**Measure Description:**

Prohibits sale, purchase or use of pesticide products containing chlorpyrifos.

**Analysis:**

Effective January 1, 2021 the legislation would prohibit the sale, purchase or use of pesticide products containing chlorpyrifos in the state of Oregon.

The Oregon Department of Agriculture (ODA) will reprioritize existing staff workloads to conduct a review of the pesticide database to identify products affected by the legislation and to conduct outreach to assure compliance with the pesticide ban; this work is estimated to cost \$25,256 Other Funds (OF) in the 2019-21 biennium. Agency rulemaking and mailers to retailers and pesticide producers are estimated at a one-time cost of \$50,000 OF in the 2019-21 biennium. Revenue from chlorpyrifos pesticide registrations is estimated at a loss of \$15,680 OF in the 2019-21 biennium and \$31,360 OF in the 2021-23 biennium.
