## **Measure Description:**

Permits Office of Child Care to consider any information obtained by office when reviewing enrollment in Central Background Registry.

## Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Education (ODE)

## Summary of Fiscal Impact:

Costs related to the measure are indeterminate at this time - See explanatory analysis.

**Analysis:** The measure requires the Early Learning Division's Office of Child Care (OCC) to consider any information it obtains that is relevant to enrollment in the Central Background Registry and requires a criminal records request to include records in the national sex offender registry maintained by the National Crime Information Center. In addition, the bill permits OCC to take evidence, take depositions, compel appearances of witnesses, issue subpoenas, and inspect premises when conducting investigations.

The OCC cannot estimate the number of individuals that may be subject to enforcement activities or the resulting fiscal impact and the overall fiscal impact is therefore indeterminate. OCC does not believe it will have a significant impact at this time.
