HB3165

Health Tools for Oregon's Schools

HB3165 is the result of 12 years of Legislative Action

The legislature has:

- Doubled the number of SBHCs in Oregon (41 – 76)
 - Ensured mental health capacity at all SBHCs
 - Required Electronic Medical Records
 - Required that SBHCs bill insurance and Medicaid (from 50% to 100% in 10 years) which leverages state \$ 5 to 1!
- NOW, HB3165 Takes the Next Steps . . .

More Flexibility

- Build on the specific needs of each district
- Provide tools for schools to meet the direction of the JCSS (i.e. health and mental behavioral needs)
- Form an SBHC, OR pursue an alternative.

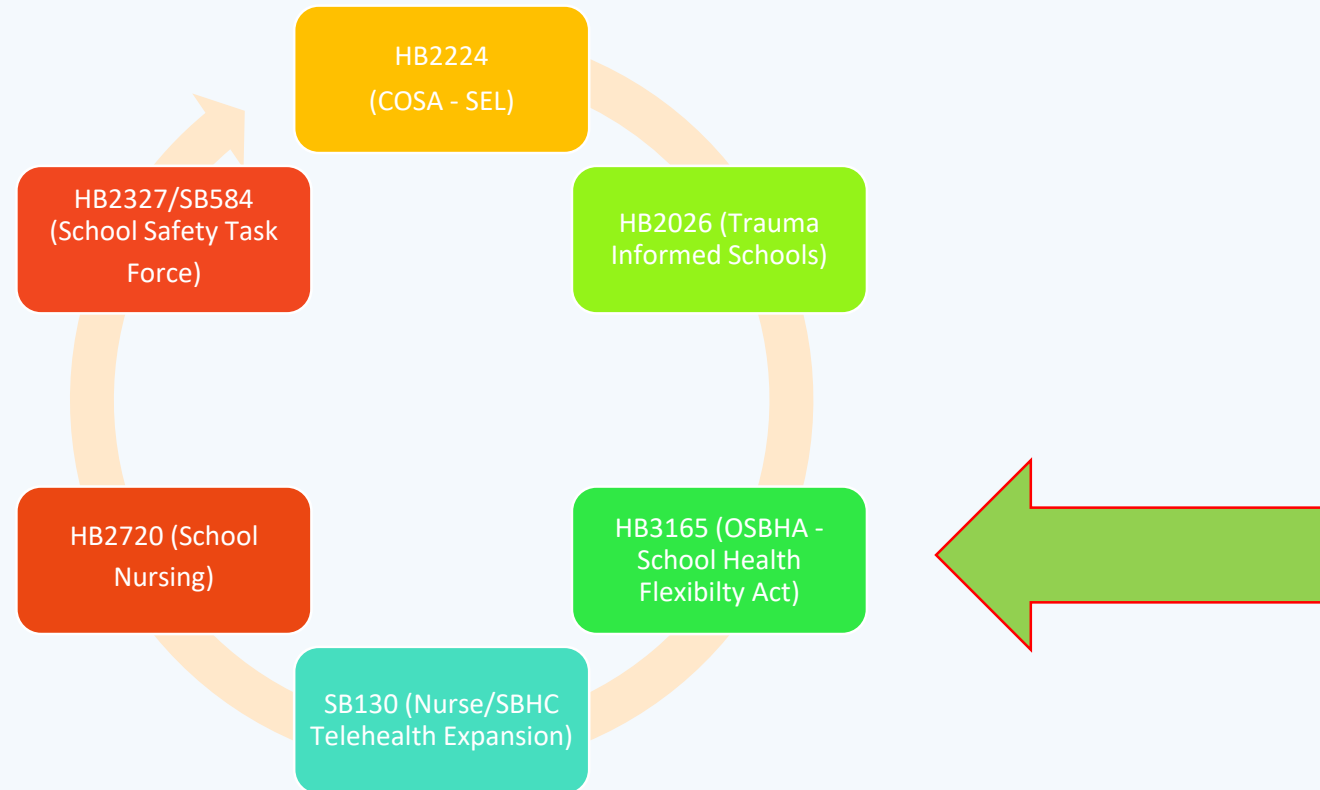
