I have resided in Portland since 1985. I am opposed to HB2001 and amendments because:

- Bypasses Oregon's Land Use Goals
- Eliminates Single-Family Zoning
- No market analysis performed
- No parking requirements
- No infrastructure requirements
- No transportation planning
- Environmental protections overridden
- Significant loss of residential tree canopy
- No protection for historic resources
- No restrictions on vacation rentals
- Decreased fire safety in multi-units
- Legal fees for denied applicants
