The amendment did not do much better "Oregon Digital Learning Academy", perhaps back in the day, "Digital" could have referenced a computer generated program. but the term digital (working with numbers) does not seem appropriate!

Might I suggest replacing the word digital with Online, "Oregon Online Learning Academy" even the word academy is defined as where special subjects are presented,

I believe that "Oregon Online Learning School" would give the appropriate definition for the program.
