



SB130 (Nurse/SBHC Telehealth Expansion)

- <u>HB2224</u>/House Committee on Education: \$85 million for investments in social, emotional/mental health. (JCSS)
- <u>HB2O26 + Amdt.</u> /House Ed/ODE: Expands successful "Trauma Informed Schools Programs" (Central and Tigard H.S.) which are reducing absenteeism, dramatically reducing failure rates among at-risk kids, etc. to allow other schools to implement the model. (And HB2965/Marsh, State Coordination of Trauma Programs Across Agencies) (JCSS)
- <u>HB3165</u>/Nathanson-G. Smith: Allow school districts to move forward with new school health centers (which leverage state dollars 5/1) or more targeted mental/behavioral or nursing supports for their schools. (WM)
- <u>SB130</u>/Senate Health Committee: Links school nurses with providers at school health centers through TELEHEALTH to allow for billing for critical health services and expansion of nursing in many districts. (WM)
- <u>HB2644</u>/Schouten: Creates Community Youth Development Hubs (up to 5) to help leverage state aid for youth/schools. Also, **SB264**, grants to community based organizations YDC. (WM)
- <u>HB2327</u>/Barker, Wagner, Bonham, Etc.: Implement anti-bullying programs, suicide prevention efforts, multi-disciplinary safety assessment teams, and school safety tip lines. (JCSS)
