I write in opposition to SB 413 based on the long-standing local opposition to a Westside Bypass and the negative impacts on Oregon's prime farmland- not only where the bypass would be located but also the secondary impacts including dispersed development that would follow. The use of eminent domain, special taxing districts and tollways for such a development undercut the agreements between urban (including Metro) and rural communities and existing land use plans.
