**Testimony to the Senate Health Care Committee**

**RE: Testimony in support of HB 2609 A-Engrossed**

Chair Monnes Anderson, Vice Chair Linthicum and Members of the Committee,

For the record my name is Dr. Jennifer Clemens. I am the Dental Director for Capitol Dental Care (CDC). We are a dental care organization that provides care to Oregon Health Plan (OHP) beneficiaries, through contracts with coordinated care organizations across the state.

I am here to testify on HB 2609 A-Engrossed and to request your support for the bill.

HB 2609 defines “Dental Director” for the purpose of providing dental directors with access to specific information in the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP). Currently, the law only applies to medical directors and pharmacy directors, allowing them access to the information in the PDMP. We believe that leaving dental directors out of the law was an oversight, as dentists regularly prescribe prescription drugs, including those classified as opioids.

Dental directors should have the same access and ability that medical and pharmacy directors currently have to monitor their clinics, offices, or system of clinics to ensure the delivery of quality care. This bill will provide a valuable tool for dental directors to ensure that providers within their clinics, offices, or system of clinics are prescribing safely and in accordance with recommended guidelines.

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In addition to Capitol Dental Care, there are a number of other organizations that support HB 2609. Their names are included in the “Coalition letter” document we have provided and is posted on OLIS (03/12/2019).
