

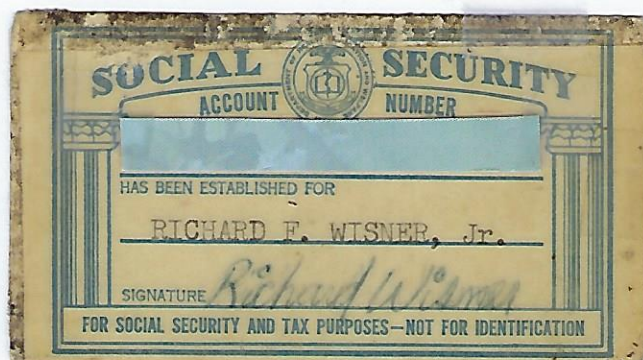

I strongly urge the Committee to pass this legislation. Requiring one to provide one's Social Security number for any reason other than payroll or tax purposes should not be an option. I have even had doctor's offices insist they obtain it prior to providing care.



I am providing a (redacted) picture of my own Social Security card that I obtained in 1964 as an example. Please note the bottom line on the face of the card, i.e., "NOT FOR IDENTIFICATION".
