Background

- Oregon Task Force on School Safety (OTFSS) created by HB4087 in 2014 Legislative Session
- 2015 OTFSS Report to the Oregon State Legislature:
 - Statewide threat assessment system
 - Statewide school floor plan database
 - Standardized terminology
 - Statewide safety tip line (HB 4075 2016)



SafeOregon



- SafeOregon launched January 31, 2017
 - 1099 Schools Enrolled
 - Over 3,300 tips
 - Over 531,000 students served
 - Web reporting form is most popular method
 - Tips include:
 - Bullying Harassment- 40%
 - Drugs 12%
 - Threat to safety- 12%
 - Suicidal Ideation (reported by others)- 9%

HB2051



- While implementing Oregon Administrative Rules for the tip line, a gap between the intent of the bill and the statutory language was discovered
 - Researched other states with tiplines
 - Worked with general counsel
 - Drafted Legislative Concept

HB2051

- HB2051 underwent one amendment in House Judiciary Committee to clarify personally identifiable information and to ensure the change does not hinder the Oregon public interest balancing test.
- HB2051 passed the House of Representatives with 58 Ayes, and zero Nays
