WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Directs the State Board of Education in consultation with the State Library to adopt standards for the state library program. Specifies instruction to students and school employees. Requires each school district board ensure that each school have state library programs that comply with State Board of Education standards. Directs State Board of Education to develop academic content standards for library and media studies. Specifies requirements for academic content standards.

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

ORS 329.095 requires school districts have a continuous improvement plan with goals to implement a number of items, including a school library program. House Bill 3263 requires the State Board of Education adopt standards for the state library program, in consultation with the State Board of Education.
