WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Allows the Department of Transportation to issue two disabled person parking decals or individual placards upon request.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

-4 Replaces original measure. Extends the period for which a temporary duplicate disabled parking permit may be issued for travel purposes from 30 days to 120 days, effective July 6, 2020. Allows temporary permits to be renewed by mail.

BACKGROUND:

Current Oregon law allows the Department of Transportation (ODOT) to issue one disabled person parking decal or individual placard per applicant. Applicants must apply with the Department and have an authorized physician certify that the applicant is eligible for a disabled person parking permit. The Department can issue a temporary second parking decal or individual placard for travel purposes. The temporary duplicate permit is valid for 30 days. disabled person parking decals or individual placards upon request.

House Bill 2999 allows ODOT to issue two disabled person parking decals or individual placards upon request.
