawkins also had problems controlling his temper, as outcast-types with no anchor tying them to the rest of society sometimes do. Robert Hawkins had a prescription for and was taking anti-depressants. Maribel Rodriguez said her son's life had been a challenge from the start. She divorced Hawkins' father when the boy was 3-years-old, she said, and by 5 he was taking prescription Ritalin and Zoloft Valium was in his system at time of shooting. He became a ward of the state in 2002 after apparently threatening his stepmother. He was moved through facilities and foster homes for several years, until he was released in 2005. Two weeks before the shooting rampage, Hawkins parted ways with his girlfriend. Hawkins killed eight people before turning a gun on himself and committing suicide.
- 94. Haywood, Deshanon 21Derrick Brantley, 21 and: Akron, OH, 4/18/13 The shooters killed four people inside a townhouse; the initial motive for the crime was reportedly robbery. PROHIBITING CRITERIA: One shooter, Brantley, was free on bond awaiting trial on felony charges of heroin trafficking. The other, Haywood, was paroled from prison in February 2012 after serving part of a two-year sentence for cocaine trafficking and heroin possession. He immediately violated his parole and was sentenced to 45 days of house arrest.
- 95. **Helms, Christian, 14:** Sept. 21, 2011: Myrtle Beach, SC –, shot school resource officer and had **pipe bombs** with him Drugs for ADD and depression. 0 Dead, 1 Wounded
- 96. Henderson, James Sparks- 19: Cleveland, OH, 11/21/14 The shooter fatally shot his close friend, a woman who was seven months pregnant, and two other victims inside a residence. He also shot and injured a nine-year old girl. GUN DETAILS: 9mm pistol GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: The shooter was prohibited from possessing firearms due to a 2010 felony conviction for aggravated robbery, too young to possess a handgun.
- 97. Hendricks, Susan Diane, 48: Liberty, SC, 10/14/11 The shooter killed her ex-husband, two sons, and their step-grandmother. When investigators arrived, she told them one of her sons had committed the homicides and then killed himself, but this story was inconsistent with forensic evidence. Nine days after the shooting she was taken into custody and charged with four counts of homicide. She had reportedly taken out a \$700,000 life insurance policy for her family members with herself named as the beneficiary. GUN DETAILS: .380 caliber handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: In April 2006, Susan Hendricks shot and killed Doyle "O'Brian" Teaguein in her home after he had allegedly entered uninvited and threatened her. No charges were filed against Hendricks at the time, and the case was never closed. There is no evidence that she was prohibited from possessing a gun in 2011.
- 98. **Higdon, Wesley Neal. 25**: June 25, 2008: Henderson, KY 6 Dead (including perp), 0 Wounded. Signs and symptoms of alcohol and **drug** misuse.

- 99. **Hinckley, John**; (1981) John Hinckley, age 25, took four Valium two hours before shooting and almost killing President Ronald Reagan in 1981. In the assassination attempt, Hinckley also wounded press secretary James Brady, Secret Service agent Timothy McCarthy and policeman Thomas Delahany.
- 100. **Hoffman, Jason, 18**; Mar. 22, 2001; admitted to **shooting** five people at an **El Cajon** high **school**, committed suicide in prison.. had been seeing a psychiatrist and on **Effexor and Celexa (SSRI)** –in El Cajon, California
- 101. Holder, Mary Ann, 36: Greensboro, NC, 11/20/11 The shooter shot and injured a married man she had been having an affair with since 2008, injuring him. At some point that morning she also shot four children in her house, including her older son, a niece, a nephew, and a friend, and they all died of their injuries. She then picked up her son from a sleepover, shot and killed him, and turned the gun on herself. GUN DETAILS: .38-caliber handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: There is no evidence the shooter was prohibited from possessing a gun. The wife of the man the shooter was having an affair with sought a restraining order against her earlier in 2011; the shooter responded by requesting a restraining order against the man and his wife. Both orders had expired.
- 102. **Holly Hill, SC,** 7/15/15 An unknown assailant entered a residence and fatally **shot two teenage girls, an adult male,** and an adult female and injured a child. SHOOTER NAME: Unknown GUN DETAILS: Unknown GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: Unknown
- 103. Holmes, James Eagan; (born December 13, 1987 age 24) is an American convicted on 24 counts of murder and 140 counts of attempted murder for the 2012 Aurora shooting that killed 12 people and injured 70 others at a Century movie theater in Aurora, Colorado, on July 20, 2012.[8] He had no known criminal record prior to the shooting.[8] ... He began to suffer from mental health issues in middle school and attempted suicide at age 11. ...search warrant on Holmes' apartment, police, "found prescription medication for sertraline, a generic version of Zoloft used to treat depression, panic disorder and obsessive-compulsive disorder; and Clonazepam, usually prescribed to treat anxiety and panic attacks, and was heavily hooked on the prescription painkiller Vicodin" Holmes booby-trapped his apartment with explosives before the shooting, killed 12 people and injuring 59 others in Aurora Colorado
- 104. Houser, John Russell, 59: in July, 2015, string of arrests and a record of "extreme erratic behavior; Lafayette, LA." ...a history of mental problems (manic depressant and bipolar)" and was being "prescribed medication (anti-depressants) to take daily.
- 105. **Huff, Kyle Aaron,** 28: Mar. 25, 2006: Seattle, WA —year-old 7 Dead (including perp), 2 Wounded. The weapons used were purchased legally at sporting goods stores in Kalispell, Montana.[19] They were seized by the police in Whitefish after he pleaded guilty to a reduced misdemeanor mischief charge (He shot up a statue of a moose that was part of an installation called "Moose on the Loose.). They were returned after he paid restitution and a fine. The original felony charge for destroying the art would have prohibited him from legally owning firearms. He had little contact with police in Seattle, but was involved in a brawl at the Lobo Saloon in 2004.[18]

- Hunt, Jody Lee, 39 Morgantown, WV, 12/1/14 The shooter fatally shot four people at three different locations: a business rival at his towing company, his ex-girlfriend and her new boyfriend in their shared home, and his cousin at his home. The shooter then killed himself in his vehicle. GUN DETAILS: 9mm handgun GUN ACQUIRED: ATF traced the shooter's gun to a Monongalia County resident, who sold Hunt the 9mm handgun in an unlicensed transfer one year prior to the shooting. He was able to purchase the handgun in a private sale after responding to an ad for the gun posted on Facebook. Authorities do not believe that Hunt and the seller previously knew each other, and the seller was not charged with a crime. PROHIBITING CRITERIA: The shooter was prohibited from possessing firearms due to multiple felony convictions. In 1999 in Virginia, he was convicted of abduction and using a firearm in the commission of a felony for kidnapping a former girlfriend and holding her hostage at gunpoint. Stone was found to have be overdosing on a combination of drugs used to treat post-traumatic stress disorder and a recreational drug similar to ecstasy.
- 107. **Ison, David E.** 46 Laurel, IN, 9/26/11 The shooter killed a man, the man's estranged wife, their two children, and a neighbor. The male victim reportedly had sold the addictive pain-reliever Oxycontin to the shooter, and on the day of the murders they had argued over the price. • GUN DETAILS: A .380 caliber handgun was used in the slayings. Another stolen .380 handgun and an AK- 47 were recovered during the investigation. GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: The shooter had a lengthy criminal record, including a conviction for armed robbery, which would have prohibited him from possessing a gun, and at the time of the murders was on probation for 10 counts of burglary.
- 108. **Johnson, Mitchell Scott, aged 14:** (Ritalin) and **Andrew Golden, aged 11,** (Ritalin), March 24, 1998: shot 15 people killing four students, one teacher, and wounding 10 others **Mitchell Scott Johnson** (born August 11, 1984) and **Andrew Douglas Golden** (born May 25, 1986) were middle school students, when they committed a massacre at <u>Westside Middle School</u> in<u>unincorporated Craighead County, Arkansas</u>, United States, near <u>Jonesboro</u>, nine weapons (<u>Remington 742</u> .30-06 rifle, <u>Universal .30 M1 carbine</u> replica, <u>Smith & Wesson .38 revolver</u>, Double Deuce Buddie .22 two-shot <u>derringer</u>, FIE .380 pistol, Star .380 pistol, <u>Ruger Security Six .357 revolver</u>, <u>Davis Industries</u> .38 two-shot <u>derringer</u>, and a <u>Charter Arms .38</u> revolver)[4]—which had been stolen from Golden's grandfather's house—and 2,000 rounds of ammunition.
- 109. **Johnson, Sean 17:** Jan. 15, 2013: St. Louis, MO Drugs for mental illness. 0 Dead, 2 Wounded (including perp), marijuana possession
- 110. **Johnson, Timothy, 50**: Aug. 14, 2008: Little Rock, AR, lost his job, depressed, on Effexor. 2 Dead (including perp), 0 Wounded.
- 111. Jordan, Damian 22 New Orleans, LA, 3/26/10 The shooter killed his ex-girlfriend, her sister, and two children. GUN DETAILS: Handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: In 2009 Jordan pled guilty to burglary, a felony, prohibiting him from possessing firearms at the time of the shooting.
- 112. Kahler, James 46; Osage, KS, 11/28/09 The shooter killed his estranged wife, her grandmother, and his two daughters in their home. GUN DETAILS: Assault rifle GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: There

is no evidence that the shooter was prohibited from possessing firearms. In March 2009, he was charged with a misdemeanor domestic violence assault; however the case was dismissed.

- 113. Kalmio, Omar Mohamed 28: Minot, ND: 1/28/11 The shooter, a Somali national, killed the mother of his child at her home and then her brother, her mother, and her mother's boyfriend at a nearby home. The murder weapon was never recovered. • GUN DETAILS: Believed to be a handgun. GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: In 2006, Kalmio was convicted of second-degree assault with a dangerous weapon and sentenced to a year in prison (Kalmio and a group of other Somali men attacked a man in Minneapolis in January 2006, and Kalmio stabbed him three times in the back with a knife. The victim also was stabbed in the face and shoulder and suffered a collapsed lung and concussion.), which offense prohibited him from legally possessing a firearm. Kalmio was working in North Dakota's oil patch at the time of the killings and said he was in the U.S. under political asylum....--- was determined to be deported, but wasn't, due to political unrest in Somalia.
- 114. Kazmierczak, Steven; (2008), 27, opened fire in a lecture hall at Northern Illinois University, killing six and wounding 21. The gunman shot and killed himself before police arrived. Jessica Baty said that her boyfriend of two years had been taking Xanax, used to treat anxiety and Ambien, a sleep agent, as well as the anti-depressant Prozac. Baty said the psychiatrist prescribed the medications, a fact that made her so "nervous" that she tried to persuade Kazmierczak to stop taking one of the drugs. She said he had stopped taking the anti-depressant (Prozac) three weeks before the Valentine's Day rampage on the NIU campus in DeKalb, Illinois, which left five students dead and 16 wounded. He then killed himself. Kazmierczak told her he had stopped taking the anti-depressant "because it made him feel like a zombie," she said during the interview Sunday at her parents' house in Wonder Lake, II. "He wasn't acting erratic. He was just a little quicker to get annoyed." Kazmierczak had a history of mental illness and revered figures like Adolf Hitler and Ted Bundy. Steven Kazmierczak even wore a tattoo depicting Jigsaw, the Saw films' sadistic narrator, and had a history of attempted suicide. NIU police say they never got wind of such warnings. "How could it be a red flag if it never came to us?" said the university's police chief. But David Vann, who culled the information on Kazmierczak for a book about the shootings said the writing was on the wall. Kazmierczak had been hospitalized several times for mental illness and was known as "Strange Steve" by roommates. "What does a mass murderer have to do to get noticed?" asked Vann.
- 115. **Kim, Alex; age 13**, hung himself shortly after his Lexapro prescription had been doubled.
- 116. **Kinkel. Kip; (1998) Kip Kinkel, 15**, had been **suspended from school for possession of a loaded .357 in his locker in school the day before the shootings!** He then murdered his parents in 1998 and the next day went to his school, Thurston High in Springfield, Ore., and opened fire on his classmates, , Kinkel **paid \$110 for the**<u>Beretta Model 90 .32-caliber pistol</u> loaded with a 9-round magazine, Kinkel retrieved **his .22 rifle** from his bedroom and ammunition from his parents' bedroom. killing two and wounding 22 others. He had been prescribed both Prozac and Ritalin.
- 117. Klebold, Dylan Bennet (17): (see above)

Survivor Valeen Schnurr claims that she was the one questioned by Harris. Joshua Lapp thought Bernall had been queried about her (religious) belief,... "-killer Eric Harris was taking Luvox. Like Prozac, Paxil, Zoloft, Effexor and many others, a modern and widely prescribed type of anti-depressant drug called Selective Serotonin Reuptake Inhibitors, or SSRIs. Harris and fellow student Dylan Klebold went on a hellish school shooting rampage in 1999, during which they killed 12 students and a teacher and wounded 24 others before turning their guns on themselves. Luvox manufacturer Solvav Pharmaceuticals concedes that during short-term controlled clinical trials, 4 percent of children and youth taking Luvox - that's one in 25 - developed mania, a dangerous and violence-prone mental derangement characterized by extreme excitement and delusion.

- 118. Kwan Fai "Willie", Mak Wai-Chiu "Tony" Ng, and Benjamin Ng (Chineese gang) gunned down fourteen people in the Wah Mee gambling club in Seattle.
- 119. **Laffer, David, 33** who killed four people in Medford, New York in 2011, Police said Laffer, who is also thought to have a painkiller addiction, was 'extremely violent' and appeared to be high on drugs when he was arrested, while Brady allegedly tried to stop him being taken into custody. The couple got about one-third of that total -- 4,251 pills -- in the first six months of this year. The couple were admittedly addicted to pain killer medication grounds for denying possession of firearms; plus a detective investigated Laffer for identity theft of his mothers, and recommended that Laffer have his guns confiscated --- because he represented a danger to himself and others... (http://www.huffingtonpost.com/2011/11/10/david-laffer-sentencedto_n_1086514.html).
- 120. Lane, Thomas "TJ" (2012), 15: Three students were killed by Thomas "TJ" Lane, another student, in a rampage at Chardon High School in Chardon, Ohio. Three others were injured. In hindsight, it is also easy to see how violence was part of his family. During his infancy, his parents Thomas Lane Jr. and Sara Nolan were reportedly each charged with domestic abuse against each other. Later arrest charges for Thomas Lane Jr. include assaulting a police officer, domestic abuse against another woman who fathered his children and attempted murder. The attempted-murder charge was dropped, but in 2002-03 he served eight months of a four-year sentence for strangling a woman until she lost consciousness, holding her face under running water and bashing her head against a wall. By the time TJ Lane was in elementary school, he was living with his maternal grandparents, Jack and Carol Nolan, who had also taken in his older brother Adam Nolan and a sister. But violence followed him there too. Records indicate that police arrested Adam, 19, multiple times for disorderly conduct, theft and other crimes related to his abuse of prescription drugs and heroin, including several overdoses. (Adam apparently was released into the custody of his grandparents who reportedly said they would try to get him treatment.) On Dec. 9, 2009, during his parents' divorce proceedings, Lane and Nolan, then 15 and 16, were arrested for assault, after getting into a fight with an uncle who had gone to the house.
- 121. Lanza, Adam Peter; age 20, Killed 26 and wounded 2 in Newtown Ct, The Sandy Hook Elementary School shooting occurred on December 14, 2012, [6] Prior to driving to the school, Lanza shot and killed his mother at their Newtown home, then stole her guns (Rifle, shotgun, and handguns) from the safe..[8][11][12] As first responders arrived at the scene, Lanza committed Suicide by shooting himself in the head. ... Lanza's obsessive compulsive disorder... antidepressant Celexa... was prescribed Fanapt, a controversial anti-psychotic medicine. Nancy Lanza appeared not to follow the advice of her son's physicians, taking her son off his medication and failing to reschedule missed appointments.... "displayed a profound autism spectrum disorder with rigidity, isolation and a lack of comprehension of ordinary social interaction and communications." (Fanapt was dropped by its first producer, picked up by another, initially rejected by the FDA, then later picked up and mass produced...)
- 122. Larry, James A., 33: Chicago, IL, 4/14/10 The shooter who had converted to Islam in prison killed his family for not going along with his conversion, fatally shooting his mother, pregnant wife, infant son, and two nieces, and injuring one other. GUN DETAILS: Shotgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: Larry was almost certainly prohibited from purchasing a gun, having recently served a prison term for a weapons charge. He had also recently pled no contest to misdemeanor battery against his wife.

- 123. Lee, Thomas Jesse, 26: La Grange, GA, 1/31/15 The shooter killed his wife, mother-in-law, father-in-law, and a teenage family friend in the home he shared with his wife's family. The shooter also strangled and killed his stepdaughter. GUN DETAILS: Unknown GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: There is no evidence that the shooter was prohibited from possessing firearms.
- Leirmoe, Gaylin, 26: killed his two infant children and their mother, then himself in Ammon, Idaho in 2011, History of Domestic Violence and Abuse (prior Domestic Violence battery charges; access to/use of weapon; attempt to burn house)
 Recent Separation, Divorce, or Custody Battle (several months of separation prior to incident; no contact order)
 Threats of Suicide or Suicidal Behaviors (committed suicide upon shooting victims)

- 125. **Leyva, Silvio** 36: Dec. 30, 1999: Tampa, FL 5 Dead, 3 Wounded. TAMPA, Fla. When Silvio Izquierdo-Leyva returned from a visit last month to his native Cuba, he was a changed man. He had always been drawn to **Santeria**, a religion rooted in **Africa with gods**, spirits and sacrifices. But now, Izquierdo had embarked on a year's worth of studies to become a **Santero**, a priest of the faith. When Izquierdo was handcuffed Thursday, he was carrying two firearms. One was a 9mm pistol he bought from the Floriland Mall flea market on Jan. 2, said police Chief Bennie Holder. The other, a .38-caliber revolver, was **purchased from Nationwide Sports by an unknown person (straw-purchase)**, he said.... was arrested in Alabama just two years ago in the vicious stabbing of an acquaintance,
- 126. Lopez, Ivan, 34: April 2, 2014, Fort Hood shooter, four dead and 16 wounded, was being treated for mental health issues, Lopez had been prescribed anti-depressants and the sleep aid medication Ambien.
- 127. **Loughner, Jared Lee**; Jan. 8, 2011: Tucson, AZ 6 Dead, 13 Wounded, born September 10, 1988 ((23 years old)) pleaded guilty to 19 charges of murder and attempted murder in connection with the January 8, 2011 Tucson shooting, in which he shot and severely injured U.S. Representative Gabrielle Giffords, his target, and killed 6 people, including Chief U.S. District Court Judge John Roll, a federal judge found that months of forcibly medicating him to treat his schizophrenia prior to the shooting, a period when he was also abusing alcohol and drugs. Loughner was arrested in 2007 for possessing drug paraphernalia, a misdemeanor charge. The records suggest that Loughner paid a \$20 fee and completed a court-ordered program for drug offenders. (Having a history of unlawful use/abuse of drugs is grounds for failing a background check and denying the possession of firearms and/or a Concealed Carry Permit...) Loughner was kicked out of Pima Community College following a series of run-ins with school officials and police at the colleges where he frequently caused disruptions in classrooms and elsewhere on campus, according to The Arizona Republic.
- 128. **Macinnis, Neil Allan** In 2013, 18-year-old student shot dead two women at a Virginia college; shotgun with buckshot and slugs
- 129. Malik, Tashfeen (27) (see Farook, Syed Rizwan) Muslim Jihadists, San Bernardino Mass Shooting San Bernardino, Ca left a Christmas party held at Inland Regional Center, later returning heavily armed and the two opened fire, killing 14 and wounding 21, ten critically. The two were later killed by police as they fled in an SUV.

- 130. Malvo, Lee Boyd 17; and Muhammad, John Allen 42; October of 2002, Muhammad, 42–year old convicted murderer and Nation of Islam member and his planned to kill six white people per day "to terrorize the nation", including plans to bomb school buses and children's hospitals: "He wanted to kill a policeman, then set off a bomb at his funeral." Over the course of three weeks, 10 people were killed and 3 more were critically injured.
- Mateem, Omar, 29 (1986); Orlando, Florida, June 12, 2016 (Ramadaan), American Born Muslim born of Afghan 131. parents in New York, shot and killed over 50 at a gay bar (53 more wounded), swearing allegience to ISIS, using a Sig Sauer AR-15-type semi-automatic rifle and a Glock 9mm semiautomatic pistol, and wearing an explosive vest (although inoperative). A .38-caliber Smith & Wesson revolver was found in the shooter's car. Mateen was legally able to buy an assault rifle even though the FBI had investigated him for possible ties to Islamist militant groups. Mateen was licensed to work as an armed security guard in the state of Florida. The security company that hired Mateen said it conducted background checks in 2007 and again in 2013. G4S says the background check also included a psychological evaluation called the Minnesota Multiphasic Personality Inventory. In July 2014, the FBI investigated a Florida man who'd blown himself up in Syria in support of al Nusra Front, an al Qaeda affiliate also considered an ISIS rival. It was learned that the suicide bomber knew Mateen..., Sitora Yu Sufi, ex-wife of Orlando nightclub shooter, Omar Mateen says: Their marriage lasted for four months, with his being Bi-Polar the real reason behind their divorce in 2011. Mateen used to beat up his wife and was abusive and violent for petty reasons; she had to call up her family so that they could come and save her from the rage of her husband. "Mateen showed signs of emotional instability and sickness and was mentally unstable and mentally ill [and] obviously disturbed and traumatized," says his ex-wife. Matteem called the news media a dn FBI to tell them he was the shooter, and that he pledged allegience to ISIS and did it for the Islamic **State**. He was also vindictive towards homosexuality, as because Islam doesn't support it.
- 132. **Mathews, Rod, 14-year-old** who had been prescribed Ritalin(r) since the third grade beat a classmate to death with a bat
- 133. McCray, Riccardo 24: Buffalo, NY, 8/14/10 The shooter opened fire on a group of people outside a bar, killing four and wounding four others. GUN DETAILS: Unknown GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: McCray had been arrested earlier that year on felony drug charges and the previous year for having a loaded rifle in his car.
- 134. McDermott, Michael, 42: (2000); The hulking computer technician accused of gunning down seven of his co-workers at a Wakefield high tech firm this week suffered from a host of mental illnesses including schizophrenia for which he was taking a trio of anti-depressants Paxil, Prozac & Desyrel (Trazodone) "drugs that helped him go to sleep.", a source told the Herald yesterday. "He's got some serious psychological issues and a long (psychiatric) history," the source said of 42-year-old Michael "Mucko" McDermott. McDermott, a divorced Navy veteran from Marshfield who lived most recently in Haverhill, suffered from severe depression, paranoia and schizophrenia, and had been in psychiatric treatment for some time, according to the source who spoke on condition of anonymity. To cope with his mental disorders, McDermott was prescribed several Selective Serotonin Reuptake Inhibitors, or SSRIs are designed to increase brain serotonin. Low levels of brain serotonin can lead to depression and anxiety disorders.

- 135. **McLendon, Michael,** 28: Mar. 10, 2009: Alabama Geneva County massacre, which occurred on March 10, 2009, spanned at least two communities, Geneva and Samson in Geneva County, Alabama, and resulted in the death of 11 people, 6 Wounded (including his wife, mother, grandparents, aunt and uncle). In the days leading up to the massacre, he told a friend that he was depressed. He had a Concealed Carry (Handgun) License.
- 136. McMeen, Sara, 30: Emington, IL, 12/16/11 The shooter killed her boyfriend and her three children before taking her own life in the backyard of their home. GUN DETAILS: Semiautomatic pistol GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: There is no evidence the shooter was prohibited from owning a gun. But she reportedly suffered from bipolar disorder and postpartum depression, and did not take any medication. She also had a family history of mental illness and violence. In 1971, McMeen's father shot and killed his wife with a 12-gauge shotgun. He was found not guilty by reason of insanity, and diagnosed with schizophrenia with suicidal and homicidal tendencies.
- 137. **Medina, Sonny 36:** Fort Myers, FL, 6/8/14 After a party, the shooter **killed his girlfriend and his three children**, ages 2 through 10, before taking his own life. GUN DETAILS: Handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: There is no evidence that the shooter was prohibited from having a gun. In 2002, he had been charged with simple assault but was found not guilty.
- 138. Memon, Hammad, 14: Feb. 5, 2010: Huntsville, AL –But a number of people have said the shooter, Hammad Memon, was Muslim Badsha Mahommed Gool and the local Muslim imam, Mullah History of being treated for ADHD and depression. On antidepressant Zoloft and "other drugs for the conditions." shooting death of 14-year-old classmate Todd Brown. 1 Dead, 0 Wounded.
- 139. **Mercer, Chris Harper, 26**: 10/1/2015 Umpqua Community College shooting Roseburg, OR; ...previously <u>attended a school for mentally unstable children</u>; He posted on social media that he was taking five medications (for ADHT and Autism). he used: 9mm Glock handgun, a .40 S&W Smith & Wesson handgun, three other handguns, and a Del-Ton 5.56×45mm rifle. Six guns were found at the scene of the crime; <u>seven more were found in his home</u>., 26-year-old Mercer opened fire with at Umpqua Community College in southwest Oregon. He was also a fan of the Islamic State (ISIS). He) asked each student what was their religion, and if they answered Christian, he shot them in the head. The gunman shot himself to death after being wounded
- 140. Merhige, Paul 40: Jupiter, FL, 11/26/09 The shooter killed his two twin sisters, his aunt, and his cousin's daughter, and injured two other family members, during a Thanksgiving celebration. He eluded capture for over a month before authorities apprehended him. GUN DETAILS: He used at least two handguns during the shooting. GUN ACQUIRED: Purchased at least six guns (including a .22-caliber handgun and a .40-caliber semiautomatic handgun), a high-powered rifle with a scope, and ammunition from two gun stores in South Florida. Had a Concealed Handgun License. PROHIBITING CRITERIA: The shooter was involuntarily committed to mental health facilities at least three times in the decade before the killing, which, according to state, federal, and county officials, prohibited him under federal law from

- **possessing guns or a Concealed Carry Permit.** According to press reports, however, the relevant records were not submitted to the NICS database.
- 141. Mims, Reginald 16: Stoves, Rashad 17; Underwood, Artavius 16: Birmingham, AL, 1/29/12; During an attempted robbery at a home, the shooters killed five individuals ages 19 to 42. • GUN DETAILS: Two 9mm handguns and a .38-caliber handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: All three shooters were prohibited from possessing handguns due to their age.
- 142. **Miller, Matthew; was 13** when he saw a psychiatrist because he was having difficulty at school. The psychiatrist gave him samples of Zoloft. The doctor said it would help Matt's mood, make him feel better about himself. The boy started taking the pills and seemed to be in good spirits for a few days. But then he began showing signs of intense nervousness and agitation. He couldn't sit still, his father remembers. Seven days later his mother found him dead, hanging by a belt from a laundry hook in his closet.
- 143. Miles, Shannon, 30, African American, killed deputy Darren Goforth, 47, white, walking up behind him and shooting him in the back and several times after he was on the ground; August 28, 2015. His arrest history includes: twice for using force against a police officer; giving false information to a police officer; resisting arrest, criminal mischief greater than \$1,500, discharging or displaying a firearm, criminal trespassing, and evading arrest. His arrests showed a long history of violent acts toward police officers.
- 144. Mixon, Lovell, 27: black parolee from Oakland, who killed four white policemen, Mixon first landed in prison in 2002 for charges of assault with a deadly weapon. He got out in late 2007, but within a few months, he was picked up again for possession of a stolen laptop, a drug scale; and took part in a home invasion robbery in Modesto, CA, on February 21 2009 in which a rifle was reported stolen. he was also accused of committing two rapes before the shooting spree. in East Oakland, California in 2009, was born in 1982, during high publicity of the Travon Martin incident... (http://murderpedia.org/male.M/m/mixon-lovelle.htm). !
- 145. **Montes, Jason, 33,:** Jan. 11, 2009: Concord, CA, shot and killed his wife and then himself at home. Montes had earlier begun taking the antidepressant Prozac for depression related to his **impending divorce and a recent bankruptcy**. Prozac. 2 Dead (including perp), 0 Wounded.
- 146. Moore, Dwayne, 35, and Edward Washington, 33: Boston, MA, 9/28/10 The shooters killed four and wounded one during a drug-related robbery. were both charged in the execution style killings. Washington was acquitted (Mis-trial: Washington admitted taking part in the robbery, but said he left before the shootings.). In Moore's first trial, the jury deadlocked 11-1 in favor of his guilt, but he was later convicted in a retrial. GUN DETAILS: .40-caliber Iberia handgun and 9mm Cobray semiautomatic. The Cobray has not been recovered, but the weapon was identified based on recovered bullets and shell casings. AMMO DETAILS: 14 rounds fired GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: Participating in a criminal act that results in the death of anyone is grounds for murder conviction.

- 147. **Morrison, Duane,** 53: Sept. 27, 2006: Bailey, CO Antidepressants found among his effects. 2 Dead (including perp), 0 Wounded.
- 148. Moser, Brittany Lina Yvonn, 25 and Bennett, Jacob Allen, 26: Crab Orchard, TN, 9/11/13 The shooters killed a woman and three teenagers, apparently during an attempted robbery during a marijuana exchange. The victims' bodies were discovered in a car parked along the side of the road in the Renegade Mountain resort community near Crossville. GUN DETAILS: Handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: Bennett was prohibited from possessing firearms. In 2010 he received a 6-year prison sentence for charges of theft, forgery, and possession of a handgun during a felony, but was paroled on March 4, 2013. The Cumberland County sheriff's office estimated they had previously arrested Bennett five times.
- Muhammad, John Allen 42; and 17—year—old partner Lee Boyd Malvo: October of 2002, Muhammad, 42—year old convicted murderer and Nation of Islam member and his plan to kill six white people per day "to terrorize the nation", including plans to bomb school buses and children's hospitals: "He wanted to kill a policeman, then set off a bomb at his funeral." Over the course of three weeks, 10 people were killed and 3 more were critically injured.
- 150. Muller, Sidney, 27: Clarksburg, WV, 7/26/13 According to a criminal complaint, the shooter was trying to collect \$10,000 two men owed him for drugs when one of them aimed a handgun at him. He stripped the man of the weapon and used it to kill them both; he then shot and killed a father-son newspaper delivery team that happened to be outside the house. SHOOTER NAME: GUN DETAILS: 9mm Beretta GUN ACQUIRED: Gun apparently belonged to one of the victims PROHIBITING CRITERIA: The shooter had been convicted previously for driving under the influence and had been arrested for driving with a suspended license, but was not criminally prohibited from possessing a gun. The shooter was also a veteran of the U.S. Marine Corps and his lawyers indicated he had scored four out of five in Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder testing and had been diagnosed as bipolar. He was reportedly in treatment at the local VA hospital.
- 151. Myers, Kenneth, 47: Wagener, SC, 7/3/11 The shooter apparently went on a murder-suicide rampage, killing his wife, her twin sister, his mother-in-law, and his ex-girlfriend in two different residences before he was confronted by law enforcement and shot himself. GUN DETAILS: A 20-gauge shotgun was used in the massacre. Myers owned numerous weapons including an SKS, AK-47, two 9 mm handguns, a .22-caliber revolver, and a .38-caliber snub-nose pistol. GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: There is no evidence that the shooter was prohibited from owning a gun. However, he reportedly had a history of violence, having threatened his mother-in-law with a rifle. In a suicide note, he blamed his wife's family for contributing to her drug problem.
- 152. **Myers, Kurt,** 64: Herkimer, NY, 4/13/13 The shooter **killed** 68-year-old Harry Montgomery and 57-year-old Michael Ransear and critically wounded Seymour, the **Barber shop's** owner and another customer, Dan Haslauer, was also was listed in critical condition at a Utica hospital; and used the shotgun to kill Thomas Stefka, an employee at **Gaffey's Fast Lube**, and Michael Renshaw, a customer who was a 23-year veteran of the state **Department of Corrections**. Myers then shot a police dog, and was killed by responding officers. GUN DETAILS: shotgun. Additional guns and ammunition were found by

- emergency crews after Myers set fire to the apartment. PROHIBITING CRITERIA: There is no reason to believe Myers was prohibited him from possessing a gun. He was arrested in 1973 for drunk driving
- 153. **Myron May, 31**: November 20, 2014; Tallahassee, Florida , a **Florida State University alum**, opened fire in the school's library, wounding three before he was shot and killed by police. ABC Action News found a half-filled prescription for the antianxiety drug Hydroxyzine in his apartment after the shooting. In addition, according to May's friends, he had seen a psychologist and had been prescribed the antidepressant Wellbutrin and the ADHD drug Vyvanse. He also checked himself in to a mental health center called Mesilla Valley Hospital around September of 2014. Shortly after this, his friends discovered the antipsychotic Seroquel among his prescriptions.
- Neace, Stanley, 47: Jackson, KY, 9/10/10 The shooter, reportedly enraged at how his wife prepared his eggs, fatally shot her, his stepdaughter, and three neighbors. He killed himself when the police arrived. GUN DETAILS: Shotgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: was arrested in January, 1993 and charged with two counts of sodomy involving a child. In 1998, court officials say Neace pleaded guilty to a misdemeanor charge of third degree sexual abuse. (He was placed on two years of probation, and his rights were restored in June, 2002.) should have not been allowed possession of firearms.
- 155. Paek, Jeong Soo 58: Feb. 22, 2012: Norcross, GA; in 2006 had a restraining order for assault on his sister (a criminal record that would have prevented him from owning firearms) 5 Dead (including perp, 2 sisters and their husbands), 0 Wounded. The shooter returned to a Korean spa from which he'd been kicked out after an altercation, where he shot and killed two of his sisters and their husbands before committing suicide. 45-caliber handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Police reported that he acquired the gun legally. He served two months in jail for assaulting his sister six years earlier. In 2006 she applied for a temporary protection order and described his intention to harm himself or others with guns (undiagnosed mental health history).
- 156. <u>Page, Wade Michael, 20</u>: Aug 5, 2012: Sikh temple, a <u>fanatical white supremacist who was filled with rage and hatred for people of different races and religions</u>. Oak Creek, WI 7 Dead (including perp), 4 Wounded.
- 157. Pasasouk, Ka, 34: murdered four people in Northridge, California, December 2, 2012: "In March 2011, while in prison for the methamphetamine conviction. Pasasouk underwent a psychiatric evaluation because of concerns regarding his behavior." He had a long history of drug and alcohol abuse, and had actually begged not to be released from prison in 2011. The motive for killing Calabia, Ghossein and Kim, the prosecutor said, was to eliminate witnesses to Navales' murder.
- 158. Phillips, Denny Edward, 34 (pled not guilty); and David Allen Tyner, 31, (pled guilty), and: Oklahoma City, OK, 11/9/2009 The shooter or shooters killed four people in a house before setting the building on fire. Two of the victims were pregnant. The crime was premeditated by two conspirators, and related to drugs they sold for one of the victims. It is unclear whether just one or both of the conspirators were present for the shooting, but both were charged with six counts of murder. Tyner surrendered to authorities a week after the killings. Phillips was arrested in Tulsa in April 2010 after allegedly attempting to sell two guns stolen from a police sergeant's home. GUN DETAILS: Handgun AMMO DETAILS: Two types of bullet

- cases were recovered at the crime scene. GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: Phillips was prohibited due to a lengthy criminal history including multiple felony convictions. Phillips was convicted in 1996 for assault with a deadly weapon, and other crimes including a jail escape. He was also convicted in 2010 for possession of a firearm by a felon. He was also convicted of aggravated assault and battery. There is no indication that Tyner was prohibited, though he was reportedly a member of a prison gang.
- 159. Pickney, Jeremy (23), Stringer, Marvin Lamar (22); Conway, Samuel, (23); and all Black: killed five people in Arkansas in 2009, These were later identified as 56-year-old Edward Gentry Jr., his 52-year-old wife Pam, their 24-year-old son Jeremy, and Jeremy's 19-year-old girlfriend Kristyn Warneke (all white). They had all been shot to death. ... the body of 80-year-old Edward Gentry Sr. was ... shot to death execution style ... burglarized: flat-screen televisions, guns, and two sets of rims and tires had been stolen. Police records state, the killers "stayed awhile" after they killed the victims which indicates in other similar robbery-murders that they tortured and raped their victims before killing them. - 160. **Peterson, Tyler, 20:** Oct. 7, 2007: Crandon, WI off duty deputy sheriff 7 Dead (including perp), 1 Wounded. 18-year-old Jordanne Michele Murray was Peterson's former girlfriend, and it was believed the dispute within the apartment motivated the shooting.
- Pittman, Christopher; (2001) 12-year-old Christopher Pittman struggled in court to explain why he murdered his grandparents, who had provided the only love and stability he'd ever known in his turbulent life. "When I was lying in my bed that night,' he testified, "I couldn't sleep because my voice in my head kept echoing through my mind telling me to kill them." Christopher had been angry with his grandfather, who had disciplined him earlier that day for hurting another student during a fight on the school bus. So later that night, he shot both of his grandparents in the head with a .410 shotgun as they slept and then burned down their South Carolina home, where he had lived with them. "I got up, got the gun, and I went upstairs and I pulled the trigger," he recalled. "Through the whole thing, it was like watching your favorite TV show. You know what is going to happen, but you can't do anything to stop it." Pittman's lawyers would later argue that the boy had been a victim of "involuntary intoxication" since his doctors had him taking the antidepressants Paxil and Zoloft just prior to the murders. Paxil's known adverse drug reactions according to the drug's FDA approved label include mania, insomnia, anxiety, agitation, confusion, amnesia, depression, paranoid reaction, psychosis, hostility, delirium, hallucinations, abnormal thinking, depersonalization and lack of emotion, among others.
- 162. Poore, Cedric Dwayne, 39 and James Stanford Poore, 32 Tulsa, OK, 1/7/13 During a robbery the shooters bound the hands of four women in an apartment at the Fairmont Terrace complex and shot each one in the head. The 3-year-old son of one of the victims was in the apartment at the time of the incident but was unharmed. GUN DETAILS: .40-caliber pistol GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: Both shooters had extensive criminal histories: Cedric Poore received a 35-year prison sentences in 1995 for armed robbery and James Poore received a 12-year sentence in 2000 for armed robbery with a firearm. Both were released in 2011, but prohibited from possessing firearms.
- 163. Poore, James Stanford, 32 and Poore, Cedric Dwayne, 39: Tulsa, OK, 1/7/13 During a robbery the shooters bound the hands of four women in an apartment at the Fairmont Terrace complex and shot each one in the head. The 3-year-old son of one of the victims was in the apartment at the time of the incident but was unharmed. GUN DETAILS: .40-caliber pistol GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: Both shooters had extensive criminal histories: Cedric Poore

- received a 35-year prison sentences in 1995 for armed robbery and James Poore received a 12-year sentence in 2000 for armed robbery with a firearm. Both were released in 2011, but prohibited from possessing firearms.
- 164. Prather, Cedric G., 33: Douglasville, GA, 2/7/15 The shooter went to the home where his ex-wife lived and fatally shot her, their nine-year old son, their seven-year old son, and the ex-wife's new boyfriend. He also shot and injured two other children who were visiting the home, and then fatally shot himself. • GUN DETAILS: .45-caliber handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: The shooter was prohibited from possessing firearms due to a 2011 felony conviction for possessing cocaine.
- 165. **Purdy, Patrick (1989)** Patrick Purdy went on a **schoolyard shooting rampage in Stockton, CA**, in 1989, which became the catalyst for the original legislative frenzy to ban "semiautomatic assault weapons" in California and the nation. The **25-year-old** Purdy, who murdered five children and wounded 30, had been on Amitriptvine, an anti-depressant, as well as the antipsychotic drug Thorazine.
- 166. Rackemann, Kenneth "Cody, 24 and Valencia Williams, 21: Indianapolis, IN, 2/20/14 During an attempt to rob the home of a drug dealer who had hired them for security, the shooters killed the drug dealer and three others. GUN DETAILS: Two handguns GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: In October 2010 Rackemann had been convicted of felony battery and criminal recklessness, which prohibited him from possessing a gun. Williams did not have a prior criminal record.
- 167. Ratzmann, Terry Michael, 45: (2005) Terry Michael Ratzmann killed seven members of the Living Church of God (LCG) before committing suicide at a Sheraton Hotel in Brookfield, WI in 2005. On the verge of losing his job as a computer technician with a placement firm, Ratzmann was known to suffer from bouts of depression, and was reportedly infuriated by a sermon the minister had given two weeks earlier. Ratzmann's autopsy revealed that he was suffering from Hashimoto's thyroiditis. Hashimoto's thyroiditis very often results in hypothyroidism with bouts of hyperthyroidism. Symptoms of Hashimoto's thyroiditis include Myxedematous psychosis, weight gain, depression, mania, sensitivity to heat and cold, paresthesia, fatigue, panic attacks, bradycardia, tachycardia, high cholesterol, reactive hypoglycemia, constipation, migraines, muscle weakness, cramps, memory loss, infertility and hair loss.
- 168. **Rhoades**, **Cherie Lash:** 44, opened fire at the **Cedarville Rancheria Tribal Office and Community Center**, killing four and wounding two. After running out of ammunition, Rhoades grabbed a **butcher knife** and stabbed another person.... always tried to intimidate tribal employees with violence, tribal members with violence," Russo said. Among the victims were the **shooter's brother**, **niece**, **and nephew**. Alturas police are investigating whether the shooter embezzled federal grant money meant for the tribe, which may have spurred the tribe's efforts to evict her.
- 169. **Rider, Kevin; age 14**, was withdrawing from Prozac when he died from a gunshot wound to his head. Initially it was ruled a suicide, but two years later, the investigation into his death was opened as a possible homicide. The **prime suspect, also age 14**, had been taking Zoloft and other SSRI antidepressants.
- 170. Ringold, Richard 44: Lawrenceville, GA, 8/27/09 The shooter executed his girlfriend, his daughter, and two others in a domestic dispute. GUN DETAILS: Unknown GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: There is no evidence the shooter was prohibited from possessing a gun.

- 171. Regalado, Gerardo 38: Hialeah, FL, 6/6/10 The shooter killed four women, including his wife who had just separated from him. He injured three others before shooting and killing himself. The shooting occurred in Yoyito-Cafe Restaurant, where the shooter's wife was employed as a waitress, and in the parking lot immediately outside. GUN DETAILS: .45-caliber handgun GUN ACQUIRED: The shooter had a concealed weapons permit. PROHIBITING CRITERIA: Relatives said the shooter had abused and terrorized women in the past, and had been imprisoned in Cuba for a particularly violent incident, but he did not have a criminal record in the United States. ("...ever been convicted of a crime of violence, or could have been sentenced to prison for one year or more...")
- 172. **Rhoden family slaughtered**, April 26, 2016: murdered members were identified as: Hannah Gilley, 20; Christopher Rhoden, Sr., 40; Christopher Rhoden, Jr., 16; Clarence "Frankie" Rhoden, 20; Dana Rhoden, 37; Gary Rhoden, 38; Hanna Rhoden, 19; and Kenneth Rhoden, 44. One of the **eight relatives all killed "execution style"** in rural Ohio suffered nine gunshot wounds, according to the local coroners offices.

Two victims suffered five gunshot wounds; one was shot four times; and the others were shot once, twice or three times, the Pike County Coroner and Hamilton County Coroner said today. Officials did not identify which of the victims was shot how many times. Seven of the eight victims in Friday's shooting spree were found in three homes along the same road in Peebles, a small village about 70 miles east of Cincinnati. The eighth victim was found in nearby Piketon. Some of the victims appeared to have been killed in their sleep, officials said. Three children -- a 4-day-old baby, a 6-month-old baby and a 3-year-old -- were found unharmed at the crime scenes. Marijuana grows were found at three of the victim locations, and evidence consistent with Cockfighting was also present.

- 171. **Rider, Kevin age 14**, was **withdrawing from Prozac** when he died from a gunshot wound to his head. Initially it was ruled a suicide, but two years later, the investigation into his death was opened as a possible homicide. The **prime suspect, also age 14**, had been **taking Zoloft and other SSRI antidepressants**
- 172. **Riggleman, Shayne,** 22: Monongalia County, WV, 9/6/11 The shooter **killed five people and injured one** before fleeing from the police and then killing himself. GUN DETAILS: A rifle was used. A second rifle and a .22-caliber pistol were also recovered. GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: In 2008, **Riggleman was sentenced to 14 months in prison for armed robbery**, an offense that would prohibit him from possessing firearms, though it is possible his rights were restored under West Virginia law. He had also been **diagnosed with bipolar disorder and schizophrenia** at Chestnut Ridge Hospital and his family had him **committed on several occasions**.
- 173. **Roberts, Charles Carl, 32:** Oct. 2, 2006: Nickel Mines, PA Amish school girls, His family reported that he took Antidepressants. 6 Dead (including perp), 5 Wounded.
- 174. **Roberts, Jacob Tyler**; 22: Dec. 11, 2012: Portland, OR 3 Dead (including perp), 1 Wounded. opened fire with an AR15 rifle he had stolen from an acquaintance the day before.

- 175. Rodger, Elliot, 22 years old, on May 23, 2014: stabbed 3, shot and killed 3, and wounded 13, then committed suicide; was taking psychiatric drugs .(including Zanex).. and writes letters, trying to warn the world that SSRI drugs can kill; He.had been seeing therapists on and off since he was 8, family friend Simon Astaire said. When he went to high school in Van Nuys, California, he met with a therapist "pretty much every day,"
- 176. **Rodriguez, Jason**, 40: Nov 6, 2009 (the day after Maj Hasan shootings); bankrupt and behind \$11,000 in child support, an engineer who was fired two years ago showed up around 11:45 a.m. Friday at his former workplace, and began to shoot randomly. former mother-in-law of Rodriguez goes on the record saying, "He was under medication ...for control of the brain." Orlando shooter is now confirmed to have been on psychiatric medications when he went on a Shooting spree in an Orlando office building last week, killing one person and wounding five others.
- 177. **Romano, Jon W; age 16**, Feb 10, 2004; fired at least two shotgun shells before he was tackled by an assistant principal at Columbia High School, New York, on Xanax . (SSRI), for depression and had previously spent time in a psychiatry care facility.
- 178. **Roof, Dylann Storm:** 21, wearing jacket stitched with the Apartheid-era South African flag; shot and killed 9 people after opening fire at the **Emanuel AME Church** in Charleston, South Carolina. According to a roommate, he had allegedly been "planning something like that for six months, 6/17/2015." According to a <u>CBS News report</u>, earlier this year when cops searched Roof after he was acting suspiciously inside a Bath and Body Works store, they found "orange strips" that Roof told officers was suboxone, a narcotic that is used to treat opiate addiction. Suboxone is a habit-forming drug that has been connected with sudden outbursts of aggression.
- 179. **Routhier, Diane,** ; was prescribed Welbutrin for *gallstone problems*. Six days later, after suffering many adverse effects of the drug, she shot herself. ...wife of Allan Routhier, MA Director for ICFDA, organizing the protest, whose wife, Diane, shot herself in the head and died six days after being given Wellbutrin for stomach pain
- 180. **Saari, Matti, 22:** September 2008, culinary student, shot and killed 9 students and a teacher, and wounded another student, before killing himself. --- at **Kauhajoki school shooting** occurred on 23 September 2008, at the <u>Seinäjoki University of Applied Sciences[4]</u> in **Western Finland**. Saari was **taking an SSRI and a benzodiazapine**.
- 181. Sallee, Samuel Earl 55: Waynesville, IN, 5/11/13 The shooter killed four people in a home where methamphetamine was subsequently discovered, leading police to believe the crime was drug-related. A Ruger 10/22 .22-caliber rifle was recovered. GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: The alleged shooter, who had been at the location of the homicides just hours before the bodies were discovered, was taken into custody two days after the shooting. He was prohibited from possessing firearms due to several prior felony convictions including for intimidation, drunk driving (on multiple occasions), receipt of stolen property, and battery. charged him with illegal firearm possession.
- 182. **San Marco, Jennifer 44:** Jan. 30, 2006: Goleta, CA Was in psychiatric hospital in 2001. Likely taking SSRIs, former US Postal Service employee, 8 Dead (including perp), 0 Wounded.
- 183. Segura-Rodriguez, Raul, 36: Chicago, IL, 9/2/10 The shooter murdered four individuals execution-style in a garage on South Kildare Avenue. Officials believe he was part of a drug-trafficking crew that had been involved in at least 10 other

- killings. GUN DETAILS: Unknown GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: Member of drug gang, gang-connected...
- 184. Sencion, Eduardo, 32; (2011) Eduardo Sencion entered an IHOP restaurant in Carson City, Nev., and shot 12 people. Five died, including three National Guard members. According to CBS affiliate KTVN, the shooter's motive was unclear, but family members said he had mental issues. He had never been in the military and had no known affiliation with anyone inside the restaurant. Investigators said his family first became aware of mental health issues when Sencion complained about being harassed by co-workers. He sought treatment when his employer told the family he was becoming increasing paranoid. Family members said Sencion took his medication, and all but one of his mental health commitments were voluntary. The report did not say how many times Sencion was hospitalized. But Sencion told his family he avoided intimate relationships because he feared "he would father a child and pass along his illness." He immersed himself in the Bible, and gave his mother keys to his gun safe, warning her he was "getting sick."He thought people were demons trying to hurt him, and began hearing voices telling him to do "bad things" to people. Sencion's medications were changed this summer. About a month later, he approached a priest in the street and asked him for help, telling the priest, "They're telling me to do bad things." The night before the shootings, Sencion, who lived with family members, took his medication at 10 p.m. Everything appeared normal the next morning. His last comment to his family was, "I should have gone to work today."
- 185. **Shanahan, Chris age 15** (Paxil) in Rigby, ID who, out of the blue, killed a woman.
- 186. **Shick**, **John**, 31: Mar. 8, 2012: Pittsburgh, PA– 9 antidepressants were found in his apartment. 2 Dead (including perp), 6 Wounded.
- 187. Simms, Nathaniel D. 26: Washington, DC, 3/30/10 Three gunmen killed four and wounded five in retaliation for another murder. Orlando Carter, 20, and unnamed 14-year-old juvenile. GUN DETAILS: An AK-47 assault rifle and 9mm and .45-caliber handguns GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: The adults were reported to have lengthy criminal histories, which prohibited them from purchasing guns, and the 14-year-old was too young to purchase or own a gun.
- 188. Smith, Joel 33: Saco, ME, 7/26/15 The shooter fatally shot his wife, their two children ages four and seven, and his 12-year-old stepson at their home before fatally shooting himself. GUN DETAILS: Pump-action 12 gauge shotgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: There is no evidence that the shooter was prohibited from possessing firearms.
- 189. **Smith**, **Rick Odell**, 43: Manchester, IL, 4/24/13 The shooter broke into a home and **killed the grandmother of his child and four of her family members** including two young children, apparently related to a custody dispute over his 3-year-old daughter. The shooter was subsequently killed in a gunfight with law enforcement. GUN DETAILS: All of the victims were killed with a Winchester 20-gauge pump-action shotgun. A .270 Bolt Action Winchester rifle and Ruger carbine rifle were also recovered. PROHIBITING CRITERIA: The shooter had been **previously convicted for felony reckless homicide**, along **with drug possession** and **writing bad checks**.
- 190. **Solomon, T. J. 15-year-old**,: May 20, 1999: **High school campus**, Conyers, GA **Ritalin and treated for depression**. 0 Dead, 6 Wounded.

- 191. **Speight, Christopher, 42:** Jan. 19, 2010: Appomattox, VA Relatives said he began having "mental problems" after his mom died in 2006. 8 Dead, 0 Wounded.
- 192. Spirit, Don Charles, 51: Bell, FL, 9/18/14 The shooter fatally shot his daughter and his six grandchildren, ranging from two months to 11 years of age. When police responded to the crime scene, the shooter fatally shot himself. GUN DETAILS: .45-caliber handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: The shooter was prohibited from possessing firearms due to multiple felony convictions. In 1996 he was convicted of felony possession of marijuana and in 2001, after unintentionally shooting and killing his eight-year old son while on a hunting trip, he was convicted of felony possession of a firearm by a felon.
- 193. **Stawicki, Ian Lee,** 40 Seattle, WA, 5/20/12 The shooter **killed five people** in a string of neighborhood shootings that began in a coffee shop, and later killed himself. • GUN DETAILS: At least one Para-Ordnance .45-caliber handgun some reports say he carried two. GUN ACQUIRED: Stawicki legally purchased the weapon used in the shooting in addition to two others. PROHIBITING CRITERIA: The shooter was **a concealed carry permit holder** but had a **history of mental illness and arrests**. He was **twice charged with misdemeanor assault** but both cases were dismissed when Analysis of Recent MASS SHOOTINGS the victims his girlfriend and brother refused to testify. Before the shooting, Stawicki's **family attempted to have his concealed carry permit revoked.** Stawicki's **family had become concerned that his mental health had worsened**. However, his family was rebuffed by authorities, who said they had no legal basis to revoke Stawicki's permit on claims about Stawicki's behavior alone.
- 194. **Stoves, Rashad 17; Underwood, Artavius 16; Mims, Reginald 16:** Birmingham, AL, 1/29/12; During an attempted robbery at a home, the shooters killed five individuals ages 19 to 42. • GUN DETAILS: Two 9mm handguns and a .38-caliber handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: All three shooters were prohibited from possessing handguns due to their age.
- 195. Stringer, Marvin Lamar (22); Conway, Samuel, (23); and Pickney, Jeremy (23), all Black: killed five people in Arkansas in 2009, These were later identified as 56-year-old Edward Gentry Jr., his 52-year-old wife Pam, their 24-year-old son Jeremy, and Jeremy's 19-year-old girlfriend Kristyn Warneke (all white). They had all been shot to death. ... the body of 80-year-old Edward Gentry Sr. was ... shot to death execution style ... burglarized: flat-screen televisions, guns, and two sets of rims and tires had been stolen. Police records state, the killers "stayed awhile" after they killed the victims which indicates in other similar robbery-murders that they tortured and raped their victims before killing them. - 196. Stewart, Robert, 45: (March 29, 2009) Eight people died in a shooting at the Pinelake Health and Rehab nursing home in Carthage, NC. The gunman, 45-year-old Robert Stewart, was targeting his estranged wife who worked at the home and survived. Stewart was sentenced to life in prison. Richard Wagner, a toxicologist with the State Bureau of Investigations, testified that blood samples taken from Robert Stewart hours after the shooting show he had several prescription drugs in his system. Wagner told jurors Stewart was reported to have the antidepressant Lexipro, sleep-aid Ambien, Benadryl, and possibly Xanax in his blood system on March 29, 2009. Wagner said he was unable to determine the amount of each drug that was found in Stewart's blood stream because the time these drugs can stay in a person's system can vary.

- 197. Stone, Bradley 35: Souderton, PA, 12/15/14 The shooter fatally shot his ex-wife, mother-in-law, sister-in-law, brother-in-law, and grandmother-in-law. He also fatally stabbed his niece and stabbed and injured his nephew before fatally poisoning himself. GUN DETAILS: .40-caliber Heckler & Koch handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: In 2013, the shooter was arrested for a third DUI offense, admitted to Veterans' Treatment Court, and sentenced to 23 months of supervision. He was receiving treatment for substance abuse after being arrested in 2013 for driving under the influence, his third such arrest since 2001. Mr. Stone was placed under the auspices of a local Veterans Treatment Court, put under house arrest for 90 days and prohibited from possessing firearms.
- 198. **Strohmeyer, Jeremy, 18: May 25, 1997:** raped and murdered a 7-year-old African American girl in Las Vegas, Nevada. Strohmeyer had been diagnosed with ADD and prescribed Dexedrine, a Ritalin-like drug, immediately prior to the killing
- 199. Sweatt, Bryan Eugene, was 27: who killed five people in Callison, South Carolina in 2013, Callison, SC, 10/29/13 A man shot and killed the mother of his child, her parents, and her two nephews in their home before killing himself. The shooter and the mother had been engaged in a custody-battle over their 7-month-old daughter, and days before the incident he had written an ominous post on Facebook: "im [sic] about to lose it." GUN DETAILS: .44-caliber handgun GUN ACQUIRED: The gun belonged to the maternal grandfather of his child; Sweatt apparently stole it when he entered the house and took the family hostage. PROHIBITING CRITERIA: The shooter had a lengthy arrest record dating back ten years, Drugs, alcohol history, and was out on bond. which all prohibited him from possessing guns.
- 200. Talovic, Sulejman, 18: Feb. 12, 2007: Salt Lake City, UT carrying a <u>pump-action shotgun</u>, a <u>38-caliber handgun</u>, [4] and a backpack full of extra ammunition during the <u>shooting</u>..... Talović repeatedly <u>shouted "Allahu Akbar</u> 6 Dead (including perp), 4 Wounded. According to my friends on the SWAT team who responded to the scene first, the terrorist killed four individuals inside a gift shop <u>Jihad execution style</u>. He actually made them kneel down. Then he put the gun barrel to the back of their heads and killed each one of them one by one.

 The day after the shooting, I observed a <u>man dressed</u> as a <u>Muslim cleric</u> being arrested by the West Valley Police on his way
 - The day after the shooting, I observed a man dressed as a Muslim cleric being arrested by the West Valley Police on his way to the Kaadeeja Islamic Center in West Valley City. My friends in law enforcement confirmed that this man is the Uncle of Sulejman Talovic.
 - "Of course the FBI is denying there is any link to terrorism because the DOJ has a direct order from President Bush to ensure that no terrorist attacks occur on American soil since 9/11."
- 201. **Tapia, Salvador 36:** Aug. 27, 2003: Chicago, IL –, 7 Dead (including perp), 0 Wounded. After **Mexican immigrant** Salvador Tapia slaughtered six employees at the Windy City Core Supply warehouse in Chicago in 2003, the Times plastered the story all over -- one article on Page 14 of the late edition. The Washington Post also ran one. Cline said Tapia had been **arrested 12 times**, dating back to a conviction in 1989 for unlawful use of a weapon and multiple domestic battery and aggravated assault arrests.
- 202. Thomas, Maron 20: Bellville, TX, 1/16/10 The shooter, a converted Muslim, became angered after a household argument, then fatally shot his mother, stepfather, sister, brother and beheaded his niece. GUN DETAILS: Handgun and shotgun and Machete• GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: The shooter was under 21, and could not legally be in possession of a handgun.

- 203. Thomas, Tonya, 33 Port St. John, FL, 5/15/12 The shooter attacked her four children ages 12 to 17 in her home, killing them before shooting and killing herself. An autopsy indicated that she had a blood alcohol level of .16 at the time of the shooting twice the legal limit. • GUN DETAILS: Taurus .38-caliber revolver AMMO DETAILS: She fired 18-hollow-point rounds during the incident, reloading the gun three times. GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: There is no evidence she was prohibited from possessing a gun. The shooter was charged with misdemeanor battery in 2002 for striking the father of her children but it was later dropped.
- 204. Thornton, Charles Lee, 53: Feb. 7, 2008: Kirkwood, MO 6 Dead (including perp), 2 Wounded. A Black contractor upset at white city council establishment
- 205. **Thornton, Omar, 34**: Aug. 3, 2010: Manchester, CT work place violence for being disciplined, a <u>black thief who</u> <u>murdered eight white men</u> in 2010 for being "<u>racist</u>." 9 Dead (including perp), 2 Wounded. Had a Concealed Carry Permit. http://takimag.com/article/monsters of egotism steve sailer/print#ixzz3yxNFT9wC;
- 206. **Todd, Jason** ("J.T.") Ready, 39: Gilbert, AZ, 5/2/12 The shooter, formerly a member of the U.S. Marine Corps and a founder and leader of a border militia group, shot and killed four people including **his girlfriend**, before killing himself. At the time of the incident he was running for the office of Pinal County Sheriff. • GUN DETAILS: At least two handguns and a shotgun were recovered from the scene. Six-armor piercing grenades, which may not legally be possessed by civilians, were also recovered. GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: There is no evidence that the shooter was prohibited from owning guns, even though he had a record of dangerous behavior. In 1992, he was arrested for damage to property and aggravated assault with a weapon and pled guilty to simple assault, a misdemeanor. He was court-martialed twice during his military service, the second resulting in a bad conduct discharge in 1996. In 2009, a **woman filed an order of protection against him**, but it was not active at the time of the shooting. Officers had also responded to **multiple domestic violence calls from Ready's home**. Indeed, his girlfriend went to police headquarters on February 28, 2012 to make a complaint and report two domestic violence incidents, but she did not go to court to file for an order of protection.
- 207. Tyner, David Allen (pled guilty), 31 and Denny Edward Phillips (pled not guilty), 34: Oklahoma City, OK, 11/9/2009 The shooter or shooters killed four people in a house before setting the building on fire. Two of the victims were pregnant. The crime was premeditated by two conspirators, and related to drugs they sold for one of the victims. It is unclear whether just one or both of the conspirators were present for the shooting, but both were charged with six counts of murder. Tyner surrendered to authorities a week after the killings. Phillips was arrested in Tulsa in April 2010 after allegedly attempting to sell two guns stolen from a police sergeant's home. GUN DETAILS: Handgun AMMO DETAILS: Two types of bullet cases were recovered at the crime scene. GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: Phillips was prohibited due to a lengthy criminal history including multiple felony convictions. Phillips was convicted in 1996 for assault with a deadly weapon, and other crimes including a jail escape. He was also convicted in 2010 for possession of a firearm by a felon. He was also convicted of aggravated assault and battery. There is no indication that Tyner was prohibited, though he was reportedly a member of a prison gang.

- 208. Underwood, Artavius 16; Stoves, Rashad 17; Mims, Reginald 16: Birmingham, AL, 1/29/12; During an attempted robbery at a home, the shooters killed five individuals ages 19 to 42. • GUN DETAILS: Two 9mm handguns and a .38-caliber handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: All three shooters were prohibited from possessing handguns due to their age.
- 209. **Uyesugi, Bryan Koji**, (**40**): Nov. 2, 1999: Honolulu, HI Underwent psychiatric evaluation and Anger Management in 1993 (age 34). 7 Dead, 0 Wounded.
- 210. **Un-named boy from Houston, age 10,** shot and killed his father after his Prozac dosage was increased.
- 211. unnamed 14-year-old juvenile; Simms, Nathaniel D. 26; and Orlando Carter, 20: Washington, DC, 3/30/10; Three gunmen killed four and wounded five in retaliation for another murder. GUN DETAILS: An AK-47 assault rifle and 9mm and .45-caliber handguns GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: The adults were reported to have lengthy criminal histories, which prohibited them from purchasing guns, and the 14-year-old was too young to purchase or own a gun.
- 212. **Unknown:** Cypress, TX, 2/3/14 An unknown assailant executed a Chinese immigrant couple and their two young sons age 7 and 9 inside their home. The couple were naturalized American citizens and the husband worked for an oil company in Houston. The case was transferred to the FBI, and as of June 2, 2014, no suspect had been identified and the investigation remains open. GUN DETAILS: Unknown; likely gang-related...
- 213. **Unknown shooter**: Detroit, MI, 12/4/12 **Three adults and one minor** were shot to death in a house on the east side of the city before a fire broke out, apparently set by the shooter. As of June 24, 2015, authorities had not identified a suspect. GUN DETAILS: Unknown GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: Unknown
- 215. **unknown assailant**, 10/9/13: Paris, TX, shot and killed four men who ranged in age from 18 to 32. Press reports indicated that three of the four victims had criminal histories. GUN DETAILS: Unknown; Likely gang and drug related
- 216. unknown assailant: San Francisco, CA, 1/9/15: shot and killed four young men while they were in a parked car on the street. Police say at least four guns were involved in the incident and two guns were recovered inside the car. GUN DETAILS: Semiautomatic weapon GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: Unknown , likely gang-related..., likely under-age firearms possession
- 217. **unknown assailant**, 12/1/13: **Topeka, KS**, shot and killed four people a woman whose body was found in her car behind a strip mall and her brother, ex-husband, and female friend, whose bodies were found in her house. GUN DETAILS: Unknown GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: Unknown

- 218. **Unknown shooters in Biker Gangs: Waco, TX 5/17/15** A **brawl between rival biker ga**ngs erupted into a shootout in which **nine bikers were killed and 18 others were injured**. Police engaged in the shootout and fired on the bikers. SHOOTER NAME: Unknown GUN DETAILS: Unknown GUNs ACQUIRED: Unknown
- 219. Unknown: Willowbrook, CA, 2/11/11 Two brothers, their uncle, and their cousin were shot and killed by an unknown assailant on the patio of their home. • GUN DETAILS: Unknown, Witnesses reported that the shooting was loud and continuous. (Possible gang related...) Police believe a semiautomatic weapon was used. GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: The assailant is unknown.
- 220. Vargas, Pedro: 42, Washington, Hialeah, Florida, 7/26/2013, set fire to his apartment, Native of Cuba, came to US in 1997, and gained citizenship in 2004; killed the two managers of his building, a bystander across the street, and three more occupants before a SWAT team stormed the building and fatally shot him. His mother told the 911 dispatcher that her son needed a psychological evaluation; set \$10,000 on fire and burned apartment, then shot 2 neighbors coming to help, two others in parking lot, and 2 more... Vargas obtained a concealed weapons permit after completing a two-hour training and four-hour safety course in the fall of 2010 and passed a criminal/mental background check in 2010 when purchasing the Glock 17 in 9mm.
- 221. **Viktor, Jarred; age 15**, (Paxil), after five days on Paxil he stabbed his grandmother 61 times.
- Wade, Jordyn D., 16; and Adams, Robert Lee, 27 (shooter): who is also been charged in the murder.: Columbus, OH, 6/13/15 The shooter killed a man, the man's daughter, and two other victims inside the man's home. He also shot and injured a 16-year-old girl. Wade held the victims at gunpoint while Adams shot them. Handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: The shooter was prohibited from possessing firearms due to a 2008 felony robbery conviction.
- **Washington, Clarence, 35:** Culpeper, VA, 8/4/14 The shooter **fatally shot his wife and three daughters** ages four, six, and thirteen and then fatally shot himself inside their home.. GUN DETAILS: 380 Hi-Point pistol was used; in addition, a .22 rifle was recovered at the scene GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: There is no evidence that the shooter was prohibited from possessing firearms.
- Washington, Edward 33, and Dwayne Moore, 35, Boston, MA, 9/28/10 The shooters killed four and wounded one during a drug-related robbery. were both charged in the execution style killings. Washington was acquitted (Mis-trial: Washington admitted taking part in the robbery, but said he left before the shootings.). In Moore's first trial, the jury deadlocked 11-1 in favor of his guilt, but he was later convicted in a retrial. GUN DETAILS: .40-caliber Iberia handgun and 9mm Cobray semiautomatic. The Cobray has not been recovered, but the weapon was identified based on recovered bullets and shell casings. AMMO DETAILS: 14 rounds fired GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: Participating in a criminal act that results in the death of anyone is grounds for murder conviction.
- 225. Watts, Alvin Lee 34 and Jacob Carl England: Apr. 6, 2012: Tulsa, OK Hate crimes <u>targeting black victims</u>, and Taking medication for depression. 3 Dead, 2 Wounded

- 226. **Weise, Jeff, 16**: Mar 21, 2005: Red Lake, MN Prozac. 16-year-old Native American Jeff Weise, living on Minnesota's Red Lake Indian Reservation, shot and killed nine people and wounded five others before killing himself. Weise had been taking **Prozac** (prescribed and diagnosed). 10 Dead (including perp), 7 Wounded.
- 227. **Wesbecker, Joseph T.; (1989)** In another famous case, 47-year-old Joseph T. Wesbecker, just a month after he began taking **Prozac (prescribed and diagnosed) in 1989**, shot 20 workers at Standard Gravure Corp. in Louisville, Ky., killing nine. Prozac maker Eli Lilly later settled a lawsuit brought by survivors.
- Whitman, Charles, 25, August 1, 1966, stabbed his mother and wife to death, and after striking and killing the tower 228. receptionist, he then killed a total of 15 people and wounded 31 from a position on the Texas Tower, using a Universal M1 semi-autmatic carbine, two additional ammunition magazines, and eight boxes of ammunition, he purchased four more carbine magazines, six additional boxes of ammunition, and a can of gun cleaning solvent. [10] At Sears he purchased a Sears Model 60 12 gauge semi-automatic shotgun; a Remington 700 6-mm bolt-action scoped hunting rifle, a .35-caliber pump rifle, a .30caliber carbine (M1), a 9-mm Luger pistol, a Galesi-Brescia .25-caliber pistol, a Smith & Wesson M19 .357 Magnum revolver, and more than 700 rounds of ammunition. For 90 minutes, firing from various positions on the observation deck above the 27th floor, with a variety of weapons... Before the attack, Whitman had sought professional help for "overwhelming" violent impulses".[4] including fantasies about shooting people from the tower.[4] An autopsy after his death revealed a brain tumor. Had gambling problems and bad grades and lost scholarship. Patrolman Billy Speed, one of the first officers to arrive, took refuge with a colleague behind a columned stone wall. Whitman shot through the six-inch space between the columns of the wall and killed Speed. Officer Houston McCoy, 26, Allen Crum, a 40-year-old retired Air Force tail gunner, Public Safety Agent Dub Cowan and Austin Police Officer Jerry Day up the elevator; Cowan provided Crum with a rifle. Officer Ramiro "Ray" Martinez was off duty responded to assist. Officers and several civilians provided suppressive fire from the ground with small weapons and hunting rifles, forcing Whitman to stay low and fire through storm drains at the foot of the observation deck's wall. A police sharpshooter in a small plane was driven back by Whitman's return fire but continued to circle at a distance, seeking to distract Whitman and further limit his freedom to choose targets. [6]
- 229. **Wilson, James; age 19**, (various psychiatric drugs) from Breenwood, South Carolina, took a **.22 caliber revolver** into an **elementary school** killing two young girls, and wounding seven other children and two teachers.

- 233. **Willkomm**, **Billy**, **19**: an accomplished wrestler and a University of Florida student, was prescribed Prozac at the **age of 17**. His family found him dead of suicide hanging from a tall ladder at the family's Gulf Shore Boulevard home in July 2002.
- 234. Wong, Jiverly, 43: Apr. 3, 2009: Binghamton, NY a Brazilian Ph.D. in Mathematics and visiting scholar at Binghamton University, had a psychiatric disorder and was under medication; 14 Dead (including perp), 4 Wounded.
- 235. **Wood, Christopher, 34**: Apr. 17, 2009: Middletown, MD, shot and killed his wife, three small children and himself inside their home. Toxicology test results verified that Wood had Nortriptyline (Pamelor), as well as the anti-anxiety drugs Zolpidem (Ambien) and Alprazolam (Xanax). Antidepressants Bupropion (Wellbutrin), Amitriptyline (Elavil), Nortriptyline (Pamelor) and the antianxiety drugs Zolpidem (Ambien) and Alprazolam (Xanax). 5 Dead (including perp), 0 Wounded.
- 236. Woodham, Luke; age 16: (on Prozac) killed his mother and then killed two students (school), wounding six others.
- 237. **Woodward, Julie; age 17**, was on Zoloft when she hung herself in her family's detached garage.
- 238. **Woody** _____, age 37, committed suicide while in his 5th week of taking Zoloft. Shortly before his death his physician suggested doubling the dose of the drug. He had seen his physician only for insomnia. He had never been depressed, nor did he have any history of any mental illness symptoms.
- 239. Yates, Andrea, 21+; (2001) Andrea Yates, in one of the most heartrending crimes in modern history, drowned all five of her children aged 7 years down to 6 months in a bathtub. Insisting inner voices commanded her to kill her children. She had become increasingly psychotic over the course of several years. At her 2006 murder re-trial (after a 2002 guilty verdict was overturned on appeal), Yates' longtime friend Debbie Holmes testified: "She asked me if I thought Satan could read her mind and if I believed in demon possession?" And Dr. George Ringhoiz, after evaluating Yates for two days, recounted an experience she had after the birth of her first child: "What she described was feeling a presence ... Satan ... telling her to take a knife and stab her son Noah," Ringhoiz said, adding that Yates' delusion at the time of the bathtub murders was not only that she had to kill her children to save them, but that Satan had entered her and that she had to be executed in order to kill Satan. Yates had been taking the anti-depressant Effexor.
- Yazdanpanah, Aziz, 56: Grapevine, TX, 12/25/11 The shooter, a Muslim, 'honor' killed his entire family: his estranged wife, two children, and three other family members as they opened their Christmas presents, before killing himself. The shooter's wife had filed for bankruptcy in August 2010 and reportedly separated from him during the proceedings, moving to the apartment complex where the shooting took place. GUN DETAILS: 9mm and .40-caliber handguns GUN ACQUIRED: The 9mm was purchased in 1996 and registered to the shooter. PROHIBITING CRITERIA: In 1996, the shooter pled guilty to one count of subscribing to a false income tax return, and was fined \$1000 and placed on three years' probation. But police said the 9mm was legally registered to the shooter. (If a person has been found guilty of a crime punishable by a sentence of one year or more in prison ((3 years probation)), cannot possess a firearm)...

Zawahri, John 23: Jun. 7, 2013: Santa Monica, CA — Zawahri was hospitalized in UCLA's psychiatric ward in 2006 after police found bomb-making materials in his home. 6 Dead (including perp), 3 Wounded. American-born son of Lebanese immigrants, admitted to UCLA's psychiatric ward for a brief period. Arab Muslim, Hialeah apartment shooting Santa Monica, California 6/7/2013, armed with a homemade assault rifle - a .223 caliber AR-15 assault rifle that did not have a serial number; (prohibited in California). A .44-caliber "black powder" revolver that had been converted to fire .45-caliber rounds and three 'Zip Guns,' which are illegal to possess, were also recovered. • and 40 30 rd high-capacity magazines (illegal to purchase, sell, or transfer in the state of California)., killed his brother and father at home, shot and wounded a passing driver who tried to intervene. He then carjacked another vehicle and made the driver transport him to Santa Monica College, firing at a city bus and police cruiser along the way, injuring three. and then headed to Santa Monica College, where he was eventually killed by police. alternative spelling of John's surname — Zawahiri as in Amman, Osama bin Laden's number two and now head of Al Qaeda. John apparently has a tie to Lebanon as his mother resides there while Ayman is Egyptian, thought to be currently hiding out in Pakistan. John had a brother named Chris whom he killed. He is also associated to Ziad Jarrah, one of the 9/11 terrorists who grew up in Beirut and attended a Catholic School yet got swept up in jihad.

Washington Post Claims 29 Mass Murders By Concealed Carriers... But They LIED.

- Michael Joe Hood shot three in 2010, not 2007. This was not a mass shooting (the FBI definition of a mass shooting is four or more), and with his documented **history of mental illness**, Hood should not have had a concealed carry permit, and there is some dispute over whether he did. He **did not use a concealed weapon**.
- Jason Hamilton had a previous domestic violence conviction, and should not have been able to own any
 firearms. His attack did not involve concealed weapons. We can find no credible confirmation at all that
 Hamilton had title II weapons or a concealed carry permit, as VPC claims via a singular erroneous news report.
- Terrance Hough, a Cleveland firefighter who shot five people for setting off fireworks in the street, **did not use a concealed weapon**.
- Guillermo Zarabozo really did use a concealed weapon to murder four people in an act of piracy on the high seas.
 He is the first person on this list with a concealed carry permit who used a concealed weapon to commit mass murder.
- Charles Johnson shot three people. This was not a mass shooting.
- Aaron Jackson murdered his wife and two children before committing suicide. He did not use a concealed weapon.
- Troy Brake shot three people to death, and beat a fourth victim to death. This again, was not a mass shooting by FBI standards, although it was a mass killing.
- Frank Garcia did not have a concealed carry permit at all. He had a handgun ownership permit only.
- Michael McLendon carried out a horrific attack that killed ten people before he took his own life. None of his victims was shot by a handgun, concealed or otherwise.
- Jiverly Wong was a concealed carry permit holder who used concealed weapons to commit a mass shooting. He is
 the second person on this list with a concealed carry permit who used a concealed weapon to commit mass
 murder.
- Richard Poplowski ambushed police officers who came to his home with a rifle. He did not use a concealed weapon in his firefight with police.
- George Sodini is the third person on this list with a concealed carry permit who used concealed weapons to commit
 mass murder.
- Paul Michael Merhige is the fourth person on this list with a concealed carry permit who used concealed weapons
 to commit mass murder.
- William Maxwell murdered his wife and two children with a handgun before committing suicide. The handgun was not concealed, and his concealed carry permit was irrelevant.
- Justin Matern murdered his estranged wife and children before committing suicide. He did have a concealed handgun permit, but it was irrelevant to the crimes.
- Christopher Speight did kill eight people and injure several more. With a rifle. That he had a concealed carry permit was irrelevant to the crimes he committed.

- Gerardo Regalado "came in running" with handgun when he shot seven women in Hialeah, Florida. His handgun was not concealed prior to the attack.
- Omar Thorton was fired for theft, then returned to the job and shot eight co-workers to death before taking his life.
 He is the fifth person on this list with a concealed carry permit who used concealed weapons to commit mass murder.
- I cannot find any evidence that Tan Do had a concealed carry permit.
- Ian Stawiki is the sixth person on this list with a concealed carry permit who used concealed weapons to commit mass murder.
- Paul Clifford Moore shot three people; again, this is not a mass killing by FBI standards. He retrieved a weapon
 from inside his own home and used it inside his own home against the victims. Concealed carry played no part in
 the murders.
- Kevin Cleeves shot three people... once again, the VPC is adding crimes that are not mass killings. Because of a
 prior domestic violence conviction in Arizona, Cleeves was not eligible to possess or use a firearm, much less have
 a concealed carry permit.
- Andrew Engeldinger did NOT have a concealed carry permit when he committed mass murder in Minneapolis.
 Permit applications were found at his home, but he had not applied.
- Ferdarius Shine did not commit a mass shooting, killing three people. He opened fire in his own home, so a concealed carry permit was irrelevant, and there is some dispute as to whether or not he actually had a permit.
- Dennis Clark murdered four people with a shotgun. Again, concealed carry was not in any way relevant to the crime.
- Pedro Vargas began his attack in his apartment by committing arson, and then started shooting. Again, concealed carry was not relevant to his crimes.
- Aaron Alexis, the Washington Navy Yard killer, used a shotgun in the commission of his crimes. Concealed carry was not relevant.
- Kenneth Allen Keith killed three (again, less than the FBI minimal definition of a mass shooting... during a robbery attempt.
- Craig Hicks killed three Muslims in Chapel Hill, NC. This was not a mass shooting, and concealed carry was not relevant as Hick ambushed the family in their home.
- Christopher Ingraham, an anti-gun propagandist apparently hired for that purpose by the Washington Post, used a propaganda report by the rabidly anti-gun Violence Policy Center (VPC) to assert concealed carriers were responsible for "at least" mass murders.

- Of those 29 alleged mass murders carried out by concealed carry permit holders, precisely six mass murders (using the accepted FBI definition of a mass murder, which is four or more victims) were carried out by concealed carry permit holders using concealed handguns.
- Seven of the claimed "29 mass shootings" were not mass shootings.
- Between four and eight of the "concealed carry permit holders" did not have concealed carry permits.
- The Violence Policy Center has a long and well-documented history of "reports" that are nothing more or less than propaganda.
- Any reporter that uses such overt and unverifed propaganda should be terminated, along with their editors.

Barker, Diana 71, accidentally shot by .38 derringer from concealed carry permit holder, who dropped the gun out of his pocket, causing the discharge. January 13, 2011. KINGWOOD, Texas -- A Kingwood man who accidentally shot an elderly woman when his gun dropped from his coat pocket says he's totally distraught after the incident. It happened as the man (who did not want to be identified) was having dinner on Jan. 13 at Raffa's in the 1600 block of W. Lake Houston Pkwy. He said he had on a jacket that he hadn't worn in a year. He said he didn't know it had his .38 caliber derringer gun in its pocket. The gun ended up falling out of his pocket. "Everybody looked around. There was a big explosion in the restaurant. No one knew what it was. Then, the person who I was dining with saw the derringer under my seat," he said. The explosion was his gun going off as it hit the floor. Police said a bullet hit another diner, Diana Barker, in the buttocks and continued through her hip, into her abdomen and ended at the right side of her chest. Paramedics rushed the 71-year-old grandmother to Ben Taub Hospital. "I was almost in shock. Oh my God. That's my gun," the Kingwood man said he uttered to himself after the gun went off."I don't even know what to say. I'm sorry the whole thing happened. If I knew there was a gun in the jacket, I would not have gone in the restaurant with it." Twelve days after the accidental shooting, Barker is still in the hospital. Her sons say their mother is making slow, steady progress, but the road to recovery has been tough. The bullet is still lodged inside of her and she can feel it. Once she's able to leave the hospital she's going to need weeks of rehabilitation. "I have been wondering how she is doing. I'm totally distraught over the whole thing. I didn't sleep the whole night," said the Kingwood man. "My prayers are with the family; and I'm hoping she fully recovers." The Kingwood man has a concealed handgun license. According to management at Raffa's, if you have a concealed handgun license, you can bring a gun into the restaurant. At this point, the man whose gun went off is not facing criminal charges. That's why 11 News is not identifying him at this time. However, on Tuesday, sources close to the investigation said the case is not closed. He could still face criminal charges and the case could go before a grand jury. The gun owner told 11 News he knows that is a possibility.

<u>Calderon, Richard, 24</u>: March 4, 2010 4:01:52 PM PST HOUSTON --A driver opened fire on a car carrying a mother and daughter Wednesday night in far southwest Houston, hitting a 13-year-old girl inside. Police say it all stemmed from a hit-and-run wreck. It started around 8:30pm as Alexis Waley, 13, and her mother were leaving a high school basketball game in a Nissan Altima. Police say they were at a stop sign on Westhampton at White Heather when they were struck by the driver of a Cadillac.

Police say that driver, identified as Richard Calderon, 24, drove off, and as he did, Waley's mother followed him to get a description and license plate number.

They were able to get that information, but police believe somewhere along Buffalo Speedway, the situation took a violent turn. Authorities say Calderon opened fire on the teen and her mother, striking Alexis in the back of the head. She was taken to Memorial Hermann Hospital, where her grandfather told us she passed away Thursday afternoon.

"I heard a pop and then I didn't think nothing about until the neighbors were upset, really upset," said witness Tom Johnson.

"The fire department came and then pulled over there on Westhampton Street and they took the girl out the car." Calderon was taken into custody a short time later and admitted to his involvement in the shooting. Police have since charged Calderon with murder.

Waley's mother was not injured in this incident.

Thursday was an extremely difficult and emotional day at Johnston Middle School. Waley was involved in so many different activities at school, was very popular and had a lot of friends. Everyone there is praying and thinking of her family.

At 13, Alexis Waley had a yearning to belong. She played volleyball, softball, and is a member of her middle school's orchestra. Relatives described Waley as outgoing and loving.

"She has a real sweet personality. She was real friendly to everybody," said her grandfather Charles Randle.

"They're emotional. It's a very emotional time for them and it was emotional for us to give that news," said Johnston Middle School Principal Dave Wheat.

As crisis counselors comfort grieving students, Waley's relatives are demanding justice.

"I would like to see that he gets what's coming to him and get all the punishment that's due to him," said Randle.

More than 100 students at the school spent time with grief counselors on Thursday.

Michael McLendon, 38: Kinston, Ala; killed at least 11 people Tuesday afternoon in southern Alabama The suspect, identified early Wednesday morning as Michael McLendon of Kinston, Ala., took his own life after leaving a trail of bloodshed across two towns. Jim Stromenger of the Samson, Ala., Police Department said the shootings occurred in at least four separate locations in two towns. No motive is known at this time, he said.

Coffee County coroner Robert Preachers told The Associated Press that the suspect started his spree by burning down his mother's house, where officials found her body. Preachers confirmed that Lisa McLendon had been shot, along with the family dogs. By late afternoon the shooter had moved on to Samson, where he went to a private home and killed at least five people -- four adults and a child.

Among the dead were the suspect's grandparents, aunt and uncle, confirmed Preachers.

McLendon went on to kill two more people in two separate houses.

"He was just driving down the street shooting at people sitting on their porches," State Sen. Harri Anne Smith, R-Slocomb, told the Dothan Eagle newspaper. "A family was just sitting on the porch and they were shot."

Geneva County coroner Max Motley said he was called to the Big Little Store on West Main Street in Samson, where he found the body of a woman between the gas pump and the front door, the Eagle's Web site reported. She was found face up with at least one fatal gunshot wound.

Samson contractor Greg McCullough said he was pumping gas at the station when the gunman opened fire, wounding him in the shoulder and arm with bullet fragments that struck his truck and the pump.

"I first thought it was somebody playing," he said, explaining that the gunman roared into the parking lot and slammed on his brakes. Then he saw the rifle. He said the gunman fired and the rifle appeared to jam, then he "went back to firing." Then he drove off, according to the AP.

After he fired at a state trooper, police pursued the shooter to Reliable Metal Products, where he fired an estimated 30 rounds. One of the bullets hit the Geneva police chief, who was saved by his bulletproof vest, the Alabama Safety Department said in a statement.

The gunman then went into the plant and shot himself, the AP reported.

The gunman had worked at Reliable Metal, said State Rep. Warren Beck, a Republican whose district includes Geneva.

"My secretary heard gunfire everywhere," he said. "This is one of the most tragic events ever in Geneva County."

State Sen. Harri Anne Smith, R-Slocomb, told the AP some of those killed in Samson were sitting outside.

"He was just driving down the street shooting at people sitting on their porches," she said. "A family was just sitting on the porch, and they were shot."

Reliable Metal Products makes grills and vents for heating and AC systems, mainly for hotels. A call to a person who answered the phone at the plant said no one could talk about the shooting, according to the AP.

The towns of Geneva and Samson are roughly 30 miles south of Fort Rucker, near the Florida border in southeast Alabama. Geneva's population is about 4,400 and Samson's, 2,000.

Senator Thatched and committee member:

I have been reviewing my statistics regarding Mass Murders and the associated chart I presented. Since the Hearing on April 4, 2019, and have determined I had omitted several examples of 'Gun Free Zones' in my initial study, and have corrected about half those case studies. (My original concern was the number of mass murders committed by persons under the influence of Serotonin Reuptake Inhibitors (SSRIs), and other anti-depressants, so i inadvertently din't include churches, hospitals or workplace murders in the Gun Free Zone statistics.)

On review of about half of my case studies, the percentage of Mass Murders in 'Gun Free Zones' appears to be a consistent 44.0%, with SSRIs and controlled drugs, Mental Health, and Domestic Disturbances compiling the greatest percentages of assailants.

I also reviewed the testimony at the hearing and agree with many of those opposing SB 978 and Amendment, and have attached a response by me re: that hearing.

I do hope and pray that this bill and Amendment are 'washed out', as they would have little or no effect on deterring criminals, but would have a tremendously negative effect on law abiding citizens in their right and ability to defend themselves or their animals.

This bill would also negate the potential effect of CCL holders in deterring crime in various institutions and localities.

Overview of April 2, 2019 Hearing re: SB 978

- Requirement for guns to be locked up, with ammo secured in another locked safe:
 Response time to acquire a firearm in an emergency (predator animals, or human
 attackers is critical.
 - Police response time is generally 7 minutes or more in the city, and can be hours in the rural areas.
 - A violent encounter with a predator generally takes only 30 seconds to two minutes –
 unlocking a gun cabinet and then unlocking an ammo cabinet, loading the firearm,
 and then responding to the emergency is generally too late.
 - A violent human intruder encounter in the home generally allows for only seconds to respond. Even unlocking only one cabinet would take too long.
 - Most violent assaults take only 3 minutes, while police response will be 7 minutes to several hours.
 - The firearm must be accessible within seconds, and often the display of it I enough to deter the assailant.
 - I personally have three daughters, and each one of them has been stalked, threatened, and even attacked by x-husbands or x-boyfriends.
 - <u>Daughter A</u> was stalked for weeks by someone making threatening calls and prowling around the residence.
 - The police would come and make a brief look around the residence, and then leave.
 - A trained dog helped, but didn't stop the stalking.
 - In between work schedules, I finally came to bodyguard her myself. One night after the police had come and looked and left; I observed for a while, and went outside, where I heard the stalked in the brush near the building. I ordered him/her out of the brush, and warned that I was armed and an Officer --- He exited uphill about 200 ft through through the brush, started a large motorcycle and left --- never to return or threaten again.
 - The police apparently saw these threats and stalking as either unfounded, or a prank-like matter, and it took me personally (plain clothes from another jurisdiction) to ultimately bring this situation to a halt.
 - <u>Daughter B</u> had a drunken roommate put a rifle to her head, threaten to kill her, and then pulled the trigger.
 - The rifle chamber was empty (magazine loaded) and it did not fire, but he intended to fire it telling her he was going to kill her.
 - Her shepherd dog attacked the assailant, and allowed her time to run out the door and several blocks away, where she called me (hundreds of miles away, and asked what she should do.
 - She called the police, who responded about 20-30 minutes after he tried to shoot her. After a search, found the assailant and arrested him.

- The rifle he possessed was illegal: He was a felon and could not own a weapon, and the rifle was not registered/transferred on legal paperwork.
- The police response was delayed initially because she ran out of the house without her cell phone or keys, and had to use a neighbors phone.
- After being called, the police responded 20-30 minutes after she would have been dead.
- <u>Daughter C</u> Had been dating a fellow for about 6 months to a year, and decided to end the relationship because of his selfish, controlling behavior.
 - He decided to threaten and stalk her for the next several weeks.
 - Police were called and counselled him, but he was not deterred, and told her, "If he couldn't have her, than no one would..."
 - I had trained her in her childhood (now in her 40s) in the use of firearms, so I gave her a refresher course in the use of handguns and a shotgun, and provided her the same and ammunition for practice and defense.
 - She sought a stalking order, but was delayed on her first request.
 - On the second request, it was further delayed, and she initiated an application for a Concealed Carry License, explaining and showing in the paperwork her qualifications and training with firearms.
 - The police contacted him again, after another threat and stalk near her work (a Gun Free Zone), and explained that her dad was a firearms training instructor, she had a gun, and was applying for a permit.
 - She also moved, and he has left her alone since.
 - The police did not have an effect on the stalker for about 2 months, until after she had been trained and provided firearms and ammo.
- When our daughters were small and playing in the field, a car stopped at the bus stop (150 yards South), fired one shot into the field, and then sped off spinning tires and fish-tailing in the gravel past our house and on up the road, firing one more shot as the car went speeding by past our house.
 - I had armed myself, when the girls came screaming and running to the house, and my wife told me to get my gun.
 - I found two empty .22 LR casing at the bus stop and about 50 feet up the road.
 - I reported the incident to the sheriff, who took the report.
 - I had been reporting drug dealers in the area, and believe the gunfire was a warning to quit reporting their drug deals.
 - I saw that car drive by several times in weeks/months to come, but it always slowed down, and never fired shots again
- On our small farm, on many occasions per year, I encounter predators of various sorts attacking our farm animals. Over the 38 years we have lived in

rural Oregon, I have learned to keep a gun handy at all times, and to never go to the barn or loafing shed without a one.

- On several occasions, I have been unarmed and encountered opossums, raccoons, coyote, fox, or cougar attacking or near our animals.
- On a few occasions, I have encountered humans. Once, stampeding our horses, and when I (unarmed) confronted them, they threatened and challenged me to fight the three of them (large, drug and belligerent 20 year olds). Before the age of cell phones, I was unable to call police, but armed myself and they left to drink more beer and then they sent a step-granddaughter of mine to re-issue their challenge to fight --- and bring a gun...(I ignored the challenge.)
- 2. **Gun Free Zones**: are **an invitation** to violent offenders. They know they are not likely to be confronted by anyone capable of defending against them.
 - A better plan would be to require vulnerable buildings and areas to have armed security on duty whenever students/clients are present. These can be either uniformed or plain clothes, understanding that one uniformed officer often becomes the first target.
 - Allowing clients, staff, employees to carry concealed (with proper training) would provide 'plain clothes' security and in numbers...
- 3. <u>Age of purchase</u>: seems an unequal application of the law, whereas a person 18-21 can serve in the military to defend our country in war conditions, and be injured or killed on duty, but not allowed to defend themselves or their families --- because they are too young to purchase/possess a firearm when home.
 - Ironically, if a soldier were to return home (USA) from battle, and have become disabled in combat, under this proposed amendment to SB 978, that disabled soldier would now not only be physically unable to run or fight, would additionally be excluded from being able to use a weapon to defend himself or family.
- 4. <u>Restricting gun rights</u> (i.e.: can't loan firearm to son/grandson daughter or granddaughter) for the purpose for the purpose of providing meat for the family or protecting livestock, or protecting family --- does not seem to logically allow for the greater safety of our citizens.
 - Most stolen guns that have been used in Mass Murders, were stolen after the parent(s) were killed by the assailant, who then went on to commit other murders.
 - Other stolen guns from home not occupied, generally involve a 'Breaking and Enter' by the thief. Breaking into most locked gun cabinets or safes is a simple matter for an accomplished thief, who has already broke and entered -- (Crow bars, cutting torch, hammer and chisel, etc.)
- 5. Concealed Carry License Allowing for restrictions regarding where and when a city, town, school, or other entity would have a right to a not recognize a Concealed Carry License is counter-intuitive. CCL holders often stop violent crimes, as has been shown the case repeatedly through NRA 'The Armed Citizen' reports. Most experts believe that

the more law-abiding, trained citizens carrying weapons (concealed), the more leery criminals are regarding who and where to attack.

- Montana is an open carry state, and has a much lower rate of armed or violent crimes.
- Switzerland is the country where each household is required to have a firearm and be trained in its use, where violent crime is nearly non-existent.
- In the alternative, Chicago and New York (and L./A.) have the most restrictive gun measures/laws in the nation, and also the highest rates of violent crime.

Such laws as are proposed in this Amendment to SB 978, won't have an effect on the criminals --- because they are already breaking the law when they commence their crime. What these proposals would do is make honest, law-abiding citizens either criminals (for violating these laws) or victims (for obeying them).

Kuwaiti-born a naturalized US citizen, opened fire at a Naval reserve center (Gun Free Zone), and then drove to a military recruitment office where he shot and killed four Marines and a Navy service member, and wounded a police officer and another military service member. He was then fatally shot in an exchange of gunfire with law enforcement officers responding to the attack. He had been treated by a child psychiatrist for depression,... In May 2013, Abdulazeez lost his job at a nuclear power plant in Ohio due to a failed drug test,... He taking sleep-aide medicines...and had a prescription for muscle relaxants for his back problem.
- 2. Adamcik, Torey Michael, 15: (see Brian Lee Draper): former American high school students who are currently serving life sentences without the possibility for parole, for murdering their classmate Cassie Jo Stoddart on September 22, 2006. **ID (Zoloft) in 1998 had a Zoloft-induced seizure that caused an armed stand off at his school.
- 3. Adams, Robert Lee jr, 27 (shooter) and 16-year-old Jordyn D. Wade: who is also been charged in the murder.: Columbus, OH, 6/13/15 The shooter killed a man, the man's daughter, and two other victims inside the man's home. He also shot and injured a 16-year-old girl. Handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: The shooter was prohibited from possessing firearms due to a 2008 felony robbery conviction.
- 4. Aldridge, Joseph Jesse, 50: Tyrone, MO, 2/26/15 The shooter went door to door in his neighborhood, shooting and killing four of his cousins and shooting four unrelated neighbors, killing three of them. Afterwards he fled the scene and ultimately shot and killed himself in his car. Neighbors described Aldridge as a recluse within an intimate community, and none knew him well. He mostly mooched off his mother and relished drugs and weapons, said a former friend GUN DETAILS: .45-caliber handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: The shooter was prohibited from possessing firearms due to a 2008 felony conviction for possession of a firearm and drugs by an unlawful user of a controlled substance. Aldridge's autopsy showed he had a 0.256 percent

blood-alcohol content — more than three times the legal limit to drive in Missouri — as well as marijuana and over-the-counter painkillers and allergy medicine in his system.

- 5. Alexis, Aaron, 34, a military veteran and contractor from Texas, Alturas tribal shooting 2/20/2014 Alturas, CA, Alexis created a webpage with the name "Mohammed Salem", relative said he acted in retaliation for U.S. wars in Muslim opened fire in the Navy installation (gun-free zone), killing 12 people and wounding 8 before being shot dead by police. Washington, D.C.
- 6. Ashbrook, Larry Gene, 47: (1999) On Sept. 15, 1999, Larry Gene Ashbrook murdered seven people and injured a further seven at a concert by Christian Rock group Forty Days at Wedgwood Baptist Church (gun free zone) in Fort Worth, Texas. Ashbrook then committed suicide. A doctor had prescribed the anti-depressant drug Prozac for Larry Gene Ashbrook, but investigators are unsure whether he was taking Prozac when he killed seven people and then himself in a Fort Worth church last week, police said on Monday. Fort Worth's Lt. Mark Krey, who is heading the investigation into the largest mass shooting in the city's history, said police have found a Prozac vial in Ashbrook's name.
- 7. Atwater, Alan M., 31: who killed his wife and three children in Oak Harbor, infidelity and verbal abuse, Ohio in 2011, .22-caliber rifle, shotgun
- 8. Auvinen, , Pekka-Eric, 18: 7 November 2007 at **Jokela High School (Gun free zone)** in <u>Jokela</u>, a town in the municipality of <u>Tuusula</u>, <u>Finland</u>. Finnish gunman Pekka-Eric Auvinen, age 18, had been taking antidepressants before he killed eight people and wounded a dozen more at Jokela High School then he committed suicide.
- 9. **Baadsgaard**, **Cory age 16**, Apr 2, 2013: Wahluke (Washington state) High School, was on Paxil (which caused him to have hallucinations) when he took **a rifle** to **his high school (Gun Free Zone)** and held 23 classmates hostage. He has no memory of the event.
- 10. Baker, William D. 66: Feb. 5, 2001: Melrose Park 5 Dead (including perp), 4 Wounded. Work place shooting (gun free Zone), State records show that Baker received his FOID (Firearm Owners Identification card) card in February 1993, and renewed it on May 8, 1998. That was just two weeks before his conviction for sexual assault. "The fact that he was a convicted felon and had four weapons on him that weren't confiscated is amazing to us," said Kirsten Curley, a spokeswoman for the Illinois Council Against Handgun Violence.

- 11. . Barton, Mark Orrin 44: July 29, 1999: Stockbridge, GA The shootings occurred at two Atlanta day trading firms, Momentum Securities and the All-Tech Investment Group (Gun Free Zones). Weapons: Hammer and two pistols, Police found Prozac in his van after the shootings. 13 Dead (including perp), 12 Wounded.
- 12. Barton, Mark Orrin 44: July 29, 1999: Stockbridge, GA --- First killed his wife and family with a hammer, and then went to the investment firms with two handguns.
- 13. Bellar, Troy, 34: May 3, 2009: Lakeland, FL, Tegretol a drug prescribed for "bi-polar disorder, shot and killed his wife and two of his three children in their home before killing himself. —. 4 Dead (including perp), 0 Wounded
- 14. **Bellard, Darrell, 43**, a drug relationship that went very bad, killed four people (including children aged 4 and 3) in Lanham, Maryland in 2010. **Tkeisha Gilmer**, 18, joined Bellard in blocking the escape of the victims. **Gilmer was bipolar and schizophrenic and had other mental health issues.** (http://www.cnn.com/2010/US/08/07/maryland.arrests/index.html). !
- 15. Bennett, David Cornell, jr (Black man): 22, basically stalking her and wouldn't leave her alone, killed a <u>young white mother</u> and her 3 (1/2 black) children, after raping the mother, in Parsons, Kansas in 2013, psychological and sociological history, WaS sent to a state psychiatric hospital one month before the shooting. He had posted a <u>threatening message on Facebook</u> that had been flagged to local police. (http://www.nydailynews.com/news/crime/police-hunt-suspect-kansas-mom-article-Biker gang brawl:
- 16. Bennett, Jacob Allen, 26 and Moser, Brittany Lina Yvonn, 25: Crab Orchard, TN, 9/11/13 The shooters killed a woman and three teenagers, apparently during an attempted robbery during a marijuana exchange. The victims' bodies were discovered in a car parked along the side of the road in the Renegade Mountain resort community near Crossville. GUN DETAILS: Handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: Bennett was prohibited from possessing firearms. In 2010 he received a 6-year prison sentence for charges of theft, forgery, and possession of a handgun during a felony, but was paroled on March 4, 2013. The Cumberland County sheriff's office estimated they had previously arrested Bennett five times.

- 17. <u>Bishop, Amy, 44</u>: professor, February 12, 2010: <u>University of Alabama in Huntsville (Gun Free Zone)</u>, (UAH) in <u>Huntsville, Alabama</u>, shooting those closest to her with a <u>9-millimeter handgun</u>. Three people were killed and three others wounded in a shooting. She had been denied tenure...
- 18. Boren, Joshua 34: Spanish Fork, UT, 1/16/14 The shooter, an officer in the Lindon City Police Department, shot and killed his two children, his wife, and her mother inside of their family home before killing himself. Joshua Boren was sexually abused as a child and had a drug addiction• GUN DETAILS: Handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: Several months prior to the shooting the shooter and his wife had separated and one of her friends reported that she was going to file for divorce because she could no longer tolerate her husband's rage. But he did not have a history domestic abuse or felony convictions, and there is no evidence that he was prohibited from possessing a gun.
- 19. Bournes, Michael, 59: Missoula, MT, 6/07/15 The shooter killed his wife and their three children ages one, four, and five in their home. He then set the house on fire and committed suicide with the gun. GUN DETAILS: .45-caliber handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: Despite a previous criminal history, the shooter was likely prohibited from possessing firearms. In 1999, he was convicted in New Mexico of three misdemeanor crimes: fleeing from an officer, concealing his identity, and resisting, evading or obstructing an officer.
- 20. **Brownlow, Charles Everett**, 36: killed 5 people in an 8 hour crime spree in Terrell, Texas in 2013, mother is dead. So is his aunt. The same goes for two of his acquaintances, plus a convenience store worker. Brownlow **appeared to be on drugs when he was arrested, and mental health history**. A criminal record that prohibited him from possessing firearms. He was convicted of burglarizing a vehicle in 1996, a Class A misdemeanor, and convicted of **felony burglary in 1997**. In 2008 he was served a **three---year sentence for unlawful possession of a firearm** and in 2011 he was convicted of **misdemeanor assault against a family member**. - 21. Burks, Adrian, 37 Kansas City, KS, 6/22/09 The shooter killed a woman with whom he had been romantically linked and three others at the house where she was staying. He had argued with the woman and followed her to the house. GUN DETAILS: Unknown GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: The shooter was prohibited from possessing firearms. He had served 10 years in Kansas prisons for robbery, aggravated assault, and burglary. He also fatally shot a man in March 2009, but he was not charged in the incident, which his cousin later described as "self defense." In April 2009, he was charged with battery and a criminal threat against the sister of the man he killed and was ordered not to possess firearms.
- 22. Bush, Elizabeth; age 13, (Paxil/Prozac) was responsible for a school shooting (Drug Free Zone) in Pennsylvania
- 23. Carneal, Michael (1997) In Paducah, KY, in late 1997, 14-year-old Michael Carneal, son of a prominent attorney, Ruger MK II .22-caliber pistol in his backpack. travelled to Heath High School (Gun Free Zone) and started shooting students in a prayer meeting taking place in the school's lobby, killing three and leaving another paralyzed. Carneal reportedly was on Ritalin.

- 24. Carter, Calvin Lewis III, 22 Rockford, IL, 12/20/14 The shooter went to his ex-girlfriend's home and fatally shot her, her two children, and her boyfriend. GUN DETAILS: Handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: There is no evidence that the shooter was prohibited from possessing firearms.
- 25. **Castillo, Alvaro Rafael, 19:** Aug. 30, 2006: Hillsborough, NC **At former high school,** shot his father, **Rafael**, 65, seven times in the head and neck, obessed with Columbine shooting. On drugs for depression. 1 Dead, 2 Wounded.
- 26. Cho, Seung-Hui (2007), 23: Seung-Hui Cho was a Korean spree killer who killed 32 people and wounded 17 others on April 16, 2007, at Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University in Blacksburg, Virginia. He was a senior-level undergraduate student at the university. The shooting rampage came to be known as the "Virginia Tech massacre." Cho later committed suicide after law enforcement officers breached the doors of the building where the majority of the shooting had taken place. His body is buried in Fairfax, Va., In middle school, he was diagnosed with a severe anxiety disorder known as Selective Mutism, as well as major depressive disorder. After this diagnosis he began receiving treatment and continued to receive therapy and special education support until his junior year of high school. During Cho's last two years at Virginia Tech, several instances of his abnormal behavior, as well as plays and other writings he submitted containing references to violence, caused concern among teachers and classmates. In the aftermath of the Virginia Tech massacre, Virginia Governor Tim Kaine convened a panel consisting of various officials and experts to investigate and examine the response and handling of issues related to the shootings. The panel released its final report in August 2007, devoting more than 30 pages to detailing Cho's troubled history. In the report, the panel criticized the failure of the educators and mental health professionals who came into contact with Cho during his college years to notice his deteriorating condition and help him. Like the perpetrators of both the Columbine and Jokela school massacres, Cho was prescribed the anti-depressant drug Paroxetine (Paxil) in 1999, officials said prescription medications related to the treatment of psychological problems had been found among Mr. Cho's effects."prior to his rampage, Paroxetine is a substance suspected by Peter Breggin and David Healy of leading to suicidal behaviors.
- 27. Carrillo, Christopher, 25: Tucson, AZ, 5/13/15 The shooter fatally shot his parents, his brother, and his brother's daughter in the family's home, and then fatally shot himself. Family members said he had a history of mental illness GUN DETAILS: 9mm handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: There is no evidence that the shooter was prohibited from possessing firearms.

- 28. Clark, Dennis III, 27, Santa Monica rampage, Pinewood Village Apartment shooting, Federal Way, Washington; 4/21/2013; shot and killed his girlfriend in their shared apartment, and then shot two witnesses in the building's parking lot and a third victim in another apartment, before being killed by police....history of domestic violence, and yet issued a Concealed Carry License
- 29. Clemmons, Maurice, 37: : Nov. 29, 2009: Parkland, WA shot and killed 4 police officers at a restaurant, sentenced to 95 years in prison in Arkansas for robberies, burglaries, thefts, and taking a gun to school, among other crimes (child rape). In 2000, after Clemmons had served 11 years, then-Gov. Mike Huckabee commuted his sentence on the recommendation of the parole board, which had determined he had met all the conditions for early release, self-medicating with Marijuana. Noted "Mental Illness Does Cause Violence". 5 Dead (including perp), 0 Wounded.
- 30. **Conant, Everett 35**: Wheatland, Wyoming in 2011, http://www.wyomingnews.com/articles/2011/07/09/news/01top_07-09-11.txt). ! WY: Wheatland father Everett Conant III, mentally ill at the time of the shootings, shot-gun murders of three children, and brother. Two the children competed in the Special Olympics. Conant is also charged with shooting his wife. His wife later reported he had become upset because he wanted to keep the curtains of their home drawn to prevent the neighbors from looking inside. Conant and his wife had recently discussed divorce. He just shot them.
- 31. Conway, Samuel, (23); Stringer, Marvin Lamar (22); and Pickney, Jeremy (23), all Black: killed five people in Arkansas in 2009, Conway helped search the residence for money and drugs...These were later identified as 56-year-old Edward Gentry Jr., his 52-year-old wife Pam, their 24-year-old son Jeremy, and Jeremy's 19-year-old girlfriend Kristyn Warneke (all white). They had all been shot to death. ... the body of 80-year-old Edward Gentry Sr. was ... shot to death execution style ... burglarized: flat-screen televisions, guns, and two sets of rims and tires had been stolen. Police records state, the killers "stayed awhile" after they killed the victims which indicates in other similar robbery-murders that they tortured and raped their victims before killing them.[1] (http://www.arkansasonline.com/news/2009/nov/20/authorities-shoot-kill-suspect-5- pearcy-deaths/). !
- 32. Coon, Asa, 14: from Cleveland, age 14, SuccessTech Academy (Gun Free Zone) shot and wounded four before taking his own life. Court records show Coon was on Trazodone.
- 33. Cooper, Shawn, 15: April 16, 1999: Notus, ID: Antidepressant and Ritalin. Shawn Cooper of Notus, Idaho took a 12-gauge shot gun to school (Gun Free Zone) and started firing, injuring one student and holding the school hostage for about 20 minutes. 0 Dead, 1 Wounded.

- 34. Dann, Laurie (1988) In 1988, 31-year-old Laurie Dann went on a shooting rampage in a second-grade classroom (Gun Free Zone) in Winnetka, IL, killing one child and wounding six. She had been taking the anti-depressant Anafranil as well as Lithium, long used to treat mania.
- 35. Dantzler, Roderick, 34: July 7, 2011: Grand Rapids, MI (Black x-convict) Reported to have stopped medication for "Bipolar" before the shooting. 8 Dead (2 x-white girlfriends, their 3 children, and their mother and father (and self), 2 Wounded
- 36. **Dekraai, Scott Evans, 41**; (2012) Eight people died in a shooting **at Salon Meritage hair salon in Seal Beach, Calif**. The gunman, **41-year-old** Scott Evans Dekraai, killed six women and two men dead, while just one woman survived. It was Orange County's deadliest mass killing. At Dekraai's Oct. 14 arraignment hearing, which at the request of defense attorney Robert Curtis was continued to Nov. 29 so he would have more time to prepare, the lawyer asked Judge Erick L. Larsh to order jail officials to give his client a prescribed **anti-psychotic medicine** and access to a **"spinal cord stimulator**" he has needed since his 2007 boat accident. Larsh instead ordered a medical evaluation of Dekraai to see what medicine he might need, **leaving it up to the Orange County Sheriff's Department jailers** to decide what was appropriate.
- 37. Diaddinne, Driss: 50 Phoenix, AZ, 5/13/15 The shooter fatally shot his mother (76-year-old Kenza Benzakour), two brothers, (38-year-old Reda Diaeddinn and 56-year-old Dodi Fayed); and a sister-in-law (26-year-old Meriem Ben Yahia) in the home they all shared, and then fatally shot himself. The family had origins in Morocco. The suspect and two other brothers were reportedly in an on-going feud about a transportation and restaurant business the family owned; and police said it appears the suspect snapped... GUN DETAILS: Semiautomatic handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: There is no evidence that the shooter was prohibited from possessing firearms.
- 38. Draper, Brian Lee; 15 years old (born in 1990) and Torey Michael Adamcik, 15 years old (born June 14, 1990)^[1] are former American high school students (Gun Free Zone) who are currently serving life sentences without the possibility for parole, for murdering their classmate Cassie Jo Stoddart on September 22, 2006. [2]—in Pocatello, ID (Zoloft) in 1998 had a Zoloft-induced seizure that caused an armed stand off at his school.

- 39. Dufrene, Kesler, 23: In 2012, Haitian immigrant, murdered as many people in Miami as Robert Dear did in Colorado Springs. One of Dufrene's victims was a 15-year-old girl. Dufrene had already been Twice convicted convicted of felonies in the United States, so he should have been deported, but our "Deporter in Chief" Obama had blocked his return to Haiti. As the murdered girl's mother said, "Because of immigration, my daughter is not alive." Have you ever heard of Dufrene? I don't think his murders got as much press as the "Planned Parenthood" shooting.
- 40. England, Jacob Carl, 21; and Alvin Lee Watts, 34: Apr. 6, 2012: Tulsa, OK Hate crimes <u>targeting black victims</u>, and Taking medication for depression. 3 Dead, 2 Wounded
- 41. Watts, Alvin Lee 34 (see England, Jacob Carl, 21; and Alvin Lee Watts, 34: Apr. 6, 2012: Tulsa, OK Hate crimes targeting black victims, and Taking medication for depression. 3 Dead, 2 Wounded
- 42. Engeldinger, Andrew, 36: (2012) Five were shot to death by 36-year-old Andrew Engeldinger at Accent Signage Systems in Minneapolis, Minn. Three others were wounded. Engeldinger went on a rampage after losing his job, ultimately killing himself. A police search of the home of Accent Signage Systems shooter Andrew Engeldinger found medications commonly prescribed for depression and insomnia, according to a Minneapolis Police Department report. Police found prescription bottles for two anti-depressant medications. Mirtazapine and Trazodone, and for Temazepam, a medication used to treat insomnia, in Engeldinger's home. They also found many empty prescription bottles, including 18 empty prescription bottles for a generic form of the anti-depressant drug Wellbutrin. According to the police report, all of the prescriptions bottles bore Engeldinger's name.
- 43. Farook, Syed Rizwan (28) and his wife, Tashfeen Malik (27): 12/3/2015; Muslim Jihadists, San Bernardino Mass Shooting San Bernardino, Ca, left a Christmas party held at Inland Regional Center (Gun Free Zone), later returning heavily armed and the two opened fire, killing 14 and wounding 21, ten critically. The two were later killed by police as they fled in an SUV.
- 44. Floyd, Zane, 24: June 3, 1999: Las Vegas, NV supermarket, born September 20, 1975, --- Treated for ADHD and Depression with antidepressants at age 13 (in 1989). 4 Dead, 1 Wounded.
- 45. Flores, Robert S., 41: Oct. 24, 2002: Tucson, AZ In a letter he wrote prior to the shooting and suicide, he said, "I realize that I am depressed but even with treatment it will not change my future.... It's not about anger because I don't feel anything

- right now." A professor **at the university (Gun Free Zone**) where the shooting occurred said that it was "common knowledge among the faculty that Flores was depressed." 4 Dead (including perp), 0 Wounded.
- 46. **Franklin**, **Jeffrey**, **17**; is serving three life sentences for killing his parents with an axe and a sledge hammer, and slashing one sibling and almost murdering another in 1998.in Huntsville, Alabama. Taking Prozac and massive amounts of Ritalin, he went psychotic...
- 47. Fryberg, Jaylen: 15, Marysville-Pilchuck High School shooting, Marysville, WA, 10/24/2014 using a .40-caliber Berretta, shot five students at Marysville High School, including two of his cousins and three friends, killing all but one. Fryberg arranged to meet them for lunch in the school cafeteria by text. Fryberg was reportedly well-liked at the school and there was not believed to be any ill-will between him and his victims. He committed suicide at the scene. At the age of 15, the shooter was unlawfully in possession of a handgun. The gun belonged to the shooter's father, who was himself under a permanent restraining order that prohibited him from possessing firearms under federal law. But the order had been issued in a Tribal Court and was not entered into the federal criminal background check database, so the man was able to pass a background check at a licensed gun dealer and acquire the gun.
- 48. **Furrow, Neal, 38:** August 10, 1999: (Prozac) in LA, <u>A White Supremist, and Jewish community center</u> (**Gun Free Zone**) shooting, and killing Pilipino-born postal delivery person, had been treated for mental illness and reported to have been court-ordered to be on Prozac along with several other medications.
- 49. Gale, Nathan, 25: Dec. 8, 2004: Columbus, OH Diagnosed with paranoid schizophrenia a year before the shooting. His mother said that "he came home with his medications" but didn't "know if he took them or not." 5 Dead (including perp), 2 Wounded.
- 50. Gilmer, Tkeisha, 18; and Bellard, Darrell, 43; ...a drug relationship that went very bad (dealing and stealing drugs), killed four people (including children aged 4 and 3) in Lanham, Maryland in 2010. Gilmer was bipolar and schizophrenic and had other mental health issues. (http://www.cnn.com/2010/US/08/07/maryland.arrests/index.html). !

- 51. **Goh, One L, 43**: .. Apr. 2, 2012: **Oikos University shooting,** a <u>Korean Christian</u> college; expelled from college and denied refund; Oakland, CA 7 Dead, 3 Wounded.
- 52. Golden, Andrew, aged 11, March 24, 1998, , (Ritalin) and Mitchell Johnson, aged 14, (Ritalin) shot 15 people killing four students, one teacher, and wounding 10 others Mitchell Scott Johnson (born August 11, 1984) and Andrew Douglas Golden (born May 25, 1986) were middle school students, when they committed a massacre at Westside Middle School (Gun Free Zone) inunincorporated Craighead County, Arkansas, United States, near Jonesboro, nine weapons (Remington 742 .30-06 rifle, Universal .30 M1 carbine replica, Smith & Wesson .38 revolver, Double Deuce Buddie .22 two-shot derringer, FIE .380 pistol, Star .380 pistol, Ruger Security Six .357 revolver, Davis Industries .38 two-shot derringer, and a Charter Arms .38 revolver)[4]—which had been stolen from Golden's grandfather's house—and 2,000 rounds of ammunition.
- 53. Goodwin-Bey, Scott, 47: Springfield, MO, 11/15/14 The shooter killed four people in a motel room whom he thought were acting as informants to the police. GUN DETAILS: Ruger 9mm GUN ACQUIRED: The gun had previously reported stolen, though it not clear how the shooter acquired the gun. PROHIBITING CRITERIA: The shooter was prohibited from possessing firearms due to multiple felony convictions. In 1992, he was convicted of three felonies: possession of a controlled substance, unlawful possession of a firearm, unlawful use of a weapon, and resisting/interfering with arrest for a felony.
- 54. **Griego**, **Nehemiah**, **15**: Jan. 19, 2013: murdered his father, mother, brother, and 2 sisters; he had been having suicidal and homicidal thoughts; has a working diagnosis with psychosis and dissociative disorders and has started medication. We know that DNA and genetic codes are damaged by **drugs** and chemicals... Albuquerque, NM 5 Dead, 0 Wounded.
- 55. **Guadalupe**, **Ronquillo-Ovalle**, 33: killed four people in Rice, Texas in 2013, Rice, TX, 9/23/13 The shooter killed her husband and three children aged 4, 8, and 10 before committing suicide. In the previous month, the shooter's husband had pled no contest to a charge of assault against her, but was released after two days in custody. .22-caliber semi-automatic rifle PROHIBITING CRITERIA: There is no evidence that the shooter was prohibited from having a gun. (http://www.nydailynews.com/news/crime/mother-gunned-husband-sons-texasauthorities-article-1.1466168).
- 56. **Guzzo**, **Michael**, 56: who killed four people in Phoenix, Arizona, over barking dogs. 10/26/13 The shooter entered his neighbors' home and killed all four family members and their two dogs. The shooter then tried to enter another nearby residence, firing

twice into the door, but ultimately failed and returned home to commit suicide. According to news reports, the shooter disliked the "constant barking" of his neighbor's dogs. GUN DETAILS: Pump-action shotgun • PROHIBITING CRITERIA: There is no evidence that the shooter was prohibited from having a gun. (http://www.foxnews.com/us/2013/10/28/phoenix-family-killings-may-have-beenspurred-by-barking-dogs-cops-say/).

- 57. Harris, Eric David (18); and Dylan Bennet Klebold (17): 1999 Columbine massacre; killing 13 people and wounding more than 20 others before turning their guns on themselves and committing suicide. The two boys got into trouble with the law for breaking into a locked van and stealing computers. In January 1998, they were charged with mischief, breaking and entering, trespassing, and theft. "Considerable media attention focused upon Cassie Bernall, who had been killed by Harris in the library and who Harris was reported to have asked, "Do you believe in God?" immediately prior to her murder. Bernall was reported to have responded "Yes" before being killed. Emily Wyant, the closest living witness to Bernall's death, denied that Bernall had this discussion.
- 58. Harrison, James, age 35: killed his five children and wife, and then himself in Graham, Washington in 2009, was born in 1974. He had a history of abuse, and when his wife threatened to leave him, he killed the children to prevent them from being raised by anybody else... The wife reported that she and the children had sustained years of abuse...(http://www.mahalo.com/pierce-county-murders/).
- 59. Hasan, Nidal Malik, 39: Nov. 5, 2009: Killeen, TX Military Psychiatrist, suffered harassment from fellow soldiers who questioned his loyalty to the US and commented on his Middle East ethnicity. As a Muslim, he was upset at the killing of Muslims in Iraq and Afghanistan by his fellow US soldiers, and was shouting Allah Akbar as he killed them,. 13 soldiers and dependents Dead, 32 Wounded on military installation (Gun Free Zone).
- 60. Haskell, Ronald Lee 33: Spring, TX, 7/9/14 The shooter killed his the sister of his ex-wife, her husband, and four of their children, injuring a fifth, before he was captured by police. GUN DETAILS: Handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: The shooter was likely prohibited from owning firearm due to a mutual restraining order enacted as part of his divorce proceedings in October 2013. He had also been charged with simple assault and domestic violence in the presence of a child in June 2008 but the charges were dismissed.
- 61. Haughton, Radcliffe, 45: years of domestic abuse of his wife, bought a 40-caliber semiautomatic handgun (no background check between individuals in Wisconsin); under 4 year a restraining order; charges for domestic violence were dropped when

the officer failed to show, and the DA refused to re-schedule the case – resulting in 4 dead and 4 wounded; Oct. 21, 2012: Brookfield, WI — 4 Dead (including perp), 4 Wounded.

- 62. **Hawkins, Robert, 19**; **(2007)** Robert Hawkins also had problems controlling his temper, as outcast-types with no anchor tying them to the rest of society sometimes do. Robert Hawkins had a prescription for and was **taking anti-depressants**. Maribel Rodriguez said her son's life had been a challenge from the start. She divorced Hawkins' father when the boy was 3-years-old, she said, and by 5 he was taking prescription Ritalin and Zoloft Valium was in his system at time of shooting. He became a ward of the state in 2002 after apparently threatening his stepmother. He was moved through facilities and foster homes for several years, until he was released in 2005. Two weeks before the shooting rampage at a mall, Hawkins parted ways with his girlfriend. Hawkins killed eight people before turning a gun on himself and committing suicide.
- 63. **Helms, Christian, 14:** Sept. 21, 2011: Myrtle Beach, SC –, shot school resource officer (Gun Free Zone) and had pipe bombs with him Drugs for ADD and depression. 0 Dead, 1 Wounded
- **64.** Henderson, James Sparks- **19:** Cleveland, OH, 11/21/14 The shooter fatally shot his close friend, a woman who was seven months pregnant, and two other victims inside a residence. He also shot and injured a nine-year old girl. GUN DETAILS: 9mm pistol GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: The shooter was prohibited from possessing firearms due to a 2010 felony conviction for aggravated robbery, too young to possess a handgun.
- 65. **Higdon, Wesley Neal. 25**: June 25, 2008: Henderson, KY, at an Atlantis Plastics factory (**Gun Free Zone**) 6 Dead (including perp), 0 Wounded. Signs and symptoms of alcohol and **drug** misuse.
- 66. **Hinckley, John**; (1981) John Hinckley, age 25, took four Valium two hours before shooting and almost killing President Ronald Reagan in 1981. In the assassination attempt, Hinckley also wounded press secretary James Brady, Secret Service agent Timothy McCarthy and policeman Thomas Delahany.
- 67. **Hoffman, Jason, 18**; Mar. 22, 2001; admitted to **shooting** five people at an **El Cajon high school (Gun Free Zone)**, committed suicide in prison.. had been seeing a psychiatrist and on Effexor and Celexa (SSRI) –in El Cajon, California

- 68. **Holder, Mary Ann**,36: killed five people (2 sons, one son's girlfriend, x-lover, and his girlfriend) in Greensboro, North Carolina in 2011. (http://www.wbtv.com/story/16101818/st and http://murderpedia.org/female.H/h/holder-mary-ann.htm).
- 69. Holly Hill, SC, 7/15/15 An unknown assailant entered a residence and fatally shot two teenage girls, an adult male, and an adult female and injured a child. SHOOTER NAME: Unknown GUN DETAILS: Unknown GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: Unknown
- 70. Holmes, James Eagan; (born December 13, 1987 age 24) is an American convicted on 24 counts of murder and 140 counts of attempted murder for the 2012 Aurora theater shooting that killed 12 people and injured 70 others at a Century movie theater in Aurora, Colorado, on July 20, 2012. He had no known criminal record prior to the shooting. ... He began to suffer from mental health issues in middle school and attempted suicide at age 11. ... search warrant on Holmes' apartment, police, "found prescription medication for sertraline, a generic version of Zoloft used to treat depression, panic disorder and obsessive-compulsive disorder; and Clonazepam, usually prescribed to treat anxiety and panic attacks, and was heavily hooked on the prescription painkiller Vicodin" Holmes booby-trapped his apartment with explosives before the shooting, killed 12 people and injuring 59 others in Aurora Colorado
- 71. Houser, John Russell, 59: in July, 2015, string of arrests and a record of "extreme erratic behavior; theater in Lafayette, LA." killing two people and injuring nine others before committing suicide. ...a history of mental problems (manic depressant and bipolar)" and was being "prescribed medication (anti-depressants) to take daily.
- 72. **Huff, Kyle Aaron,** 28: Mar. 25, 2006: Seattle, WA —year-old 7 Dead (including perp), 2 Wounded. The weapons used were purchased legally at sporting goods stores in <u>Kalispell, Montana. [19]</u> They were seized by the police in Whitefish after he <u>pleaded</u> guilty to a reduced <u>misdemeanor mischief charge</u> (*He shot up a statue of a moose that was part of an installation called "Moose on the Loose.*). They were returned after he paid restitution and a fine. The <u>original felony charge</u> for destroying the art would have prohibited him from legally owning firearms. He had little contact with police in Seattle, but <u>was involved in a brawl at the Lobo Saloon in 2004.[18]</u>
- 73. Hunt, Jody Lee, 39 Morgantown, WV, 12/1/14 The shooter fatally shot four people at three different locations: a business rival at his towing company, his ex-girlfriend and her new boyfriend in their shared home, and his cousin at his home. The shooter then killed himself in his vehicle. GUN DETAILS: 9mm handgun GUN ACQUIRED: ATF traced the shooter's gun to a Monongalia County

resident, who sold Hunt the 9mm handgun in an unlicensed transfer one year prior to the shooting. He was able to purchase the handgun in a private sale after responding to an ad for the gun posted on Facebook. Authorities do not believe that Hunt and the seller previously knew each other, and the seller was not charged with a crime. • PROHIBITING CRITERIA: The shooter was prohibited from possessing firearms due to multiple felony convictions. In 1999 in Virginia, he was convicted of abduction and using a firearm in the commission of a felony for kidnapping a former girlfriend and holding her hostage at gunpoint. Stone was found to have be overdosing on a combination of drugs used to treat post-traumatic stress disorder and a recreational drug similar to ecstasy.

- 74. Johnson, Mitchell Scott, aged 14: (Ritalin) and Andrew Golden, aged 11, (Ritalin), March 24, 1998: shot 15 people killing four students, one teacher, and wounding 10 others Mitchell Scott Johnson (born August 11, 1984) and Andrew Douglas Golden (born May 25, 1986) were middle school students, when they committed a massacre at Westside Middle School (Gun Free Zone) inunincorporated Craighead County, Arkansas, United States, near Jonesboro, nine weapons (Remington 742 .30-06 rifle, Universal .30 M1 carbine replica, Smith & Wesson .38 revolver, Double Deuce Buddie .22 two-shot derringer, FIE .380 pistol, Star .380 pistol, Ruger Security Six .357 revolver, Davis Industries .38 two-shot derringer, and a Charter Arms .38 revolver)[4]—which had been stolen from Golden's grandfather's house—and 2,000 rounds of ammunition.
- 75. Kazmierczak, Steven; (2008), 27, opened fire in a lecture hall at Northern Illinois University (Gun Free Zone), killing six and wounding 21. The gunman shot and killed himself before police arrived. Jessica Baty said that her boyfriend of two years had been taking Xanax, used to treat anxiety and Ambien, a sleep agent, as well as the anti-depressant Prozac. Baty said the psychiatrist prescribed the medications, a fact that made her so "nervous" that she tried to persuade Kazmierczak to stop taking one of the drugs. She said he had stopped taking the anti-depressant (Prozac) three weeks before the Valentine's Day rampage on the NIU campus in DeKalb, Illinois, which left five students dead and 16 wounded. He then killed himself. Kazmierczak told her he had stopped taking the anti-depressant "because it made him feel like a zombie," she said during the interview Sunday at her parents' house in Wonder Lake, II. "He wasn't acting erratic. He was just a little quicker to get annoyed." Kazmierczak had a history of mental illness and revered figures like Adolf Hitler and Ted Bundy. Steven Kazmierczak even wore a tattoo depicting Jigsaw, the Saw films' sadistic narrator, and had a history of attempted suicide. NIU police say they never got wind of such warnings. "How could it be a red flag if it never came to us?" said the university's police chief. But David Vann, who culled the information on Kazmierczak for a book about the shootings said the writing was on the wall. Kazmierczak had been hospitalized several times for mental illness and was known as "Strange Steve" by roommates. "What does a mass murderer have to do to get noticed?" asked Vann.
- 76. Kinkel. Kip; (1998) Kip Kinkel, 15, had been suspended from school for possession of a loaded .357 in his locker in school the day before the shootings! He then murdered his parents in 1998 and the next day went to his school, Thurston High in Springfield, Ore (Gun Free Zone)., and opened fire on his classmates, , Kinkel paid \$110 for the

Beretta Model 90 .32-caliber pistol loaded with a 9-round magazine, Kinkel retrieved his .22 rifle from his bedroom and ammunition from his parents' bedroom. killing two and wounding 22 others. He had been prescribed both Prozac and Ritalin.

- 77. **Klebold, Dylan Bennet (17): (and Harris listed above)**Survivor Valeen Schnurr claims that she was the one questioned by Harris. Joshua Lapp thought Bernall had been queried about her (religious) belief,... "-killer Eric Harris was taking Luvox. Like Prozac, Paxil, Zoloft, Effexor and many others, a modern and widely prescribed type of anti-depressant drug called Selective Serotonin Reuptake Inhibitors, or SSRIs. Harris and fellow student **Dylan Klebold** went on a hellish **school shooting rampage (Gun Free Zone**) in 1999, during which they killed 12 students and a teacher and wounded 24 others before turning their guns on themselves. Luvox manufacturer Solvav Pharmaceuticals concedes that during short-term controlled clinical trials, **4 percent of children and youth taking Luvox** that's one in 25 **developed mania**, a dangerous and violence-prone mental derangement characterized by extreme excitement and delusion.
- 78. Kwan Fai "Willie", Mak Wai-Chiu "Tony" Ng, and Benjamin Ng (Chineese gang) gunned down fourteen people in the Wah Mee gambling club in Seattle.
- 79. Laffer, David, 33 who killed four people in Medford, New York in 2011, Police said Laffer, who is also thought to have a painkiller addiction, was 'extremely violent' and appeared to be high on drugs when he was arrested, while Brady allegedly tried to stop him being taken into custody. The couple got about one-third of that total -- 4,251 pills -- in the first six months of this year. (http://www.huffingtonpost.com/2011/11/10/david-laffer-sentencedto_n_1086514.html).
- 80. Lane, Thomas "TJ" (2012), 15: Three students were killed by Thomas "TJ" Lane, another student, in a rampage at Chardon High School in Chardon (Gun Free Zone), Ohio. Three others were injured. In hindsight, it is also easy to see how violence was part of his family. During his infancy, his parents Thomas Lane Jr. and Sara Nolan were reportedly each charged with domestic abuse against each other. Later arrest charges for Thomas Lane Jr. include assaulting a police officer, domestic abuse against another woman who fathered his children and attempted murder. The attempted-murder charge was dropped, but in 2002-03 he served eight months of a four-year sentence for strangling a woman until she lost consciousness, holding her face under running water and bashing her head against a wall. By the time TJ Lane was in elementary school, he was living with his maternal grandparents, Jack and Carol Nolan, who had also taken in his older brother Adam Nolan and a sister. But violence followed him there too. Records indicate that police arrested Adam, 19, multiple times for disorderly conduct, theft and other crimes related to his abuse of prescription drugs and heroin, including several overdoses. (Adam apparently was released into the custody of his grandparents who reportedly said they would try to get him treatment.) On Dec. 9, 2009, during his parents' divorce proceedings, Lane and Nolan, then 15 and 16, were arrested for assault, after getting into a fight with an uncle who had gone to the house.

- 81. Lanza, Adam Peter; age 20, Killed 26 and wounded 2 in Newtown Ct, The Sandy Hook Elementary School shooting occurred on December 14, 2012, [5] Prior to driving to the school, Lanza shot and killed his mother at their Newtown home, then stole her guns (Rifle, shotgun, and handguns) from the safe...[6][1][1][2] As first responders arrived at the scene, Lanza committed suicide by shooting himself in the head. ... Lanza's obsessive compulsive disorder... antidepressant Celexa... was prescribed Fanapt, a controversial anti-psychotic medicine. Nancy Lanza appeared not to follow the advice of her son's physicians, taking her son off his medication and failing to reschedule missed appointments.... "displayed a profound autism spectrum disorder with rigidity, isolation and a lack of comprehension of ordinary social interaction and communications." (Fanapt was dropped by its first producer, picked up by another, initially rejected by the FDA, then later picked up and mass produced...)
- 82. Lee, Thomas Jesse, 26: La Grange, GA, 1/31/15 The shooter killed his wife, mother-in-law, father-in-law, and a teenage family friend in the home he shared with his wife's family. The shooter also strangled and killed his stepdaughter. GUN DETAILS: Unknown GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: There is no evidence that the shooter was prohibited from possessing firearms.
- 83. Leirmoe, Gaylin, 26: killed four people in Ammon, Idaho in 2011, History of Domestic Violence and Abuse (prior DV battery charges; no legal access to/use of weapon; attempt to burn house) Recent Separation, Divorce, or Custody Battle (several months of separation prior to incident; no contact order) Mental Health Issue: Threats of Suicide or Suicidal Behaviors (committed suicide upon shooting victims) (http://idahostatejournal.com/news/local/article_ec3d6922-7d7c-11e0-85bc-001cc4c03286.html). !
- 84. **Leyva, Silvio** 36: Dec. 30, 1999: Tampa, FL 5 Dead, 3 Wounded. TAMPA, Fla. When Silvio Izquierdo-Leyva returned from a visit last month to **his native Cuba**, he was a changed man. He had always been drawn to **Santeria**, a religion rooted in Africa with gods, spirits and sacrifices. But now, Izquierdo had embarked on a year's worth of studies to become a **Santero**, a priest of the faith. When Izquierdo was handcuffed Thursday, he was carrying two firearms. One was a 9mm pistol he bought from the Floriland Mall flea market on Jan. 2, said police Chief Bennie Holder. The other, a .38-caliber revolver, was **purchased from Nationwide Sports by an unknown person (unlawful straw-purchase)**, he said... was arrested in Alabama just two years ago in the vicious stabbing of an acquaintance (x-convict not Allowed to purchase or possess a firearm),
- 85. Lopez, Ivan, 34: April 2, 2014, Fort Hood shooter (Gun Free Zone), four dead and 16 wounded, was being treated for mental health issues, Lopez had been prescribed anti-depressants and the sleep aid medication Ambien.

- 86. Loughner, Jared Lee; Jan. 8, 2011: Tucson, AZ supermarket parking lot— 6 Dead, 13 Wounded, born September 10, 1988 ((23 years old))) pleaded guilty to 19 charges of murder and attempted murder in connection with the <u>January 8, 2011 Tucson shooting</u>, in which he shot and severely injured <u>U.S. Representative Gabrielle Giffords</u>, his target, and killed 6 other people, including Chief <u>U.S. District Court Judge John Roll</u>, a federal judge found that months of forcibly medicating him to treat his <u>schizophrenia</u> prior to the shooting, a period when he was also abusing alcohol and <u>drugs *Methamphetamines</u>, <u>marijuana and trying cocaine</u>..
- 87. **Macinnis, Neil Allan** In 2013, 18-year-old student shot dead two women at a **Virginia college (Gun Free Zone)**; shotgun with buckshot and slugs
- 88. Malik, Tashfeen (27) (see Farook, Syed Rizwan) Muslim Jihadists, San Bernardino Mass Shooting San Bernardino, Ca left a Christmas party held at Inland Regional Center (Gun Free Zone), later returning heavily armed and the two opened fire, killing 14 and wounding 21, ten critically. The two were later killed by police as they fled in an SUV.
- 89. Malvo, Lee Boyd 17 (Malvo was an undocumented immigrant who at no point became a legal resident of the United States.); and Muhammad, John Allen 42; October of 2002, neither Muhammad nor Malvo was legally allowed to purchase or possess guns, with both classified as prohibited persons under the Gun Control Act of 1968, Muhammad, 42-year old convicted murderer and Nation of Islam member and his planned to kill six white people per day "to terrorize the nation", including plans to bomb school buses and children's hospitals: "He wanted to kill a policeman, then set off a bomb at his funeral." Over the course of three weeks, 10 people were killed and 3 more were critically injured.
- 90. McDermott, Michael, 42: (2000); The hulking computer technician accused of gunning down seven of his co-workers at a Wakefield high tech firm (Gun Free Zone) this week suffered from a host of mental illnesses including schizophrenia for which he was taking a trio of anti-depressants Paxil, Prozac & Desyrel (Trazodone) "drugs that helped him go to sleep.", a source told the Herald yesterday. "He's got some serious psychological issues and a long (psychiatric) history," the source said of 42-year-old Michael "Mucko" McDermott. McDermott, a divorced Navy veteran from Marshfield who lived most recently in Haverhill, suffered from severe depression, paranoia and schizophrenia, and had been in psychiatric treatment for some time, according to the source who spoke on condition of anonymity. To cope with his mental disorders, McDermott was prescribed several Selective Serotonin Reuptake Inhibitors, or SSRIs are designed to increase brain serotonin. Low levels of brain serotonin can lead to depression and anxiety disorders.

- 91. **McLendon, Michael,** 28: Mar. 10, 2009: Alabama Geneva County massacre, which occurred on March 10, 2009, spanned at least two communities, Geneva and Samson in Geneva County, Alabama, and resulted in the death of 11 people, 6 Wounded (**relatives and neighbors**). In the days leading up to the massacre, he told a friend that he was depressed due to a lack of work.
- 92. **Medina, Sonny 36:** Fort Myers, FL, 6/8/14 After a party, the shooter **killed his girlfriend and his three children**, ages 2 through 10, before taking his own life. GUN DETAILS: Handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: There is no evidence that the shooter was prohibited from having a gun. In 2002, he had been charged with simple assault but was found not guilty.
- 93. Memon, Hammad, 14: Feb. 5, 2010: Huntsville, AL, at Discovery Middle School (Gun Free Zone). —But a number of people have said the shooter, Hammad Memon, was Muslim Badsha Mahommed Gool and the local Muslim imam, Mullah History of being treated for ADHD and depression. On antidepressant Zoloft and "other drugs for the conditions." shooting death of 14-year-old classmate Todd Brown 1 Dead, 0 Wounded.
- 94. Mercer, Chris Harper, 26: 10/1/2015 Umpqua Community College (Gun Free Zone) shooting Roseburg, OR; ...previously attended a school for mentally unstable children (could not legally possess a firearm); He posted on social media that he was taking five medications (for ADHT and Autism). he used: 9mm Glock handgun, a .40 S&W Smith & Wesson handgun, three other handguns, and a Del-Ton 5.56×45mm rifle. Six guns were found at the scene of the crime; seven more were found in his home., 26-year-old Mercer opened fire with at Umpqua Community College in southwest Oregon. He was also a fan of the Islamic State (ISIS). He asked each student what was their religion, and if they answered Christian, he shot them in the head. The gunman shot himself to death after being wounded
- 95. Miles, Shannon, 30, African American, killed deputy Darren Goforth, 47, white, walking up behind him and shooting him in the back and several times after he was on the ground; August 28, 2015. His arrest history includes: twice for using force against a police officer; giving false information to a police officer; resisting arrest, criminal mischief greater than \$1,500, discharging or displaying a firearm, criminal trespassing, and evading arrest. His arrests showed a long history of violent acts toward police officers.
- 96. Mixon, Lovell, 27: black parolee from Oakland, who killed four white policemen, Mixon first landed in prison in 2002 for charges of assault with a deadly weapon. He got out in late 2007, but within a few months, he was picked up again for possession of a stolen laptop, a drug scale; and took part in a home invasion robbery in Modesto, CA, on February 21 2009 in which a

rifle was reported stolen.. he was also accused of committing two rapes before the shooting spree. in East Oakland, California in 2009, was born in 1982, during high publicity of the Travon Martin incident... (http://murderpedia.org/male.M/m/mixonlovelle.htm). !

- 97. Morrison, Duane, 53: Sept. 27, 2006: Platte Canyon High School (Gun Free Zone) in Bailey, ColoradoBailey, CO—
 Antidepressants found among his effects. 6 female hostages and sexually assaulted them, Morrison had been imprisoned in 1973 for larceny and possession of marijuana, and was arrested on a separate occasion for obstructing police in Littleton, Colorado., 2 Dead (including perp), 0 Wounded.
- 98. Moser, Brittany Lina Yvonn, 25 and Bennett, Jacob Allen, 26: Crab Orchard, TN, 9/11/13 The shooters killed a woman and three teenagers, apparently during an attempted robbery during a marijuana exchange. The victims' bodies were discovered in a car parked along the side of the road in the Renegade Mountain resort community near Crossville. GUN DETAILS: Handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: Bennett was prohibited from possessing firearms. In 2010 he received a 6-year prison sentence for charges of theft, forgery, and possession of a handgun during a felony, but was paroled on March 4, 2013. The Cumberland County sheriff's office estimated they had previously arrested Bennett five times.
- 99. Muhammad, John Allen 42; and 17—year—old partner Lee Boyd Malvo: October of 2002, Muhammad, 42—year old convicted murderer and Nation of Islam member and his plan to kill six white people per day "to terrorize the nation", including plans to bomb school buses and children's hospitals: "He wanted to kill a policeman, then set off a bomb at his funeral." Over the course of three weeks, 10 people were killed and 3 more were critically injured. neither Muhammad nor Malvo was legally allowed to purchase or possess guns, with both classified as prohibited persons under the Gun Control Act of 1968,
- 100. **Myers, Kurt,** 64: Mar. 13, 2013: Herkimer County, NY, went on a rampage at a car wash and a barbershop— 5 Dead (including perp), 2 Wounded.
- 101. **Myron May, 31:** November 20, 2014; Tallahassee, Florida, a **Florida State University alum (Gun Free Zone)**, opened fire in the school's library, wounding three before he was shot and killed by police. ABC Action News found a half-filled prescription for the antianxiety drug Hydroxyzine in his apartment after the shooting. In addition, according to May's friends, he had seen a psychologist and had been prescribed the antidepressant Wellbutrin and the ADHD drug Vyvanse. He also checked himself in to a mental health center called

Mesilla Valley Hospital around September of 2014. Shortly after this, his friends discovered the antipsychotic Seroquel among his prescriptions.

- 102. Paek, Jeong Soo 58: Feb. 22, 2012: Norcross, GA; in 2006 had a restraining order for assault on his sister (a criminal record that would have prevented him from owning firearms) 5 Dead (including perp, 2 sisters and their husbands), 0 Wounded.
- 103. Page, Wade Michael, 20: Aug 5, 2012: Sikh temple (Gun Free Zone),, a fanatical white supremacist who was filled with rage and hatred for people of different races and religions. Oak Creek, WI 7 Dead (including perp), 4 Wounded.
- 104. Pasasouk, Ka, 34: murdered four people in Northridge, California, December 2, 2012: "In March 2011, while in prison for the methamphetamine conviction. Pasasouk underwent a psychiatric evaluation because of concerns regarding his behavior." The motive for killing Calabia, Ghossein and Kim, the prosecutor said, was to eliminate witnesses to Navales' murder.
- 105. Pickney, Jeremy (23), Stringer, Marvin Lamar (22); Conway, Samuel, (23); and all Black: killed five people in Arkansas in 2009, These were later identified as 56-year-old Edward Gentry Jr., his 52-year-old wife Pam, their 24-year-old son Jeremy, and Jeremy's 19-year-old girlfriend Kristyn Warneke (all white). They had all been shot to death. ... the body of 80-year-old Edward Gentry Sr. was ... shot to death execution style ... burglarized: flat-screen televisions, guns, and two sets of rims and tires had been stolen. Police records state, the killers "stayed awhile" after they killed the victims which indicates in other similar robbery-murders that they tortured and raped their victims before killing them. - 106. **Peterson, Tyler, 20:** Oct. 7, 2007: Crandon, WI off duty deputy sheriff 7 Dead (including perp), 1 Wounded. 18-year-old Jordanne Michele Murray was Peterson's former girlfriend, and it was believed the dispute within the apartment motivated the shooting.

- 107. Prather, Cedric G., 33: Douglasville, GA, 2/7/15 The shooter went to the home where his ex-wife lived and fatally shot her, their nine-year old son, their seven-year old son, and the ex-wife's new boyfriend. He also shot and injured two other children who were visiting the home, and then fatally shot himself. • GUN DETAILS: .45-caliber handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: The shooter was prohibited from possessing firearms due to a 2011 felony conviction for possessing cocaine.
- 108. **Purdy, Patrick (1989)** Patrick Purdy went on a **schoolyard shooting rampage in Stockton, CA (Gun Free Zone)**, in 1989, which became the catalyst for the original legislative frenzy to ban "semiautomatic assault weapons" in California and the nation. The **25-year-old** Purdy, who **murdered five children and wounded 30**, had been on **Amitriptvine**, an anti-depressant, as well as the antipsychotic drug Thorazine.
- 109. Rackemann, Kenneth "Cody, 24 and Valencia Williams, 21: Indianapolis, IN, 2/20/14 During an attempt to rob the home of a drug dealer who had hired them for security, the shooters killed the drug dealer and three others. GUN DETAILS: Two handguns GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: In October 2010 Rackemann had been convicted of felony battery and criminal recklessness, which prohibited him from possessing a gun. Williams did not have a prior criminal record.
- 110. Ratzmann, Terry Michael, 45: (2005) Terry Michael Ratzmann killed seven members of the Living Church of God (LCG) (Gun Free Zone) before committing suicide at a Sheraton Hotel in Brookfield, WI in 2005. On the verge of losing his job as a computer technician with a placement firm, Ratzmann was known to suffer from bouts of depression, and was reportedly infuriated by a sermon the minister had given two weeks earlier. Ratzmann's autopsy revealed that he was suffering from Hashimoto's thyroiditis. Hashimoto's thyroiditis very often results in hypothyroidism with bouts of hyperthyroidism. Symptoms of Hashimoto's thyroiditis include Myxedematous psychosis, weight gain, depression, mania, sensitivity to heat and cold, paresthesia, fatigue, panic attacks, bradycardia, tachycardia, high cholesterol, reactive hypoglycemia, constipation, migraines, muscle weakness, cramps, memory loss, infertility and hair loss.
- 111. Rhoades, Cherie Lash: 44, opened fire at the Cedarville Rancheria Tribal Office and Community Center (Gun Free Zone), killing four and wounding two. After running out of ammunition, Rhoades grabbed a butcher knife and stabbed another person.... always tried to intimidate tribal employees with violence, tribal members with violence," Russo said. Among the victims were the shooter's brother, niece, and nephew. Alturas police are investigating whether the shooter embezzled federal grant money meant for the tribe, which may have spurred the tribe's efforts to evict her.

- 112. **Roberts, Charles Carl, 32:** Oct. 2, 2006: Nickel Mines, PA **Amish school for girls (Gun Free Zone)**, His family reported that he took **Antidepressants**. 6 Dead (including perp), 5 Wounded.
- 113. Roberts, Jacob Tyler; 22: Dec. 11, 2012: Portland, OR in Clackamas Mall 3 Dead (including perp), 1 Wounded. opened fire with an AR15 rifle he had stolen from an acquaintance the day before.
- 114. Rodger, Elliot, 22 years old, on May 23, 2014: near the campus of University of California, Santa Barbara *(Gun Free Zone), stabbed 3, shot and killed 3, and wounded 13, then committed suicide; was taking psychiatric drugs .(including Zanex).. and writes letters, trying to warn the world that SSRI drugs can kill; He.had been seeing therapists on and off since he was 8, family friend Simon Astaire said. When he went to high school in Van Nuys, California, he met with a therapist "pretty much every day,"
- 115. **Romano, Jon W; age 16**, Feb 10, 2004; fired at least two shotgun shells before he was tackled by an assistant principal at **Columbia High School (Gun Free Zone)**, New York, on Xanax . (SSRI), for depression and had previously spent time in a psychiatry care facility.
- 116. **Roof, Dylann Storm:** 21, wearing jacket stitched with the Apartheid-era South African flag; shot and killed 9 people after opening fire at the **Emanuel AME Church (Gun Free Zone)** in Charleston, South Carolina. According to a roommate, he had allegedly been "planning something like that for six months, 6/17/2015." According to a <u>CBS News report</u>, earlier this year when cops searched Roof after he was acting suspiciously inside a Bath and Body Works store, they found "orange strips" that Roof told officers was suboxone, a narcotic that is used to treat opiate addiction. Suboxone is a habit-forming drug that has been connected with sudden outbursts of aggression.
- 117. **Saari, Matti, 22:** September 2008, culinary student, shot and killed 9 students and a teacher, and wounded another student, before killing himself. --- at **Kauhajoki school shooting** occurred on 23 September 2008, at the <u>Seinäjoki University of Applied Sciences</u> in **Western Finland (Gun Free Zone)**. Saari was **taking an SSRI and a benzodiazapine**.
- 118. **San Marco, Jennifer 44:** Jan. 30, 2006: Goleta, CA, Goleta postal facility shootings (Gun Free Zone). Was in psychiatric hospital in 2001. Likely taking SSRIs, former US Postal Service employee, 8 Dead (including perp), 0 Wounded.

- 119. Sencion, Eduardo, 32; (2011) Eduardo Sencion entered an IHOP restaurant in Carson City, Nev., and shot 12 people. Five died, including three National Guard members. According to CBS affiliate KTVN, the shooter's motive was unclear, but family members said he had mental issues. He had never been in the military and had no known affiliation with anyone inside the restaurant. Investigators said his family first became aware of mental health issues when Sencion complained about being harassed by co-workers. He sought treatment when his employer told the family he was becoming increasing paranoid. Family members said Sencion took his medication, and all but one of his mental health commitments were voluntary. The report did not say how many times Sencion was hospitalized. But Sencion told his family he avoided intimate relationships because he feared "he would father a child and pass along his illness." He immersed himself in the Bible, and gave his mother keys to his gun safe, warning her he was "getting sick."He thought people were demons trying to hurt him, and began hearing voices telling him to do "bad things" to people. Sencion's medications were changed this summer. About a month later, he approached a priest in the street and asked him for help, telling the priest, "They're telling me to do bad things." The night before the shootings, Sencion, who lived with family members, took his medication at 10 p.m. Everything appeared normal the next morning. His last comment to his family was. "I should have gone to work today."
- 120. **Shick**, **John**, 31: Mar. 8, 2012: Pittsburgh, PA– psychiatric clinic of the University of Pittsburgh Medical Center **(Gun Free Zone)**. 9 antidepressants were found in his apartment. 2 Dead (including perp), 6 Wounded.
- 121. Smith, Joel 33: Saco, ME, 7/26/15 The shooter fatally shot his wife, their two children ages four and seven, and his 12-year-old stepson at their home before fatally shooting himself. GUN DETAILS: Pump-action 12 gauge shotgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: There is no evidence that the shooter was prohibited from possessing firearms.
- 122. **Solomon, T. J. 15-year-old**,: May 20, 1999: **High school campus**, Conyers, GA **Ritalin and treated for depression**. 0 Dead, 6 Wounded.
- 123. **Speight, Christopher, 42:** Jan. 19, 2010: Appomattox, VA Relatives said he began having "mental problems" after his mom died in 2006. 8 Dead, 0 Wounded, shot in his home
- 124. Spirit, Don Charles, 51: Bell, FL, 9/18/14 The shooter fatally shot his daughter and his six grandchildren, ranging from two months to 11 years of age. When police responded to the crime scene, the shooter fatally shot himself. GUN DETAILS: .45-caliber handgun GUN ACQUIRED: Unknown PROHIBITING CRITERIA: The shooter was prohibited from possessing firearms due

to multiple felony convictions. In 1996 he was convicted of felony possession of marijuana and in 2001, after unintentionally shooting and killing his eight-year old son while on a hunting trip, he was convicted of felony possession of a firearm by a felon.

125. Stringer, Marvin Lamar (22); Conway, Samuel, (23); and Pickney, Jeremy (23), all Black: killed

five people in Arkansas in 2009, These were later identified as 56-year-old Edward Gentry Jr., his 52-year-old wife Pam, their 24-year-old son Jeremy, and Jeremy's 19-year-old girlfriend Kristyn Warneke (<u>all white</u>). They had all been shot to death. ... the body of 80-year-old Edward Gentry Sr. was ... shot to death execution style ... burglarized: flat-screen televisions, guns, and two sets of rims and tires had been stolen. Police records state, the killers "stayed awhile" after they killed the victims – which indicates in other similar robbery-murders that <u>they tortured and raped</u> their victims before killing them.
