We and our children are also exposed to dangerous levels of this neurotoxin in residues on food. The science is clear that pesticides like chlorpyrifos cause brain damage to children. To cap it off, chlorpyrifos also gets into Oregon streams, threatening our already imperiled salmon and steelhead.

For this reason, the EPA was going to stop the use of chlorpyrifos, but then the Trump administration reversed that decision, putting Dow Chemical ahead of the nation's children. That is why I am asking you to step up and protect our kids by supporting these bills.

HB3058 and SB853 would also make the neonicotinoid class of insecticides "restricted use," meaning that people who don't have an Oregon license to apply pesticides wouldn't be able to buy and use these chemicals, which are widely sold in garden centers and big box stores with no education about their grim effects. Neonics are highly toxic to bees, beneficial insects, and aquatic invertebrates (an important part of the food web). Because they move in water, they are prone to drift from yards and fields into water. Likewise, since they are systemic they persist in plants and increase toxic exposure to insects. Seeds coated in neonics are also dangerous to birds – just a single seed can kill a songbird.
