WELL-BEING

79% of youth demonstrated an INCREASE IN RELATIONSHIP SKILLS. ●

82% of youth demonstrated an INCREASE IN COPING SKILLS and a decrease in issues at school or work. ●

79% of youth ENGAGED IN RELATIONSHIP SKILL BUILDING ACTIVITIES. ●

74% of youth supported via street outreach RECEIVED BASIC NEEDS SUPPLIES.

PERMANENCY

50% of youth EXITED WITH POSITIVE PERMANENT CONNECTIONS to two or more adults. ● ●

50% of youth EXITED WITH CONNECTIONS to their communities. ● ●

HOUSING

83% of youth UNDER 18 EXITED TO SAFE AND STABLE HOUSING. ● ●

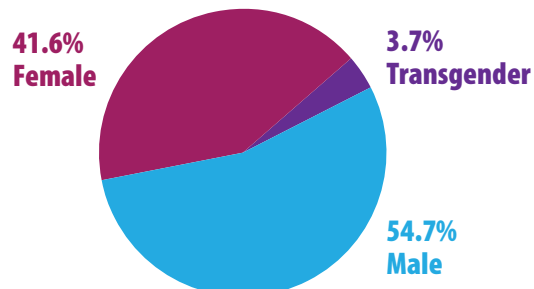
24% of young adults OVER 18 EXITED TO SAFE AND STABLE HOUSING. ● ●

EMPLOYMENT/EDUCATION

83% of youth under 18 ADVANCED EDUCATION. ● ●
