## **Online Learning Options in Oregon**

Full Virtual: The school has no physical building where students meet with each other or with teachers, and all instruction is virtual

**Focus Virtual:** The school focuses on a systematic program of virtual instruction but includes some physical meetings among students or with teachers

**Supplemental Virtual:** The school offers virtual courses but virtual instruction is not the primary means of instruction.

#### Online learning trends:

- Increased demand for access to high speed broadband connectivity.
- Increased use of learning management systems (LMS) for online and blended learning.
- Greater need for understanding student data privacy and data security.

- Variety of access to 50+ courses


ORVSD students remain students in their home district.






## **ORVSD Across the State**




On average, **ORVSD** serves 500 students from 38 rural school districts each year. Each blue pin on the map represents a school district served within the past three years.

## Virtual Education in Public Charter Schools

- The public charter school sector has been a primary avenue for virtual innovation in Oregon.
- The first full-virtual, state-wide online schools started opening in the early 2000's.
- Virtual public charter schools now serve about 13,000 students in 19 schools.

## What is a Public Charter School?

- Public School of Choice
- Authorized by Sponsor, usually School District Boards
- Semi-Autonomous in their operation and governance
- Granted some flexibility from traditional requirements
- Accountable to Performance Expectations




#### Virtual Public Charter School Distinctives

- Curriculum and instruction delivered electronically
- Teacher and students are in different physical locations
- Specific statutory requirements ORS 338.120

asynchronous = students can engage anytime, pre-recorded synchronous = students engage with live lessons

- In-person meetings and annual regional activities
- Attendance calculated through teacher-student check-ins twice a week (minimum for full funding)




#### Virtual Public Charter School Enrollment






## Virtual Public Charter School Demographics
