# WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Removes maximum per cigar tax for cigars. Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

# **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

# **EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

No amendment.

## **BACKGROUND:**

Under current law, Oregon taxes cigars at 65% of the wholesale sales price with a maximum price per cigar of \$0.50. Removing the maximum price from statute results in cigars taxed at 65% of the wholesale sales price at all sales ranges.
