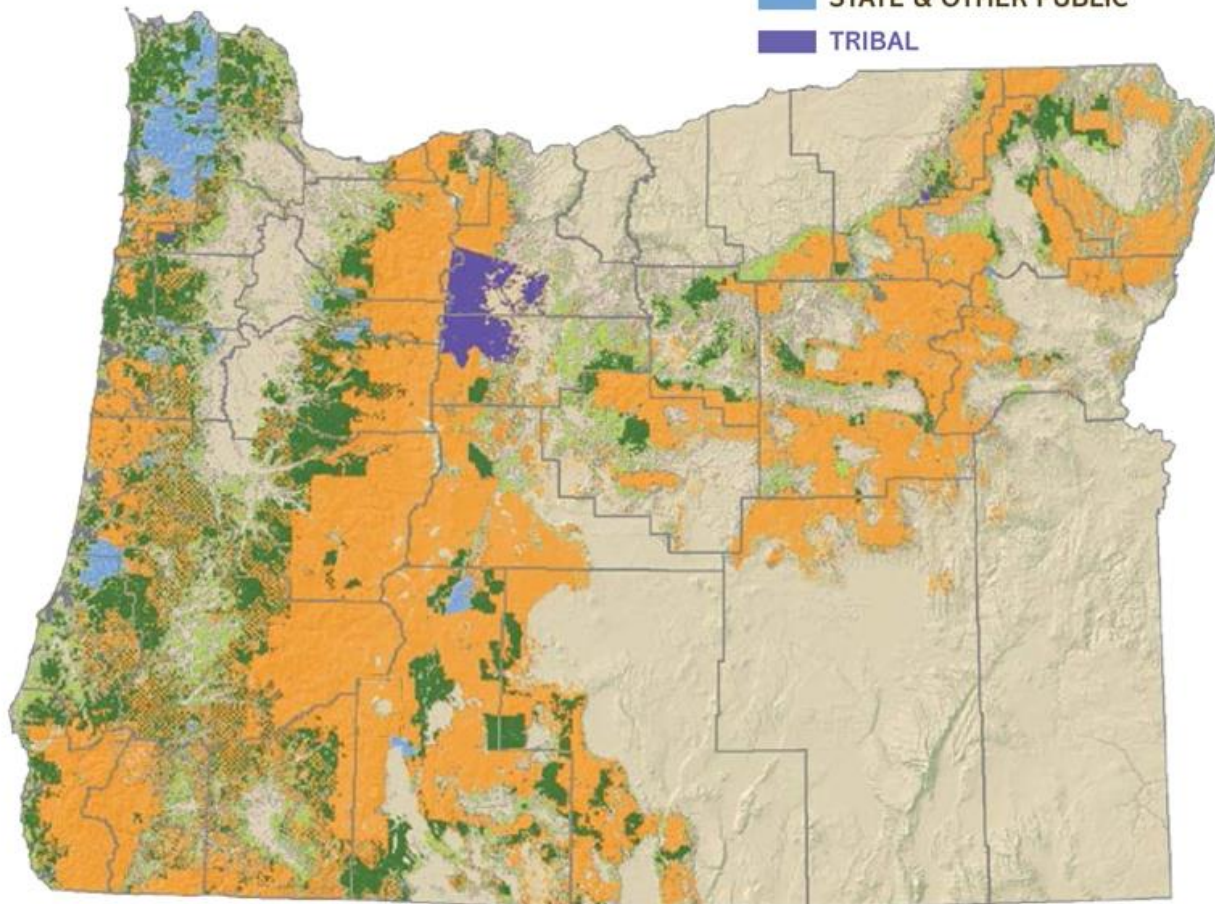

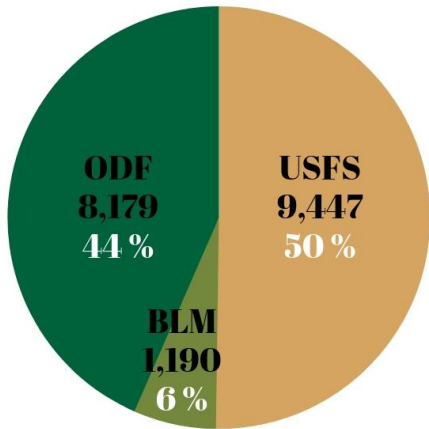

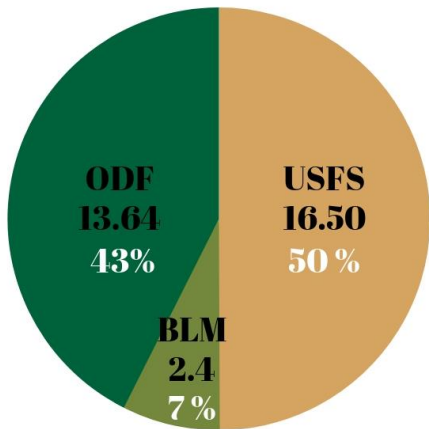

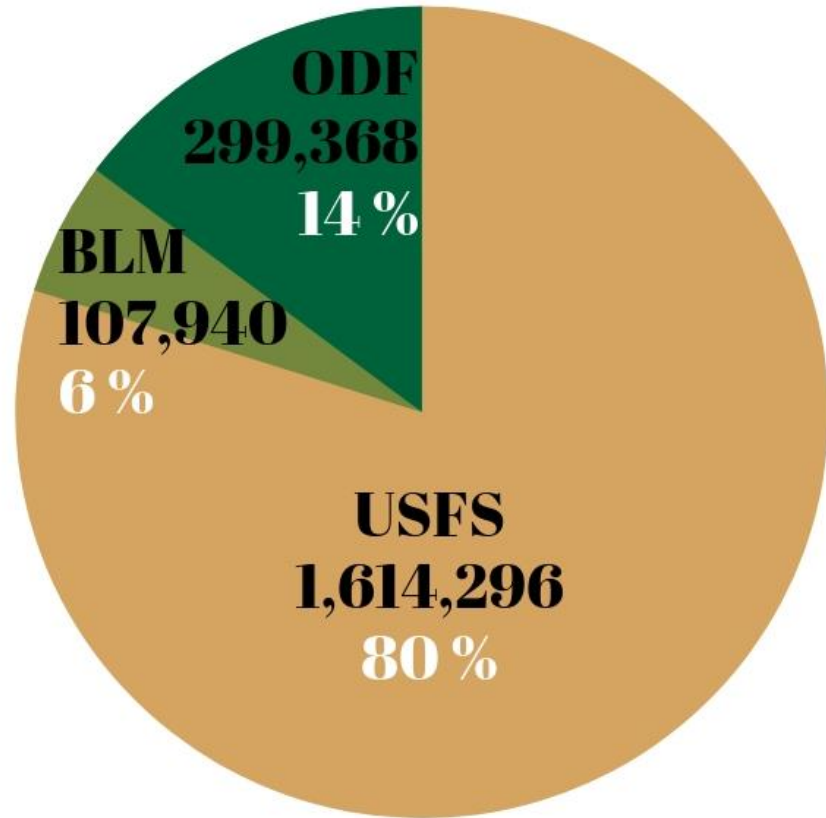
Number of Fires 2009-2018
