Measure Description:

Appropriates moneys to Housing and Community Services Department for grants to support services for families seeking or needing housing that have low or very low incomes.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Housing and Community Services Department (HCSD)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Rules to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The legislation makes three General Fund (GF) appropriations in the 2019-21 biennium for the following: \$15 million to the Housing and Community Services Department to administer and award grants to private of public entities that help individuals obtain/retain housing, \$2 million to the Housing and Community Services Department to award grants to private to public entities for providing no-charge legal services related to housing for low-income individuals, and \$3 million to the Department of Justice for deposit in the Oregon Domestic and Sexual Violence Services Fund for assistance with housing needs specified by the bill for victims of domestic violence and sexual assault.

A more complete fiscal analysis, including agency grant administration cost estimates, will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
