

Educator Externships

What: Educators are exposed to the culture and values of an industry through summer externship placements to become more prepared to implement curriculum that is beneficial to student preparation.

Where: In various sectors including, tech, food and beverage manufacturing, wood products, agriculture, metals manufacturing, & construction. To date, 26 educators from 13 districts.


How: ODE, Oregon Community Foundation, and Ford Family Foundation


Strengths: *Relevance*. Curriculum connections being made in the classroom.

Challenges: *Capacity.* This year we had a waitlist of 5 educators.




