WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Establishes Oregon Youth Council to advise Governor on issues youth-related issues. Creates eligibility criteria and application process, limits membership to maximum of one member per Senate district and directs Oregon Advocacy Commissions Office to provide administrative support to Council.

BACKGROUND:

The Oregon Advocacy Commissions Office provides support for four advocacy commissions: the Commission on Asian and Pacific Islander Affairs, the Commission on Black Affairs, the Commission on Hispanic Affairs and the Commission for Women. The commissions are comprised of nine community members, appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Senate, and two legislators appointed by the Presiding Officers. The commissions provide policy advice, grow leadership and strive to build success for their constituents.
