When combined with the current proposed levels for the State School Fund, this investment education to funding to historic levels closing more than half the gap to the funding level defined in the Quality Education Model (QEM).

It is disheartening, if not demoralizing, for our staff to once again be facing a time of cuts that have such a negative impact on the children we are entrusted to serve. Hazeldale Elementary has been on a trajectory of growth in every subgroup area on the State Report Card due to strategic moves of our staff. We believe that with the investment in our children, this growth will continue despite the higher standards and Title I population that has very real challenges of poverty.
